
#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 9.7% since 2019, growing by 2,148. Population is expected to increase by 6.6% between 2024 and 2029, adding 1,593.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 1.5% in Vilas County, WI from 9,593 to 9,738. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.9% by 2.4%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 53.9% to 50.0% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **19.4% of Vilas County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (2.0% below the national average), and **10.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).













# **Unemployment by Ethnicity**







## **Job Trends**






Vilas County, WI had an October 2024 unemployment rate of 2.49%, decreasing from 4.11% 5 years before.




#### Millennials

Racial diversity is low in Vilas County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 9,947 racially diverse people, while there are 3,269 here.




#### **Veterans**

Vilas County, WI has 0.13 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.




#### **Property Crime**








### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**






### **Top Industry GRP**






