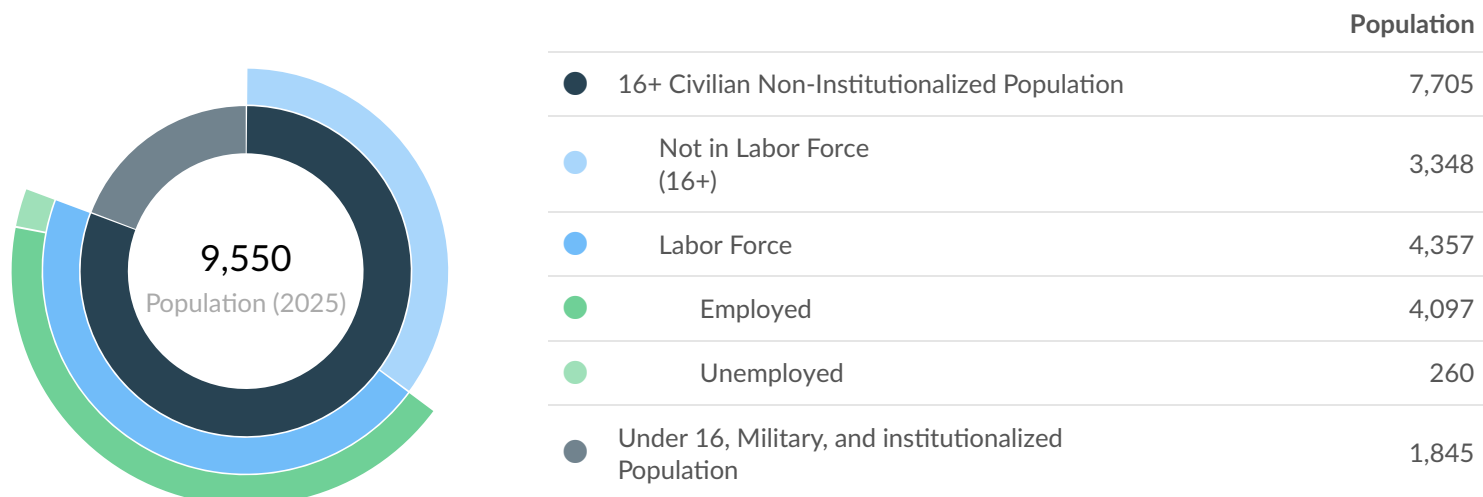
Median household income is **\$19.6K below** the national median household income of \$75.1K.

- As of 2024 the region's population **increased by 4.5%** since 2019, growing by 411. Population is expected to **increase by 4.3%** between 2024 and 2029, adding 410.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs **declined by 0.7%** in Forest County, WI from 3,659 to **3,634**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 4.1% by 4.8%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 60.0% to 55.3% between 2019 and 2024**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.3% of Forest County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.2% below the national average), and **12.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.8% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.

