Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population **declined by 0.3%** since 2019, falling by 81. Population is expected to **decrease by 0.8%** between 2024 and 2029, losing 222.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 0.5% in Juneau County, WI from 10,597 to 10,650. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.9% by 3.4%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 65.5% to 64.3% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.2% of Juneau County**, **WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.2% below the national average), and **12.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.5% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.







Unemployment by Gender





Unemployment by Ethnicity









Unemployment Rate Trends


Juneau County, WI had an October 2024 unemployment rate of 2.39%, decreasing from 3.19% 5 years before.



Juneau County, WI has 4,495 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 5,403.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Juneau County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,028 people 55 or older, while there are 10,239 here. 2,284


Racial Diversity

Juneau County, WI has 1.96 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Occupation Employment Concentration




