
#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 1.5% since 2018, growing by 1,112. Population is expected to increase by 1.3% between 2023 and 2028, adding 988.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 4.0% in Wood County, WI from 42,426 to 40,723. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.5% by 8.5%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 60.1% to 55.3% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, **14.5% of Wood County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.6% below the national average), and **14.4% hold an Associate's Degree** (5.6% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are General Freight Trucking, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.













### **Job Trends**






Wood County, WI had a September 2024 unemployment rate of 2.71%, decreasing from 3.68% 5 years before.


#### Millennials

Wood County, WI has 12,655 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 15,023.




#### Veterans

Wood County, WI has 5,209 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 3,772.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Wood County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 22,320 people 55 or older, while there are 27,564 here.




#### **Violent Crime**

Racial diversity is low in Wood County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 30,793 racially diverse people, while there are 6,599 here.




#### **Property Crime**








### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**





In 2023, there were 997 graduates in Wood County, WI. This pipeline has grown by 20% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from "Nursing Assistant/Aide and Patient Care Assistant/Aide" (Certificate), "Emergency Medical Technology/Technician (EMT Paramedic)" (Certificate), and "Registered Nursing/Registered Nurse" (Associate's).