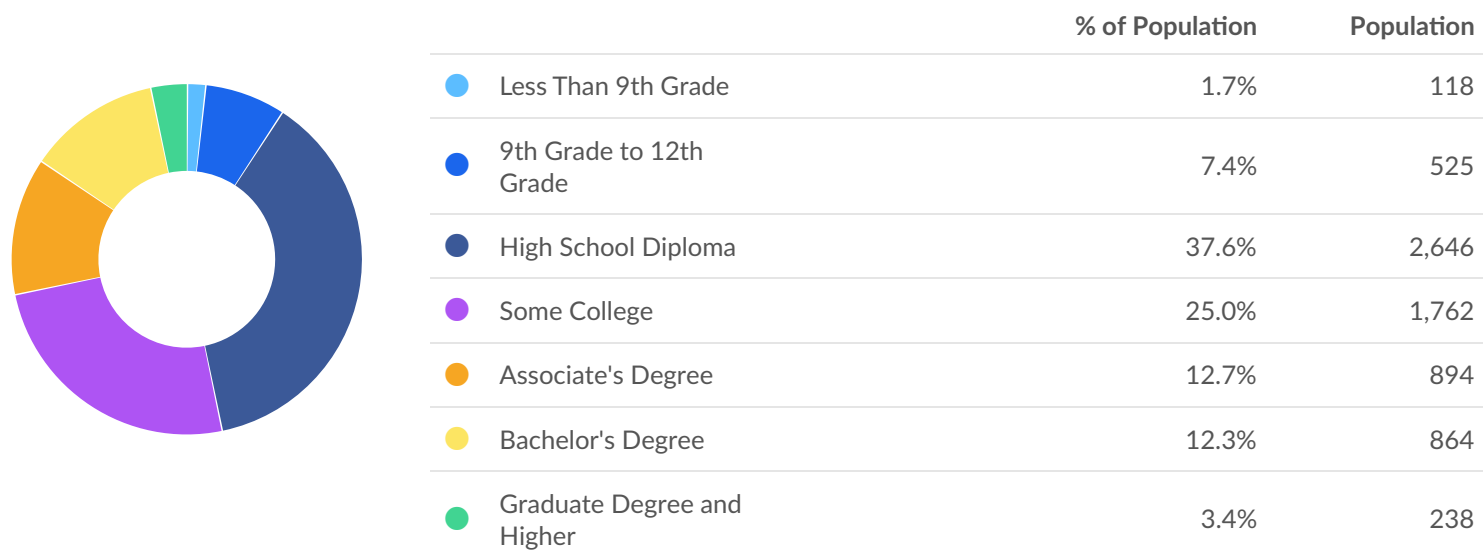

Mar 2025 Labor Force Breakdown



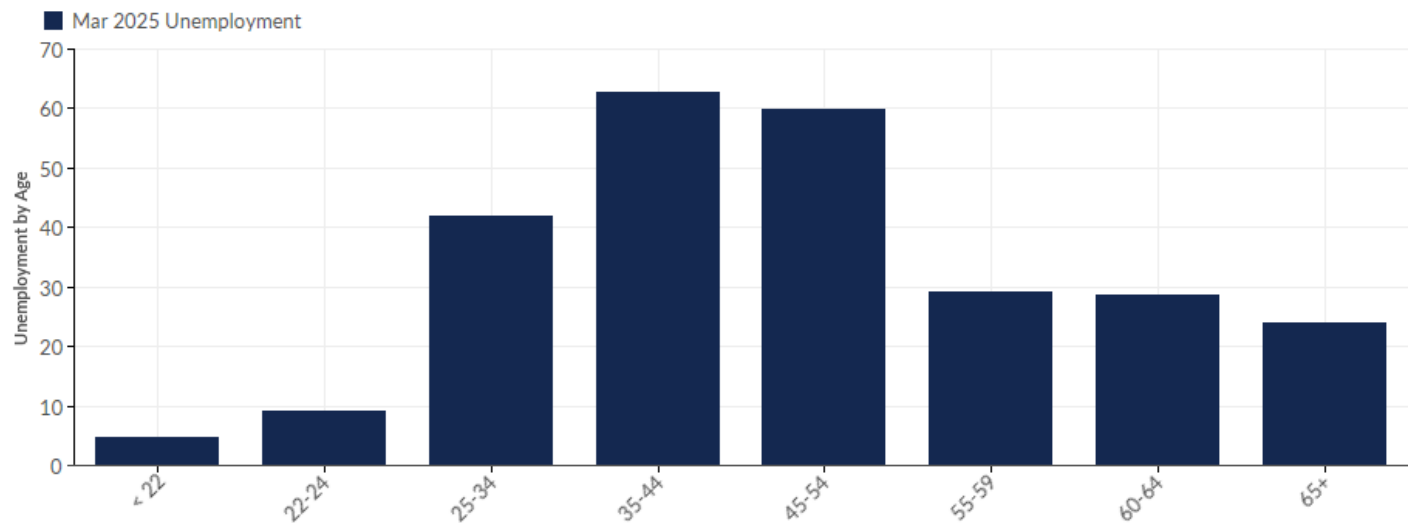
Educational Attainment

