
#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 1.5% since 2019, growing by 279. Population is expected to increase by 0.8% between 2024 and 2029, adding 150.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs declined by 0.9% in Langlade County, WI from 8,779 to 8,697. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.9% by 4.8%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 58.2% to 57.5% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.5% of Langlade County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.9% below the national average), and **11.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.9% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Crop Production, Warehouse Clubs, Supercenters, and Other General Merchandise Retailers, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.











### **Unemployment by Ethnicity**





As of 2024 the region's population increased by 1.5% since 2019, growing by 279. Population is expected to increase by 0.8% between 2024 and 2029, adding 150.



#### **Job Trends**






Langlade County, WI had an October 2024 unemployment rate of 2.63%, decreasing from 3.99% 5 years before.






#### **Millennials**




#### **Veterans**

Retirement risk is high in Langlade County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 5,858 people 55 or older, while there are 8,407 here.




#### **Violent Crime**

Racial diversity is low in Langlade County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,081 racially diverse people, while there are 1,448 here.




#### **Property Crime**












#### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**








### **Top Occupation Employment Concentration**










