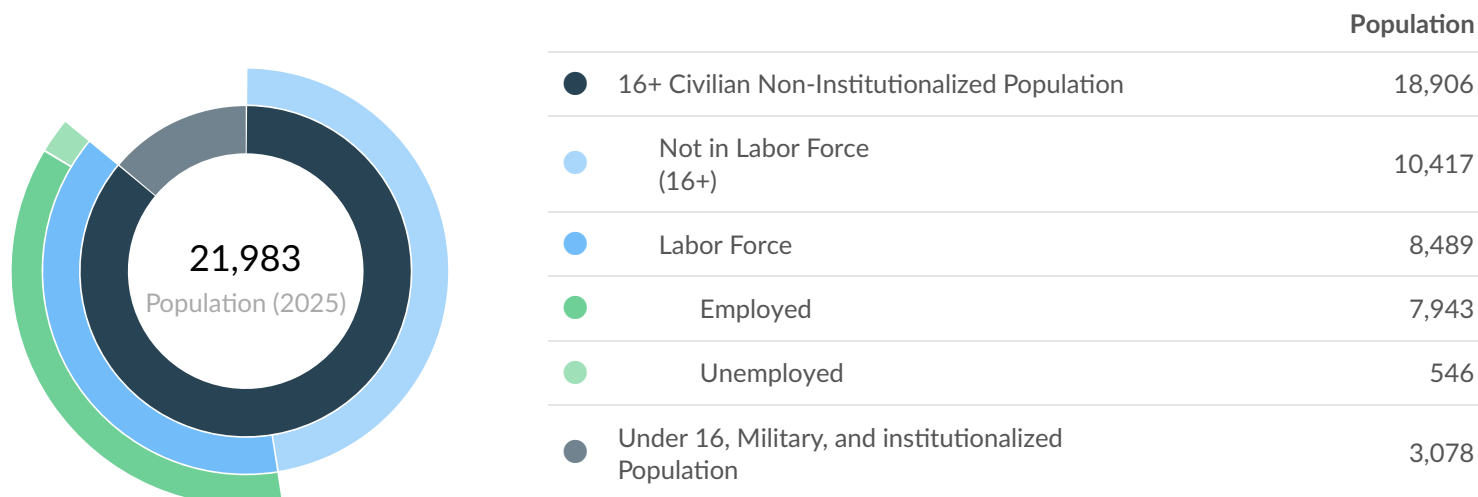
Median household income is **\$19.9K below** the national median household income of \$75.1K.

Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population **increased by 7.3%** since 2019, growing by 1,478. Population is expected to **increase by 4.4%** between 2024 and 2029, adding 964.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs **increased by 1.7%** in Adams County, WI from 5,731 to **5,829**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 4.1% by 2.4%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 49.4% to 44.4% between 2019 and 2024**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.0% of Adams County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.5% below the national average), and **9.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Crop Production, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Traveler Accommodation.