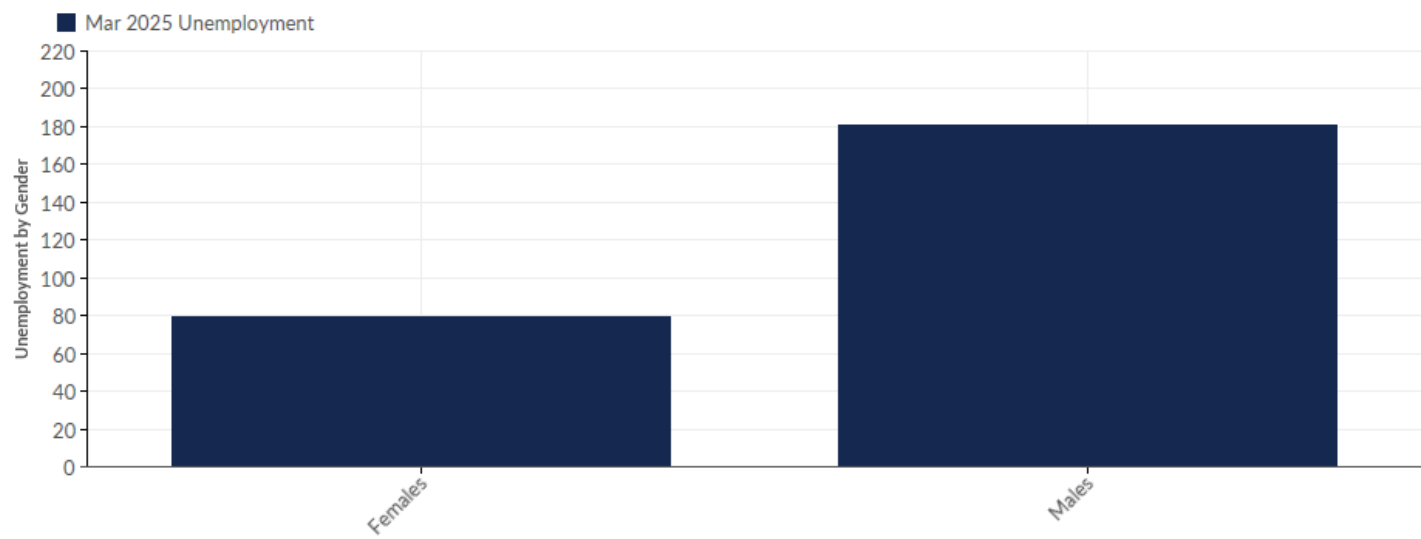

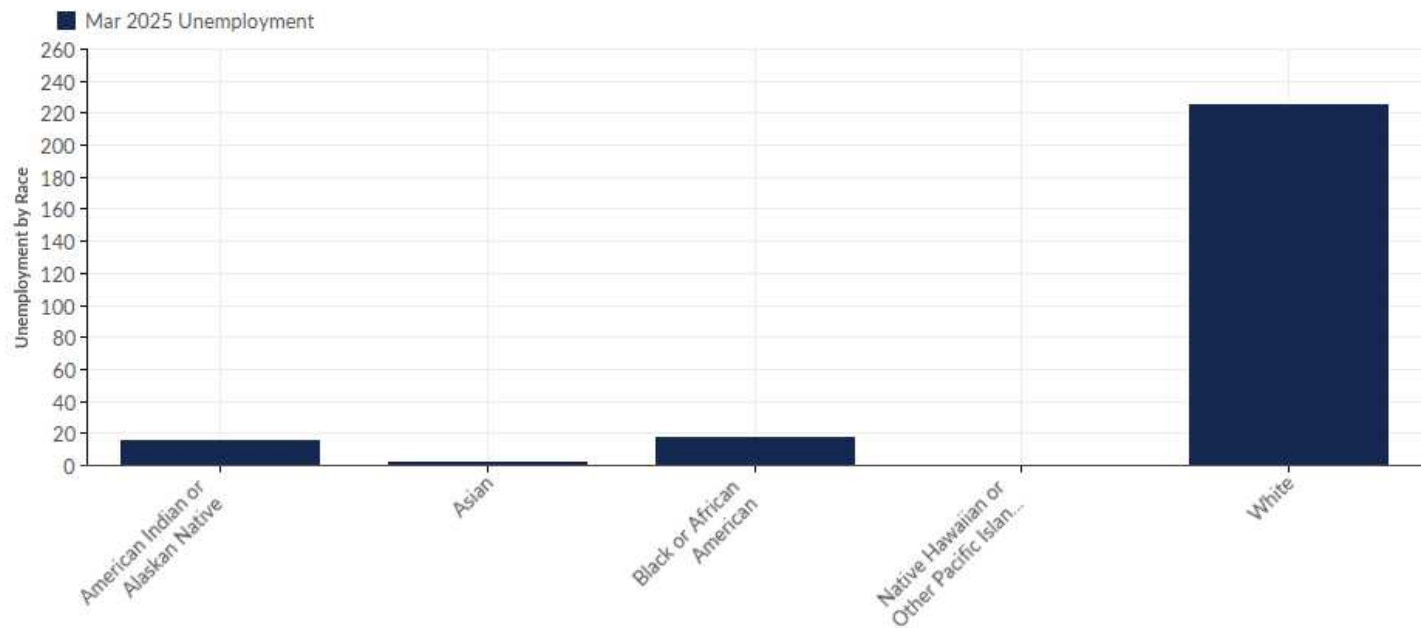

Unemployment by Gender



