
#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 7.3% since 2019, growing by 1,476. Population is expected to increase by 4.4% between 2024 and 2029, adding 959.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 0.1% in Adams County, WI from 5,740 to 5,746. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.9% by 3.8%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 48.6% to 44.0% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.4% of Adams County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.1% below the national average), and **8.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.3% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Crop Production, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Traveler Accommodation.















# **Job Trends**






Adams County, WI had an October 2024 unemployment rate of 3.42%, decreasing from 4.91% 5 years before.




#### Millennials

Adams County, WI has 3,052 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 4,358.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Adams County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 6,475 people 55 or older, while there are 11,079 here.




#### **Racial Diversity**

Racial diversity is low in Adams County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,933 racially diverse people, while there are 2,293 here.




#### **Veterans**

Adams County, WI has 1.21 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.




#### **Property Crime**








### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**










## **Top Occupation Employment Concentration**