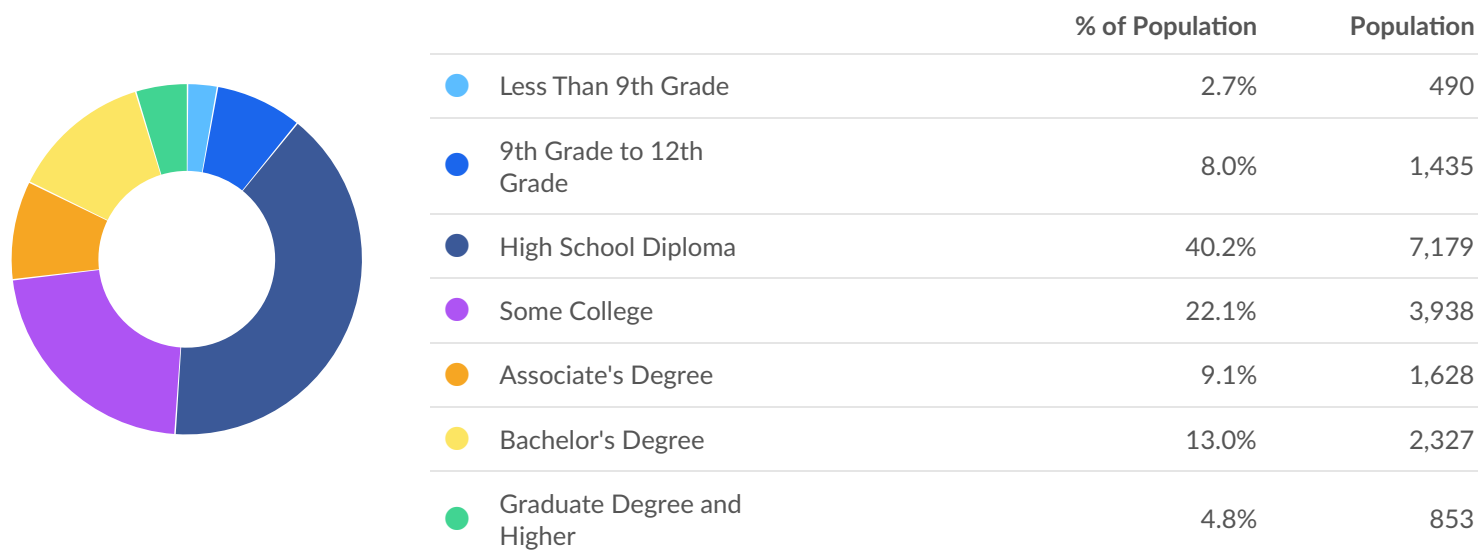

Mar 2025 Labor Force Breakdown



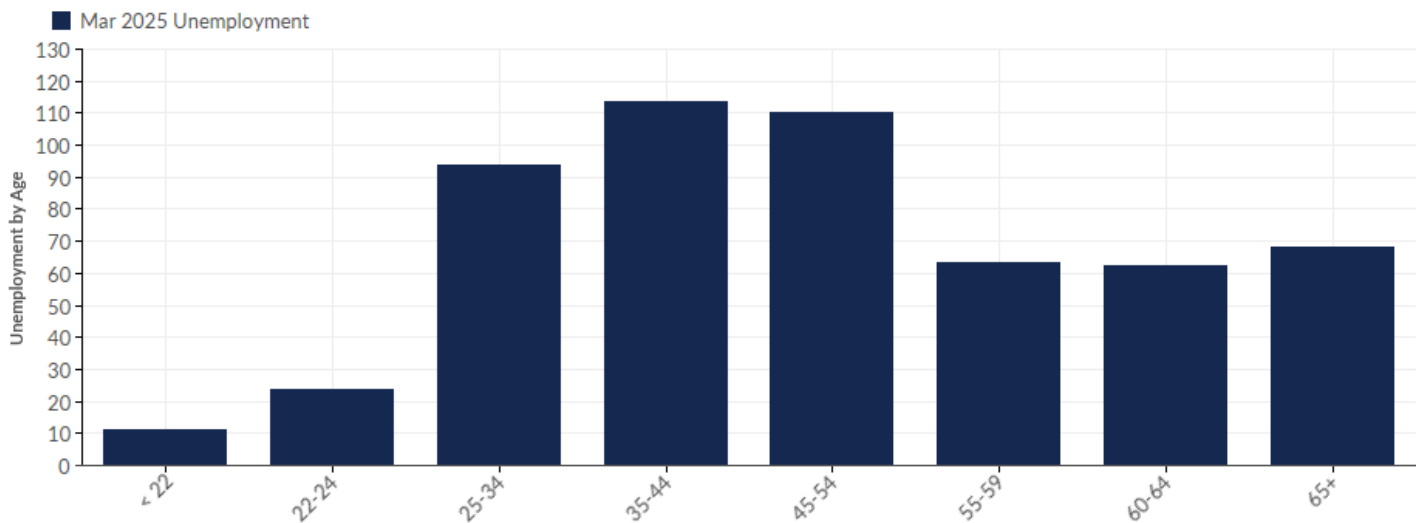
Educational Attainment

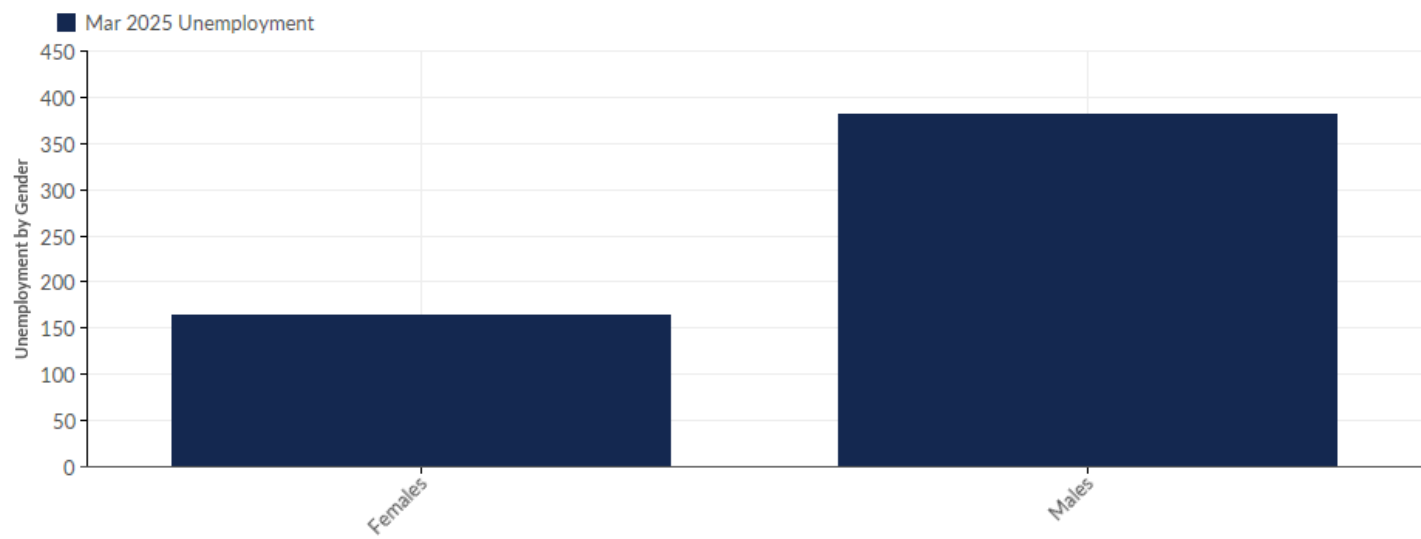

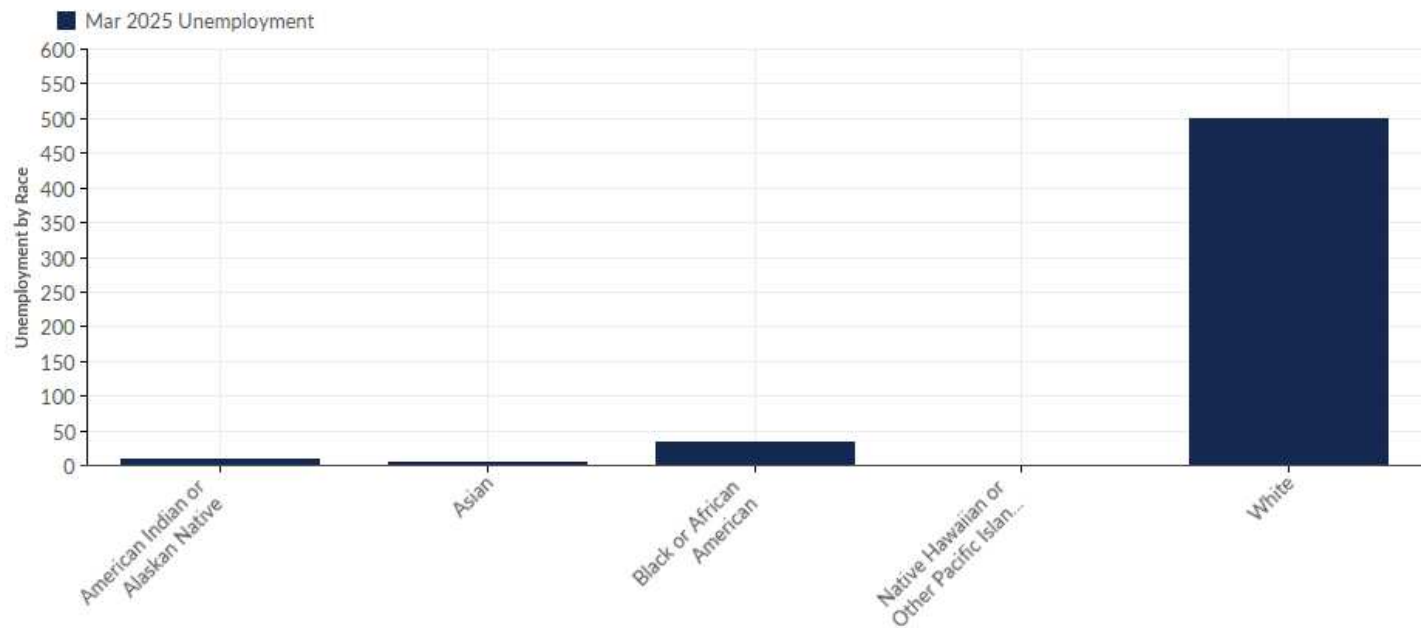

Unemployment by Gender



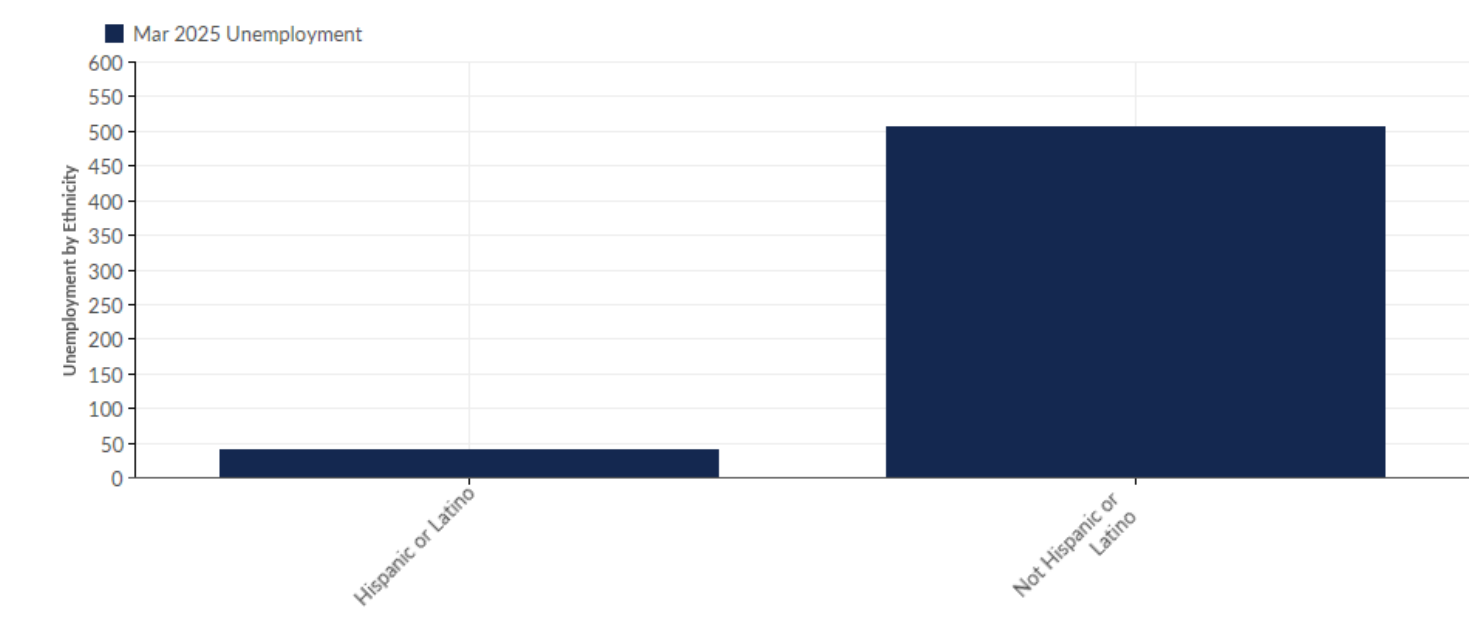

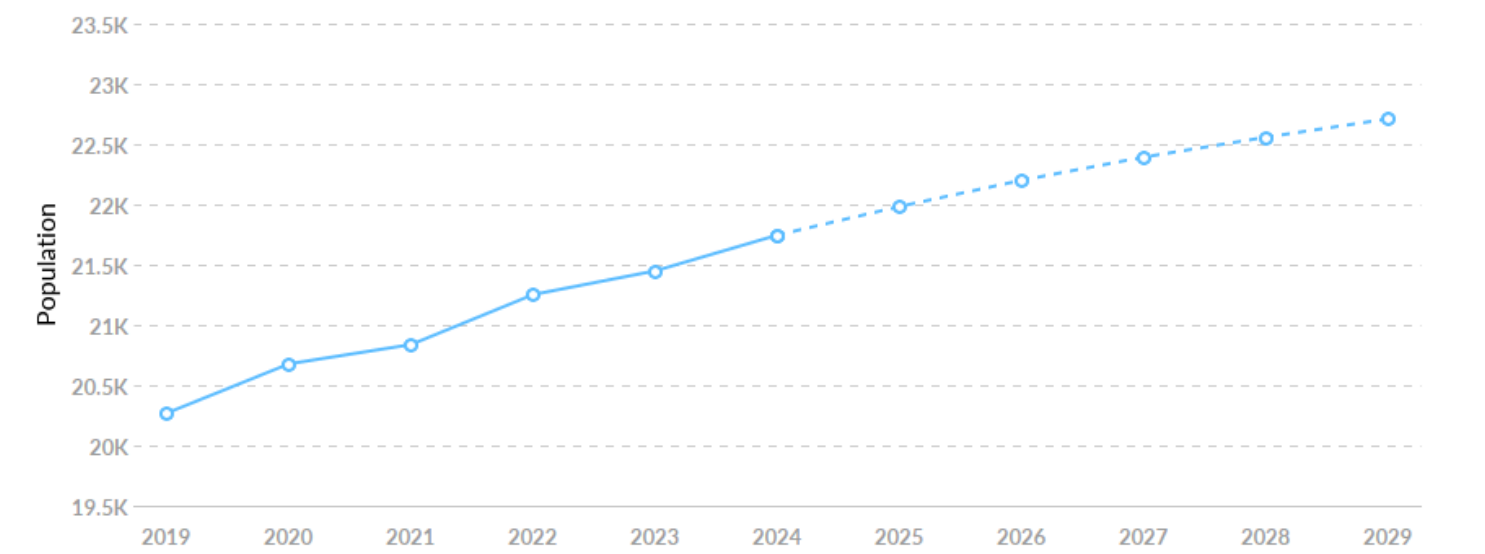

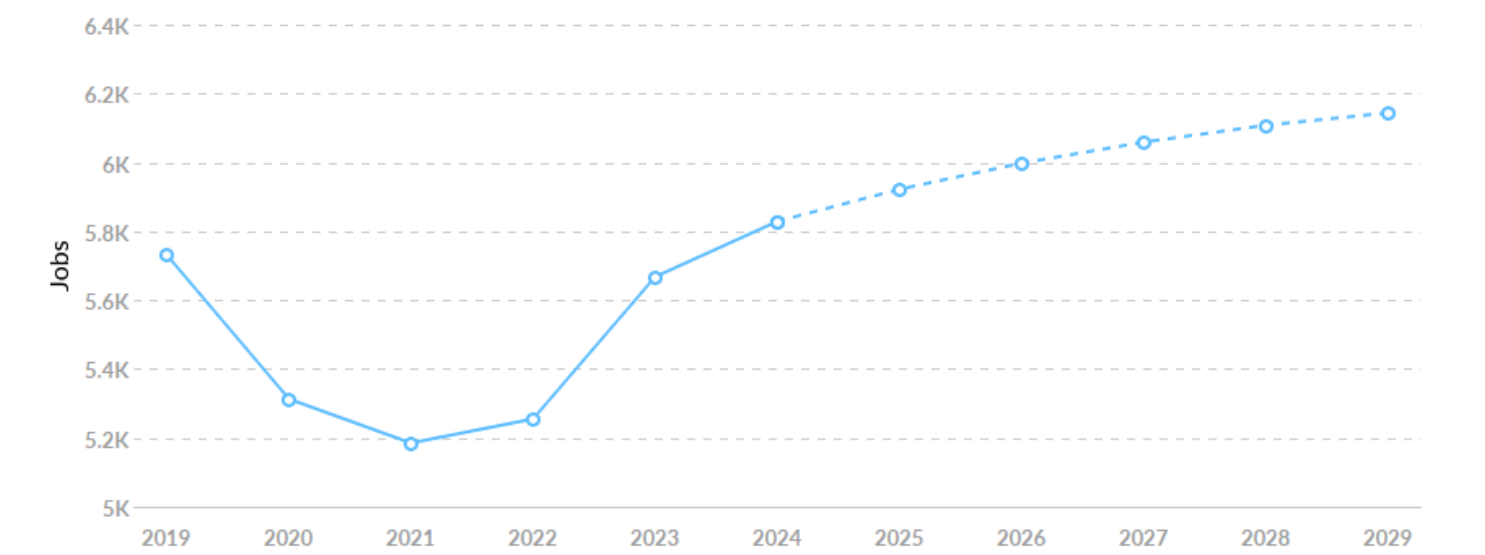

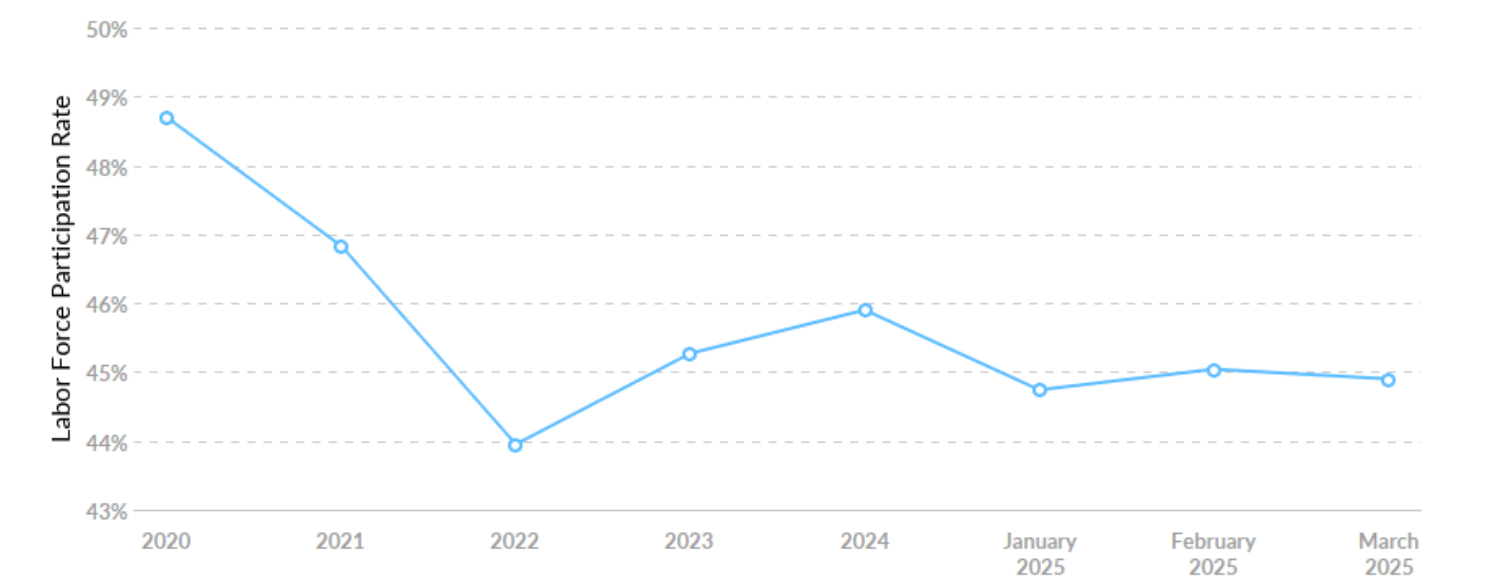
Job Trends

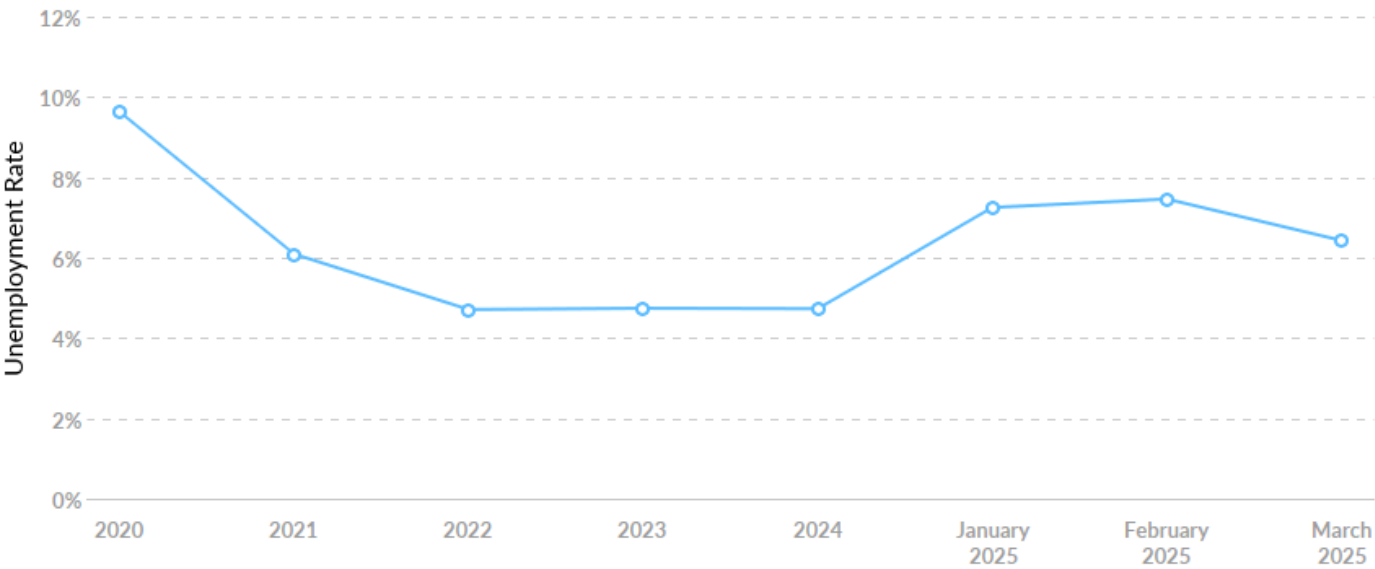

