
Median household income is **\$1.9K below** the national median household income of \$75.1K.

- From 2019 to 2024, jobs declined by 1.1% in Marathon County, WI from 78,443 to 77,551. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.9% by 5.0%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 68.3% to 65.2% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **19.3% of Marathon County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (2.1% below the national average), and **14.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (5.2% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and General Medical and Surgical Hospitals.







Unemployment by Gender








Population Trends






Unemployment Rate Trends

Marathon County, WI had an October 2024 unemployment rate of 2.11%, decreasing from 2.77% 5 years before.












Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration







Top Growing Occupations




Top Occupation Employment Concentration






Top Posted Occupations



Unique Average Monthly Postings



Educational Pipeline

In 2023, there were 2,171 graduates in Marathon County, WI. This pipeline has shrunk by 6% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from "Nursing Assistant/Aide and Patient Care Assistant/Aide" (Certificate), "Welding Technology/Welder" (Certificate), and "Emergency Medical Technology/Technician (EMT Paramedic)" (Certificate).