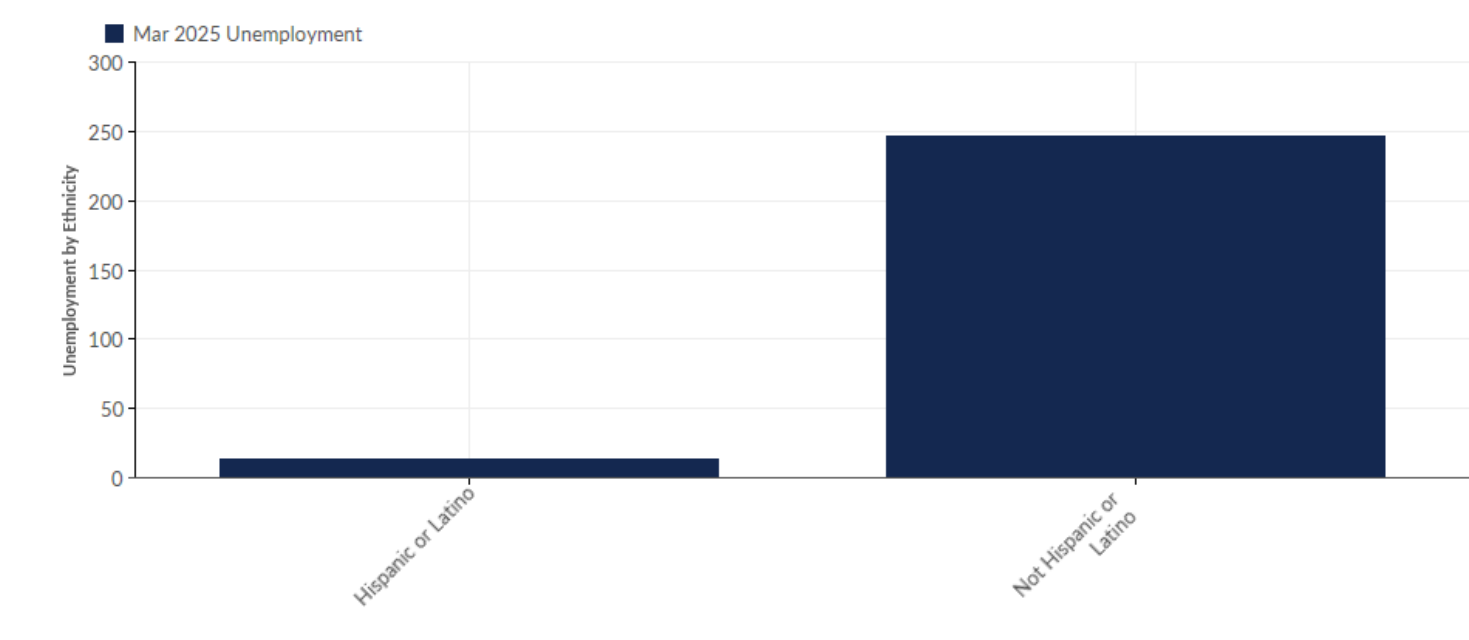

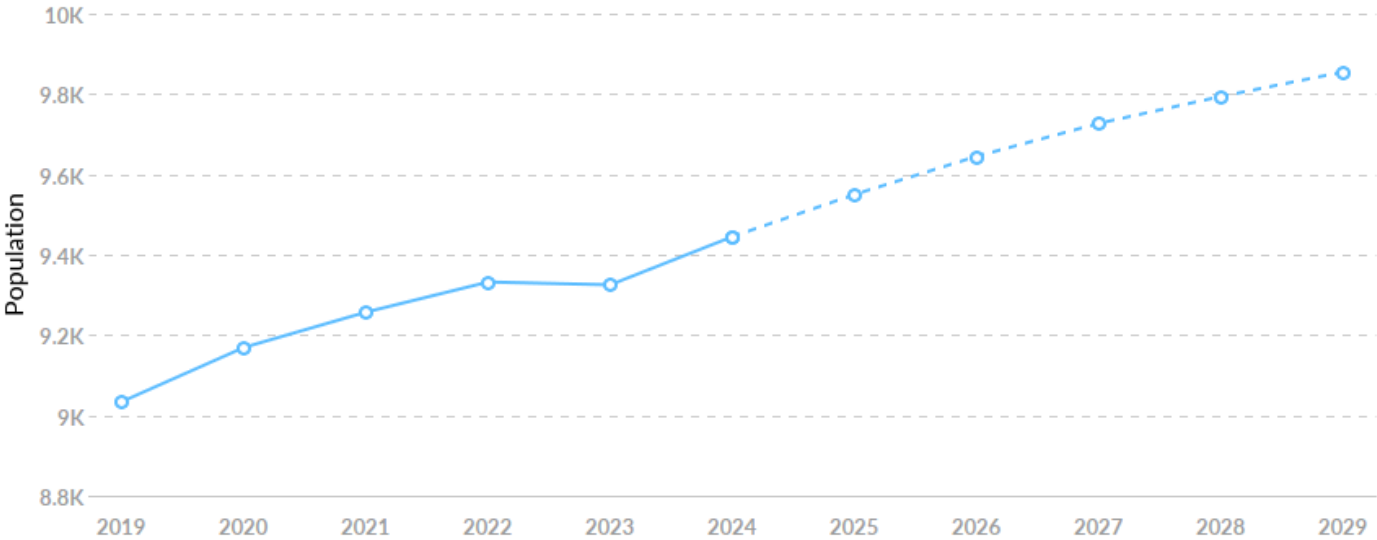

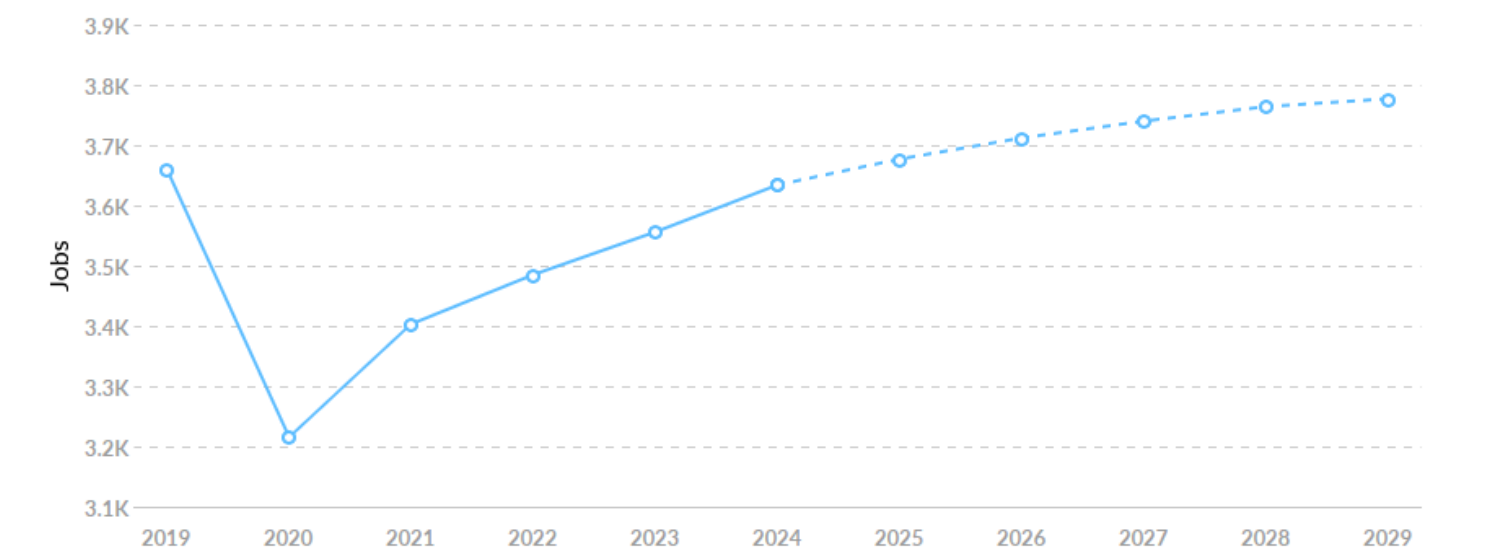