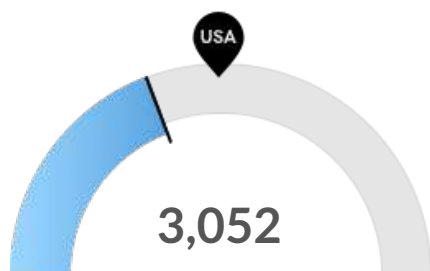
Unemployment Rate Trends

Adams County, WI had a March 2025 unemployment rate of 6.43%, **decreasing from 9.63%** 5 years before.



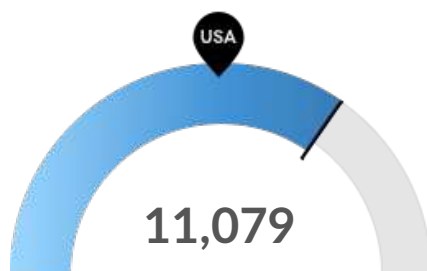

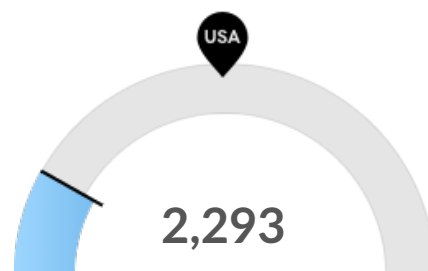
Millennials

Adams County, WI has 3,052 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 4,358.



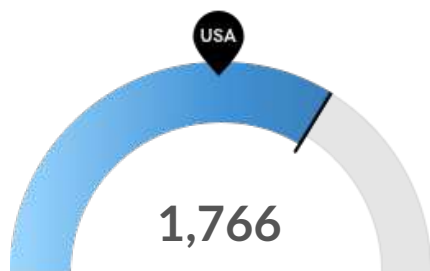
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Adams County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 6,475 people 55 or older, while there are 11,079 here.



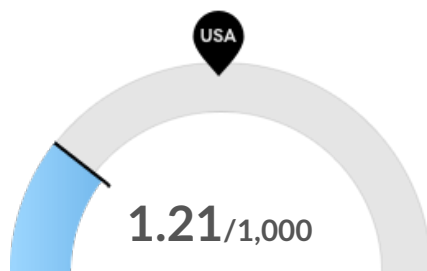
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Adams County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,933 racially diverse people, while there are 2,293 here.



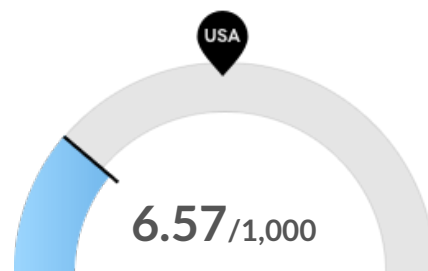
Veterans

Adams County, WI has 1.21 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.

