


### **Takeaways**

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 7.3% since 2019, growing by 1,478. Population is expected to increase by 4.4% between 2024 and 2029, adding 964.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 1.7% in Adams County, WI from 5,731 to 5,829. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.1% by 2.4%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 49.4% to 44.4% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.0% of Adams County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.5% below the national average), and **9.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Crop Production, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Traveler Accommodation.













## **Job Trends**






Adams County, WI had a March 2025 unemployment rate of 6.43%, decreasing from 9.63% 5 years before.




#### **Veterans**

Adams County, WI has 1,766 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,087.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in Adams County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 6,475 people 55 or older, while there are 11,079 here.




#### **Violent Crime**

Racial diversity is low in Adams County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,933 racially diverse people, while there are 2,293 here.




#### **Property Crime**










### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**








### **Top Occupation Employment Concentration**