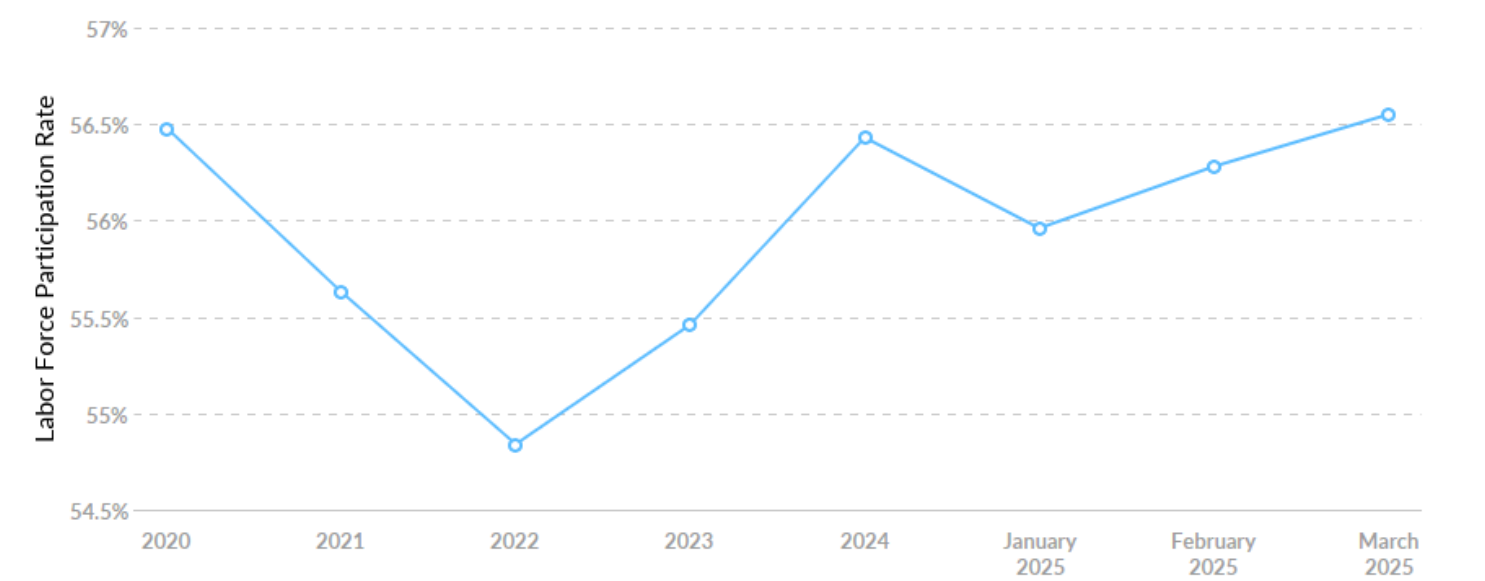
Job Trends

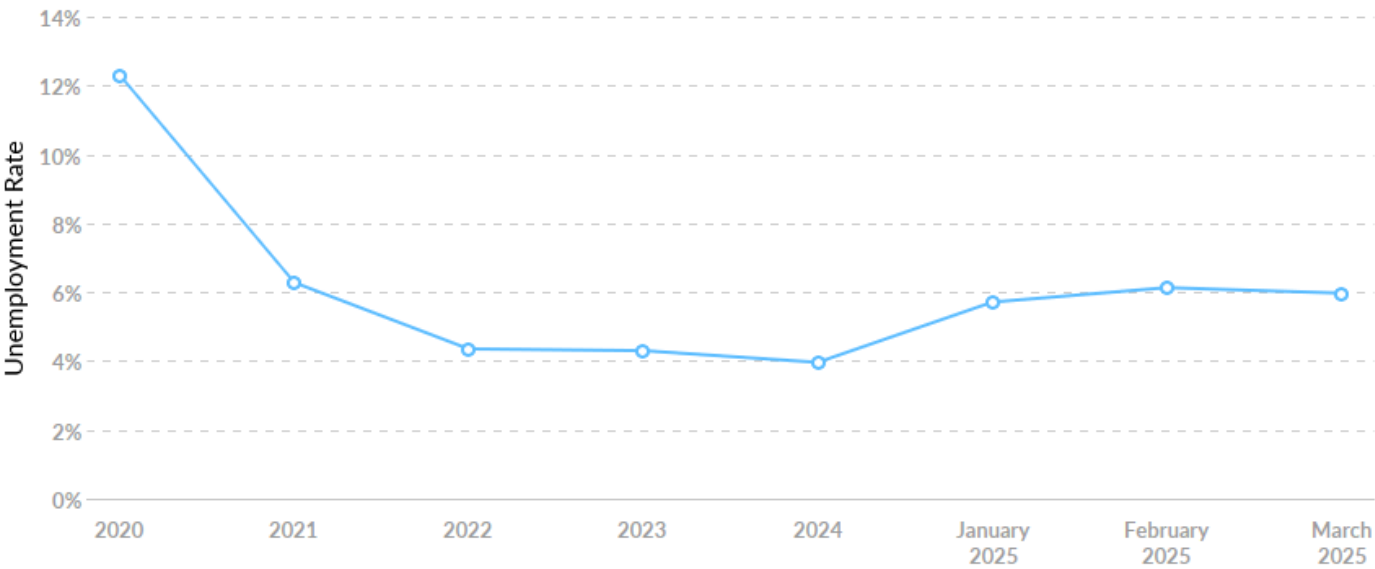

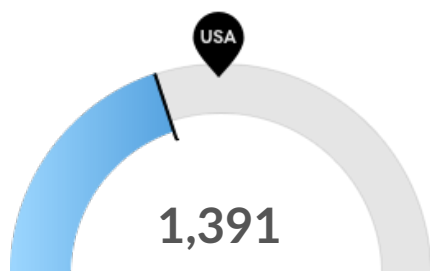
Unemployment Rate Trends

Forest County, WI had a March 2025 unemployment rate of 5.97%,**decreasing from 12.30%** 5 years before.