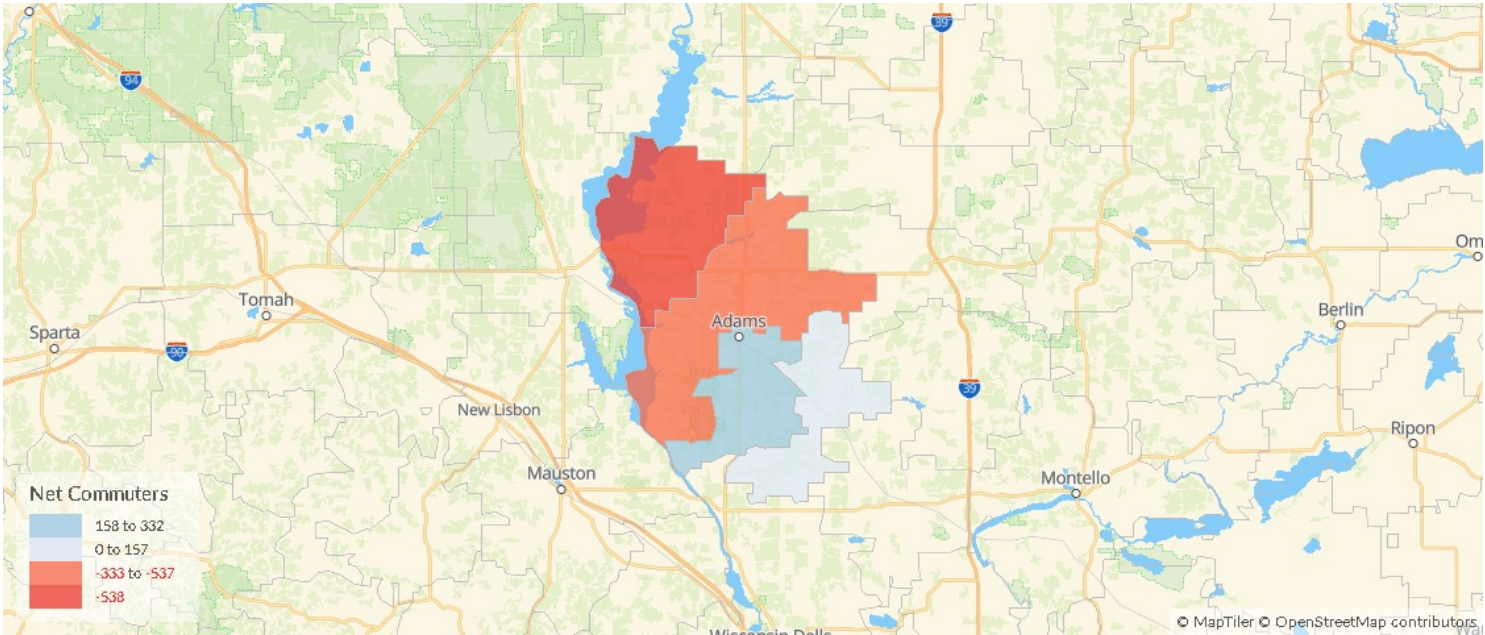


Property Crime

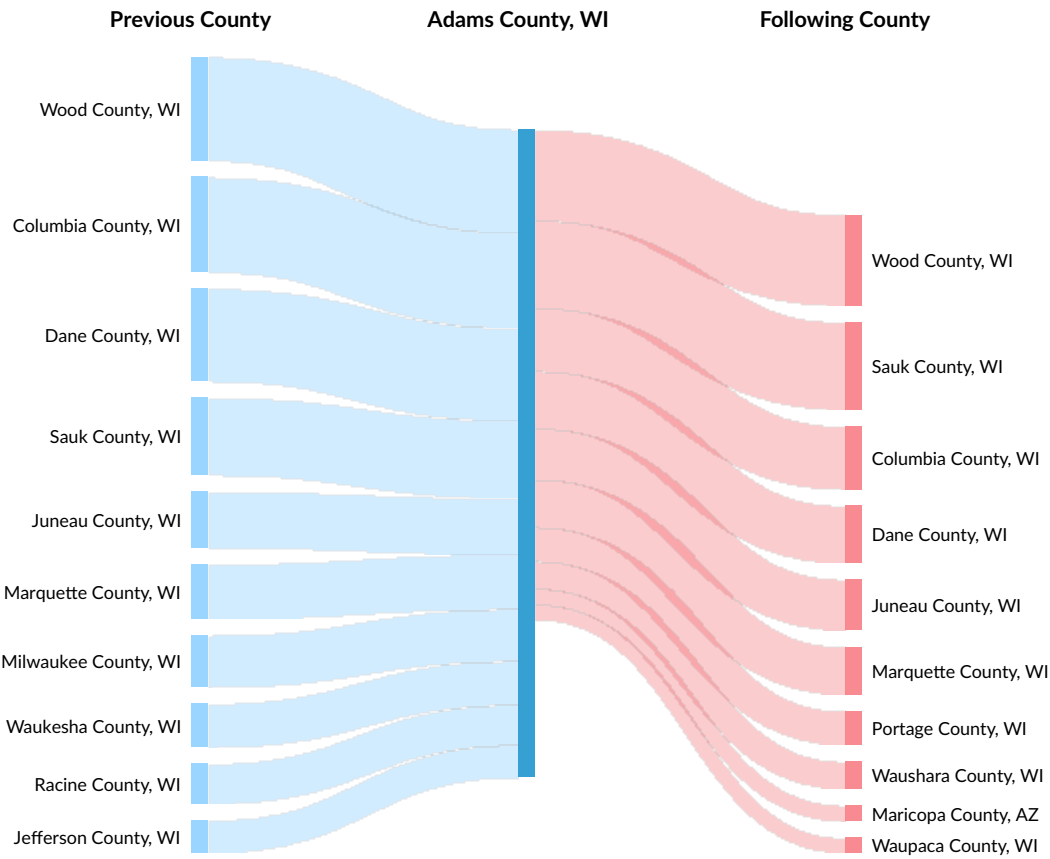

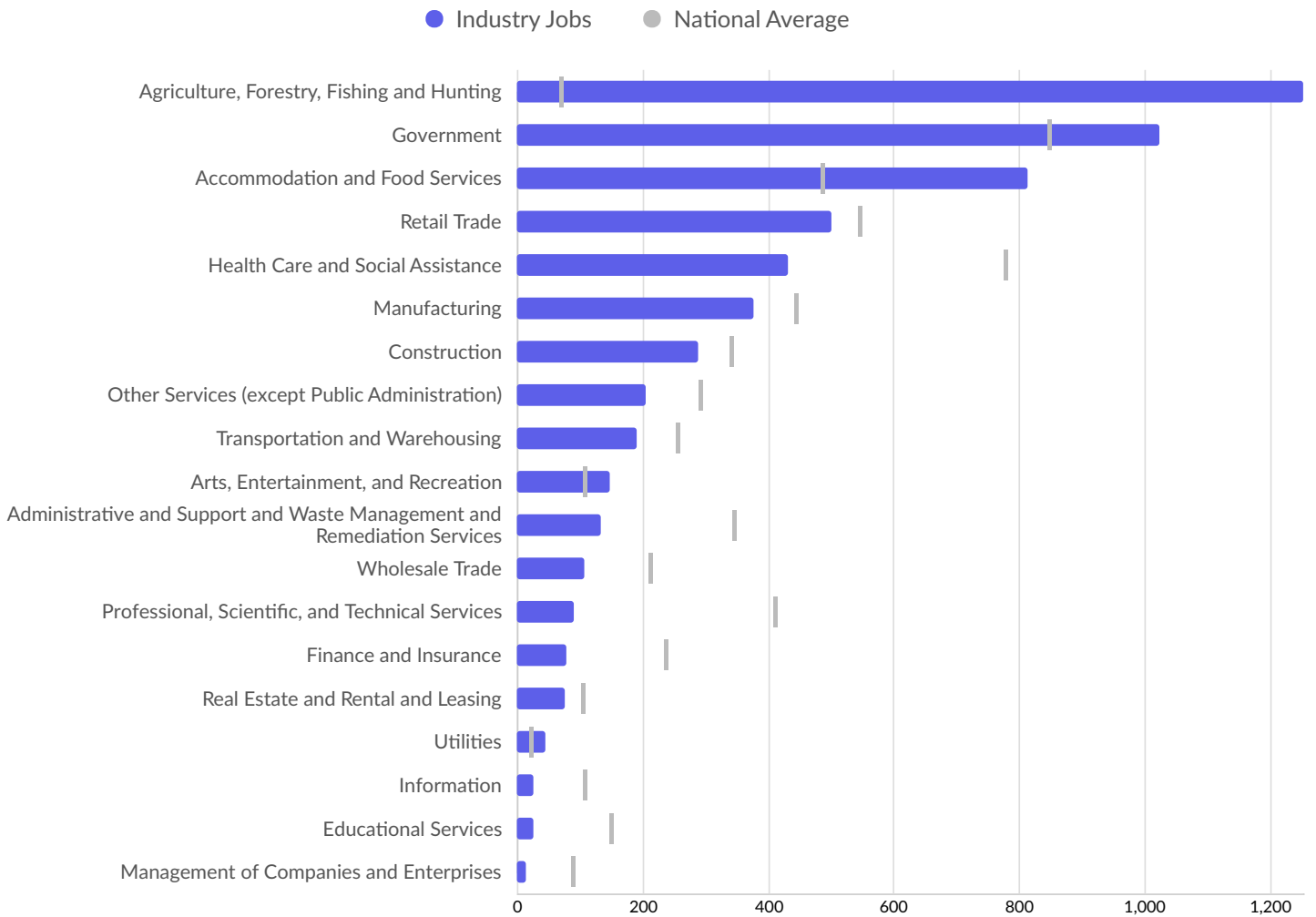

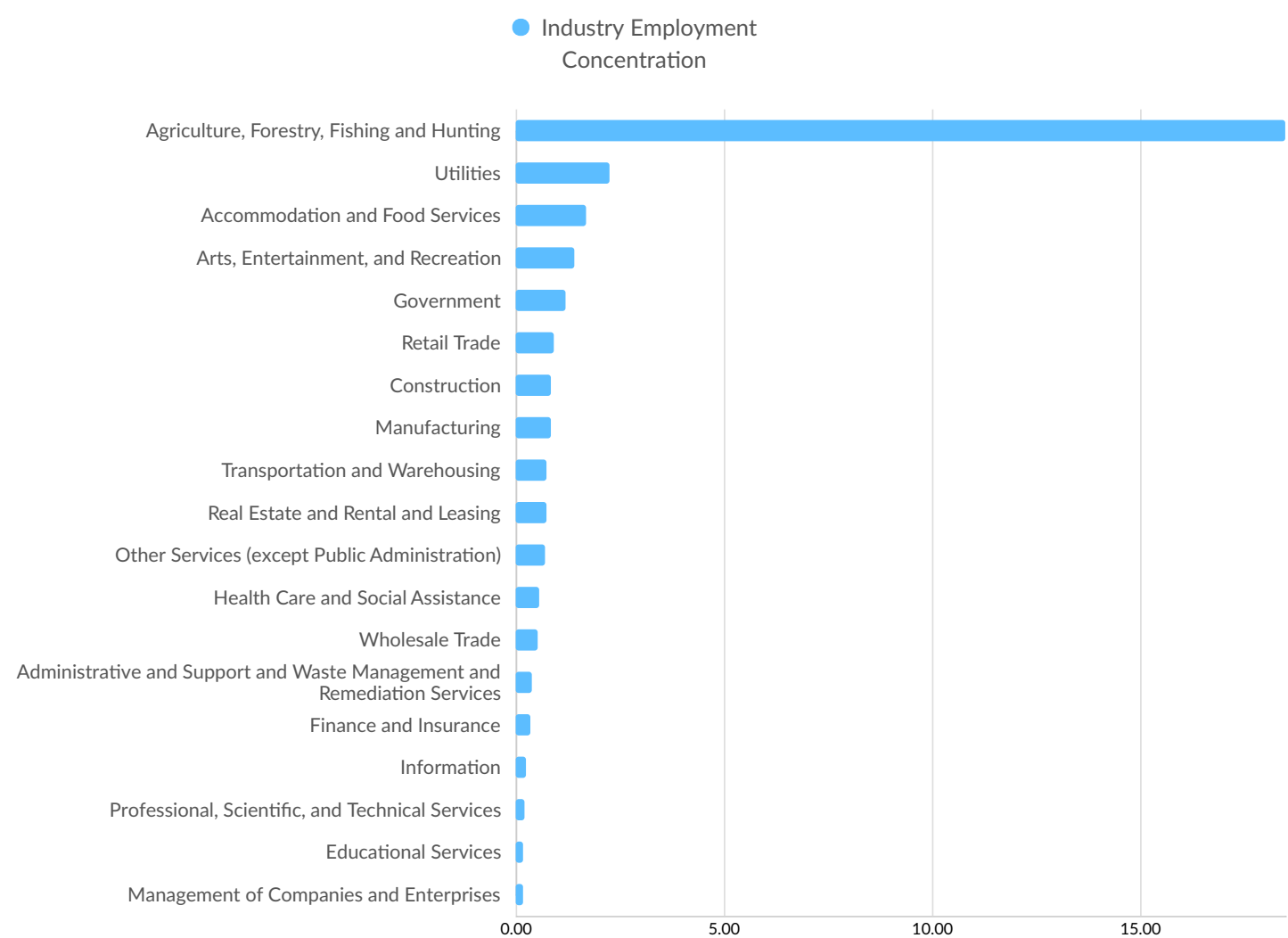

