

Median household income is \$10.8K below the national median household income of \$75.1K.


Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 2.6% since 2018, growing by 719. Population is expected to increase by 2.8% between 2023 and 2028, adding 801.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 5.6% in Lincoln County, WI from 12,356 to 11,668. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.5% by 10.1%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 66.6% to 61.6% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.9% of Lincoln County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.3% below the national average), and **11.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Insurance Carriers, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.








Unemployment by Gender







Unemployment by Ethnicity





As of 2023 the region's population increased by 2.6% since 2018, growing by 719. Population is expected to increase by 2.8% between 2023 and 2028, adding 801.



Job Trends






Lincoln County, WI had a September 2024 unemployment rate of 2.25%, decreasing from 3.56% 5 years before.




Millennials

Lincoln County, WI has 1,571 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,450.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Lincoln County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,575 people 55 or older, while there are 12,001 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Lincoln County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 11,830 racially diverse people, while there are 1,678 here.




Property Crime










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP