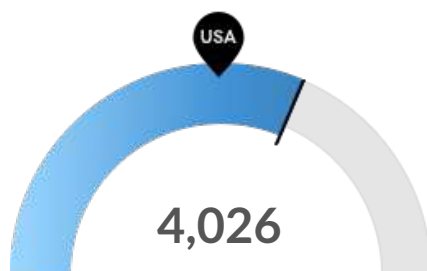

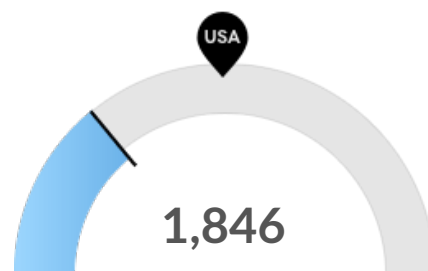
Millennials

Forest County, WI has 1,391 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 1,895.



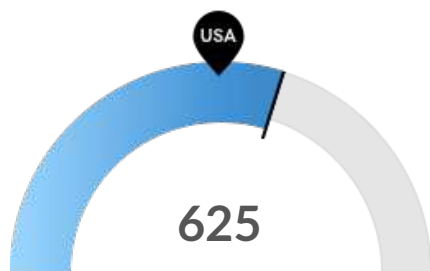
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Forest County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 2,815 people 55 or older, while there are 4,026 here.



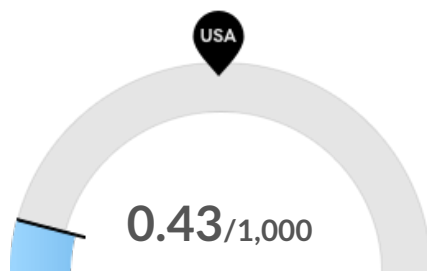
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Forest County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 3,884 racially diverse people, while there are 1,846 here.



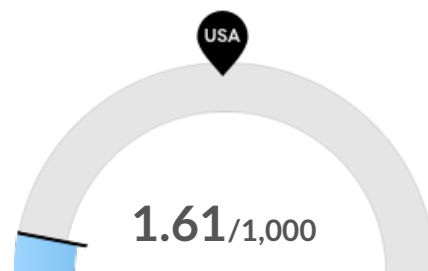
Veterans

Forest County, WI has 0.43 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.