Top Growing Industries

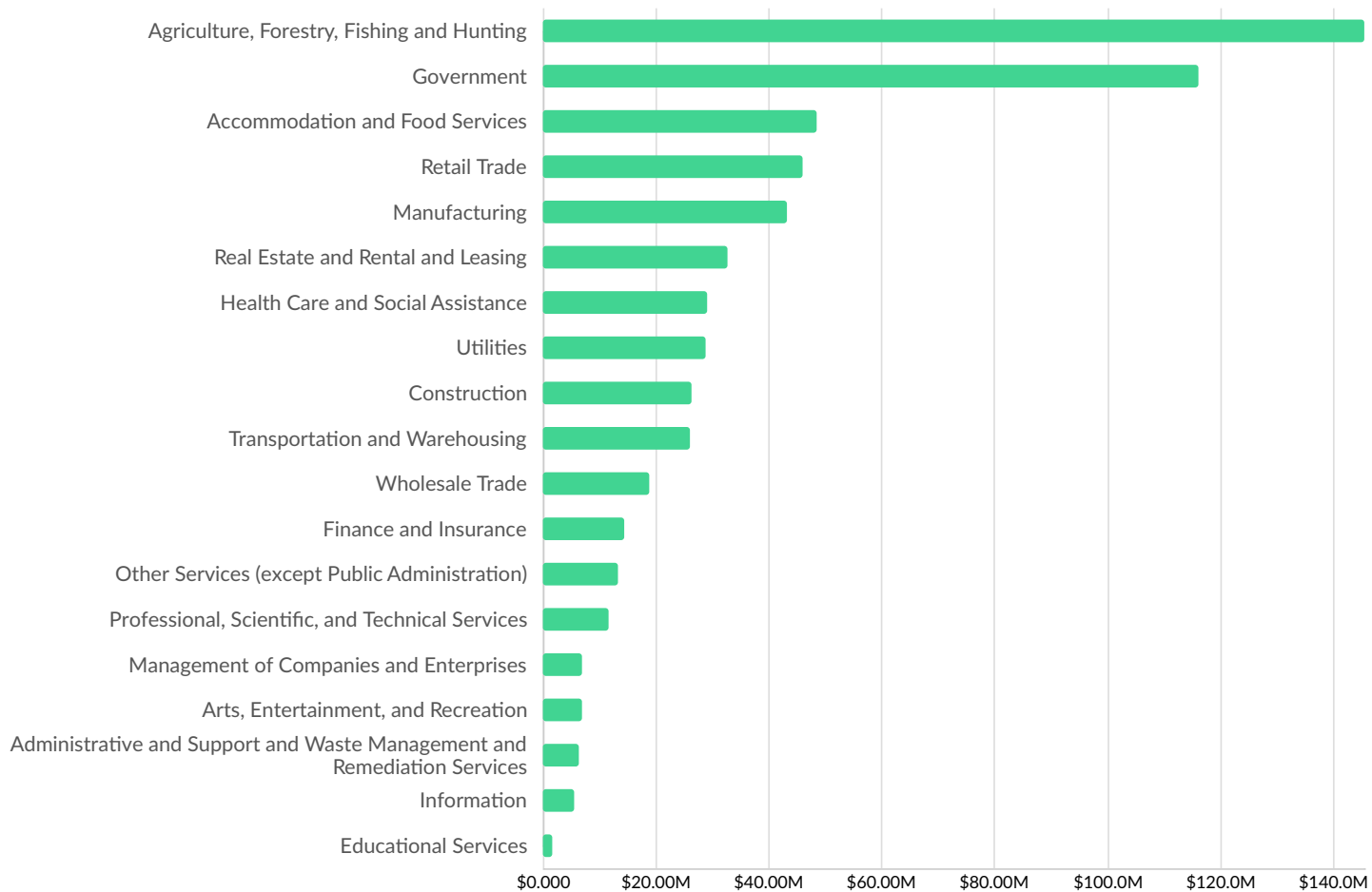


Top Industry Employment Concentration

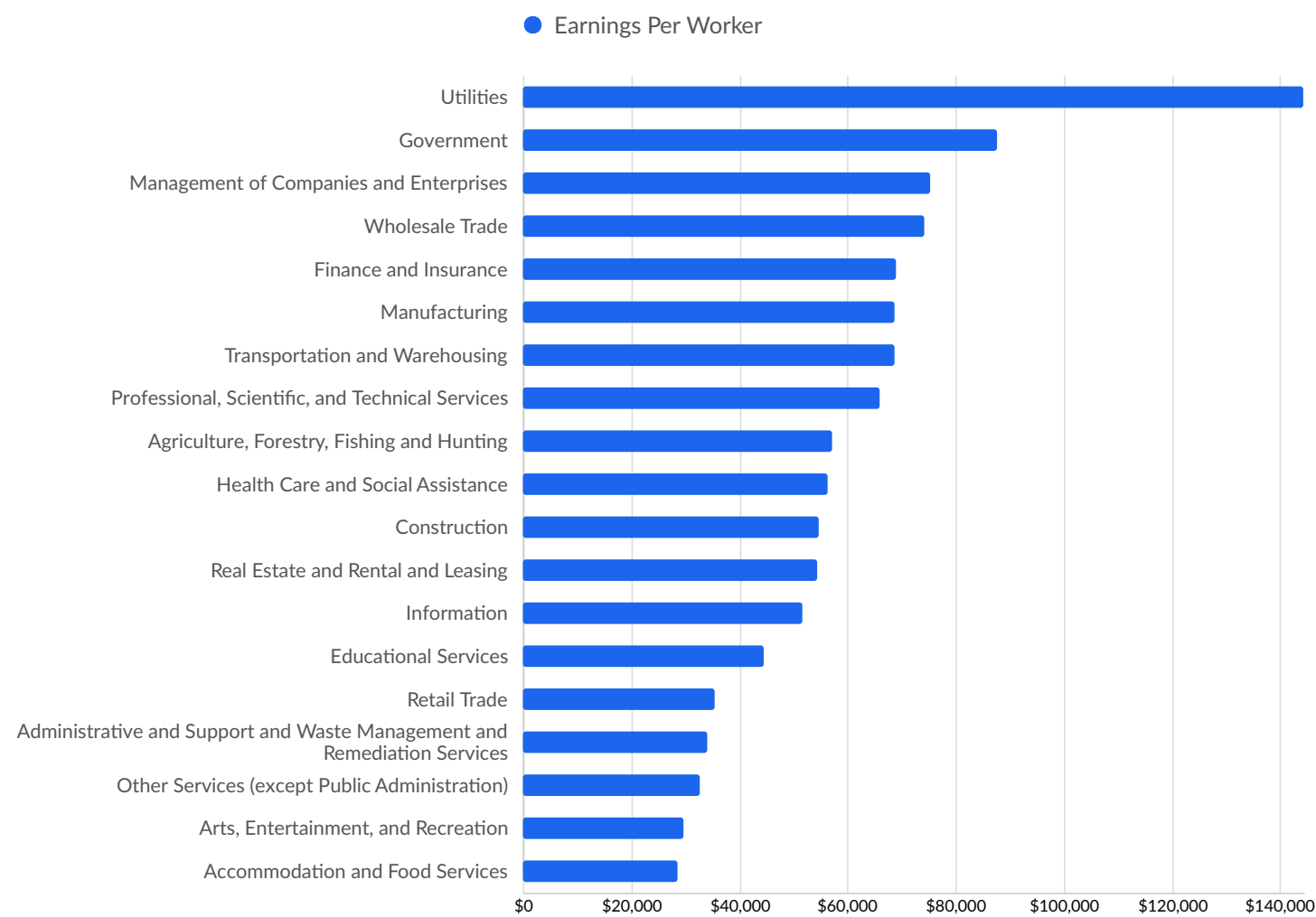


