

Median household income is \$11.4K below the national median household income of \$75.1K.


Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 8.8% since 2018, growing by 1,936. Population is expected to increase by 7.3% between 2023 and 2028, adding 1,740.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs increased by 2.6% in Vilas County, WI from 9,497 to 9,744. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.5% by 1.9%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 52.4% to 50.0% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **19.2% of Vilas County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (1.9% below the national average), and **10.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.9% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).








Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends



Labor Force Participation Rate Trends




Vilas County, WI had a September 2024 unemployment rate of 2.47%, decreasing from 4.11% 5 years before.


Millennials

Vilas County, WI has 2,000 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,214.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Vilas County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 7,210 people 55 or older, while there are 12,534 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Vilas County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 9,947 racially diverse people, while there are 3,269 here.




Property Crime








Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP








Top Occupation Employment Concentration