Top Industry GRP

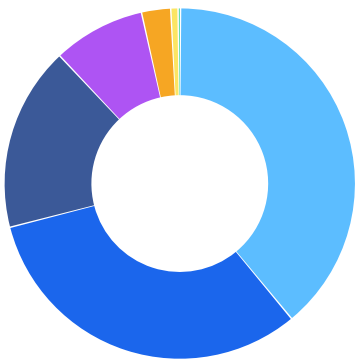

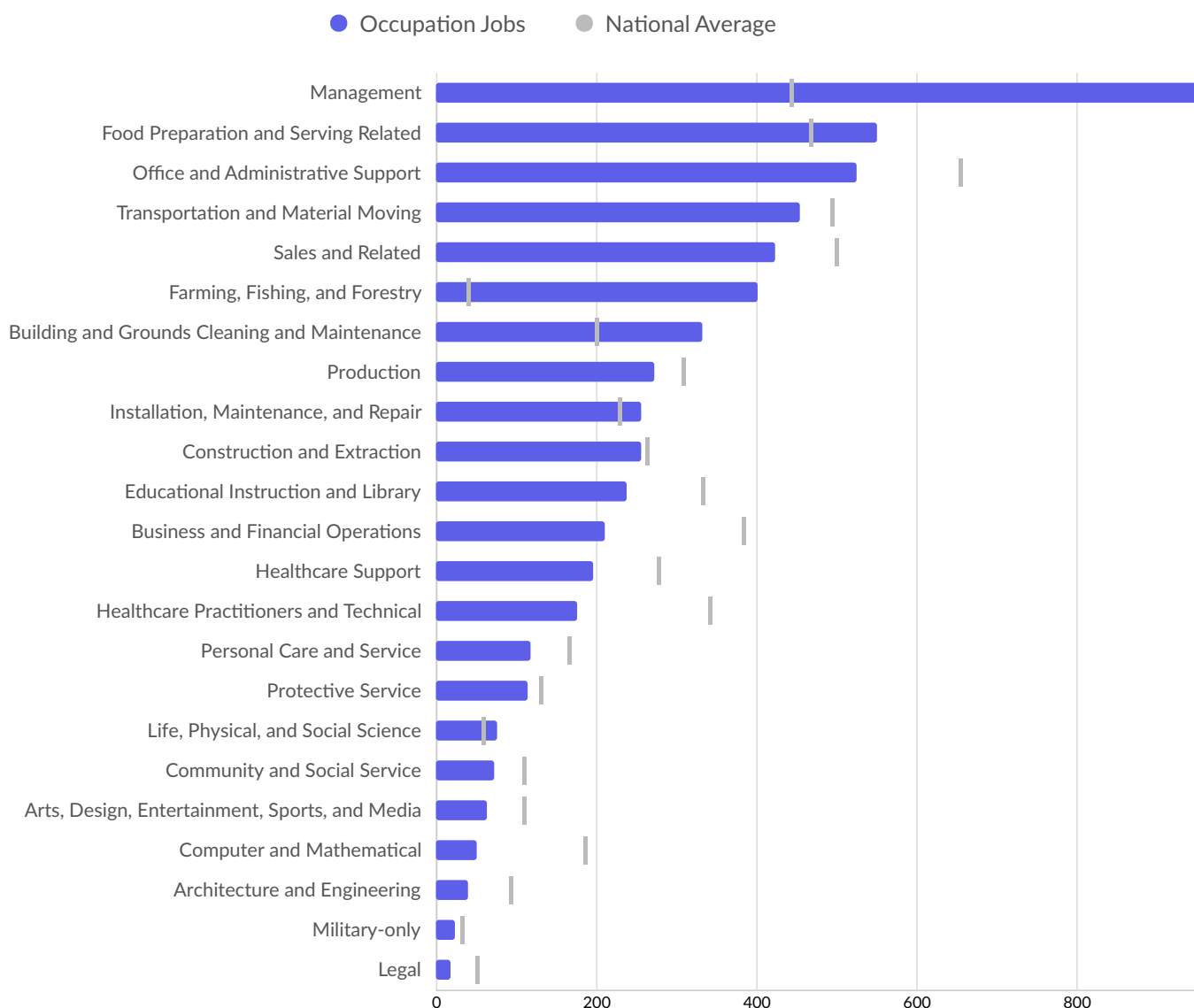

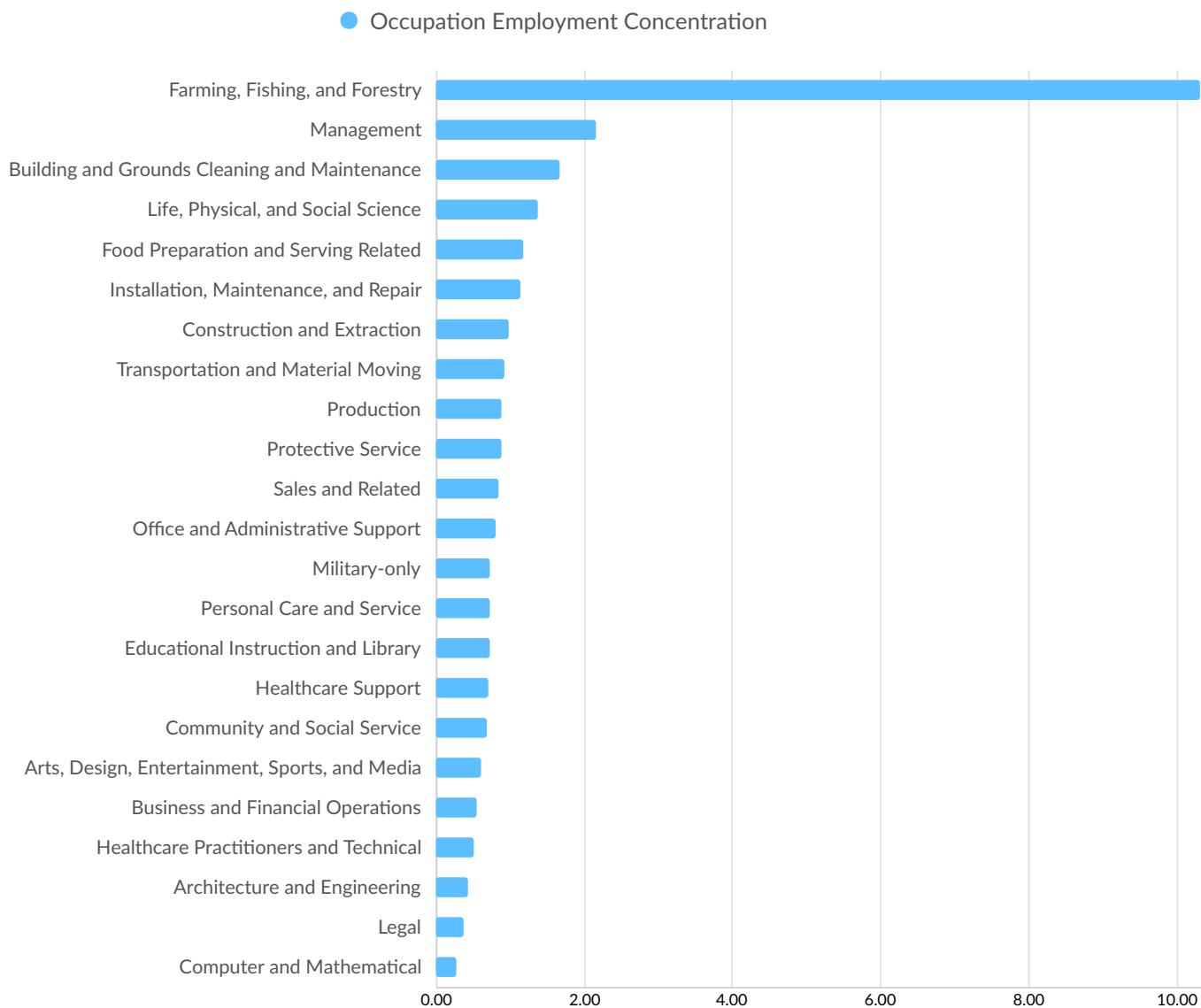

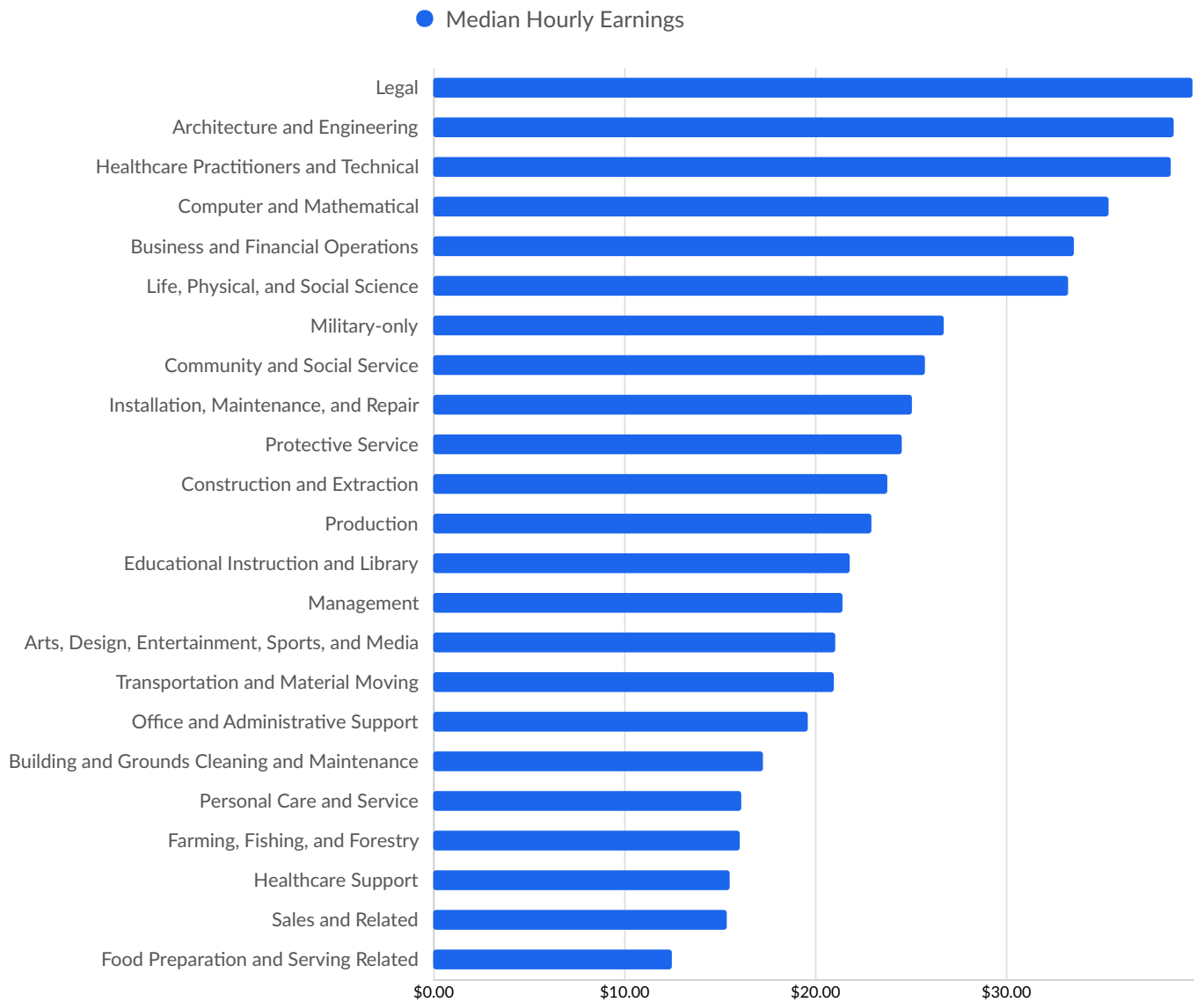
Top Growing Occupations



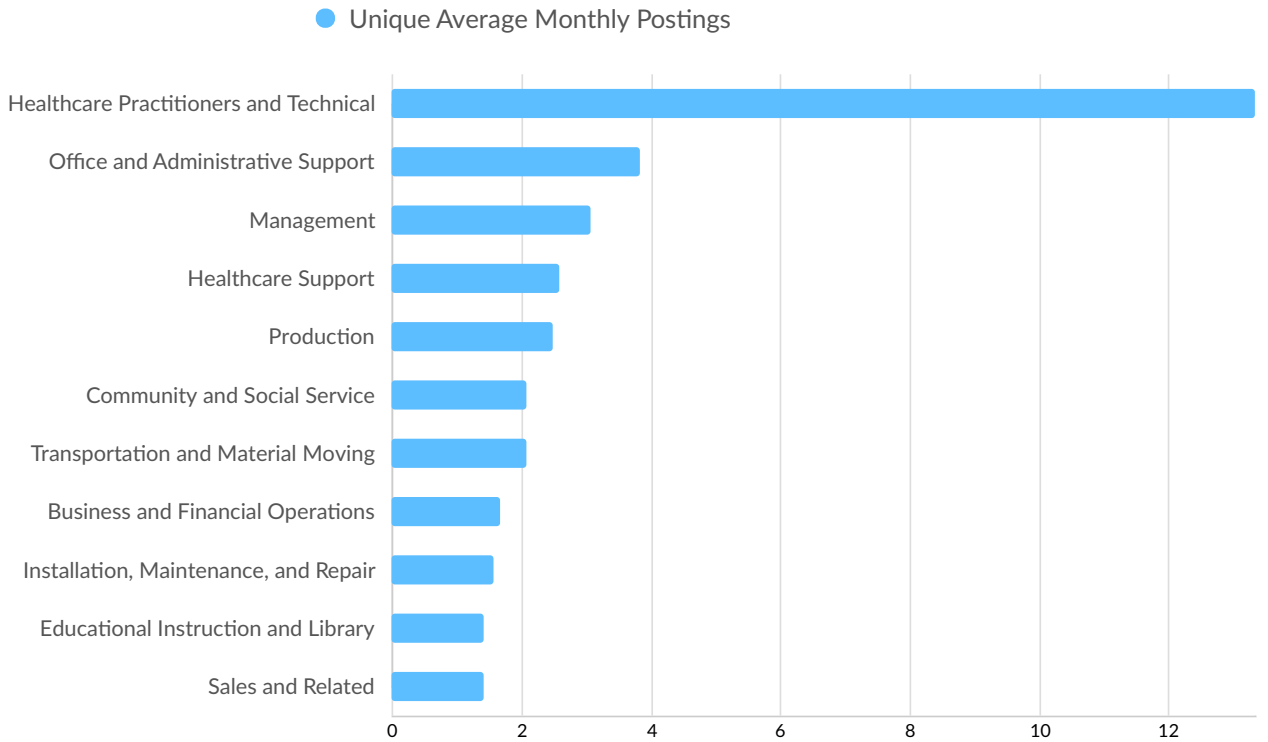
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



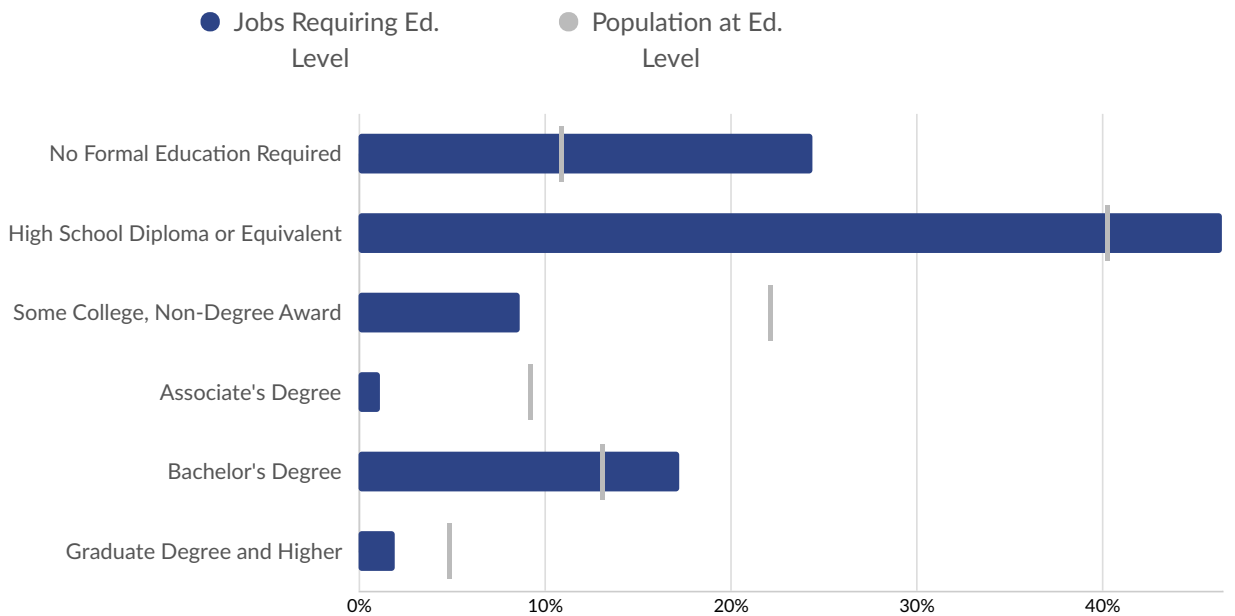