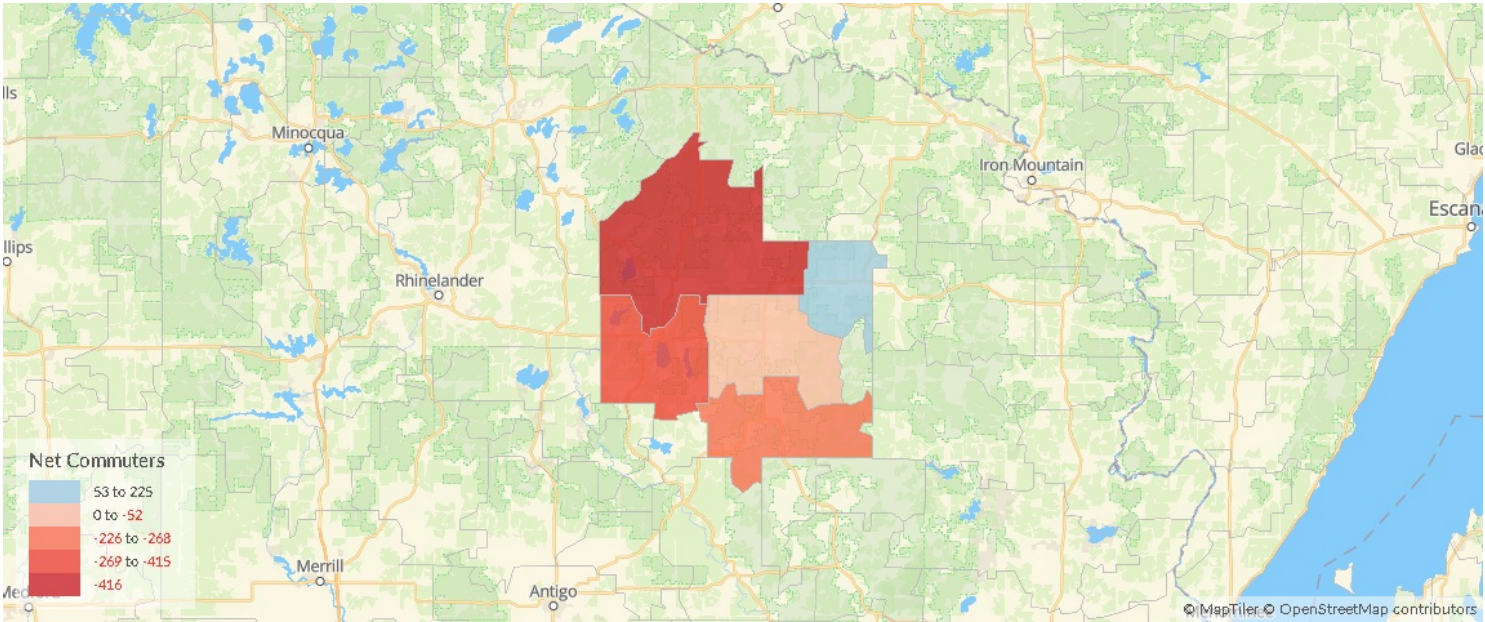


Property Crime

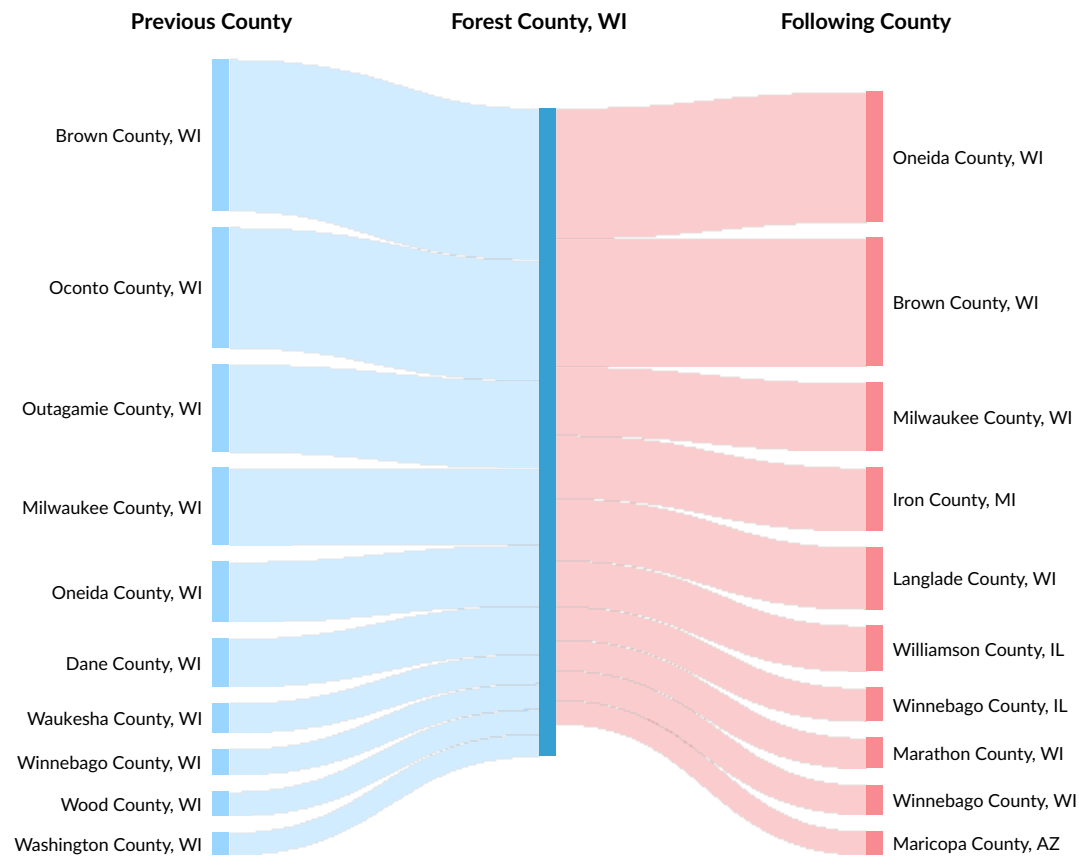

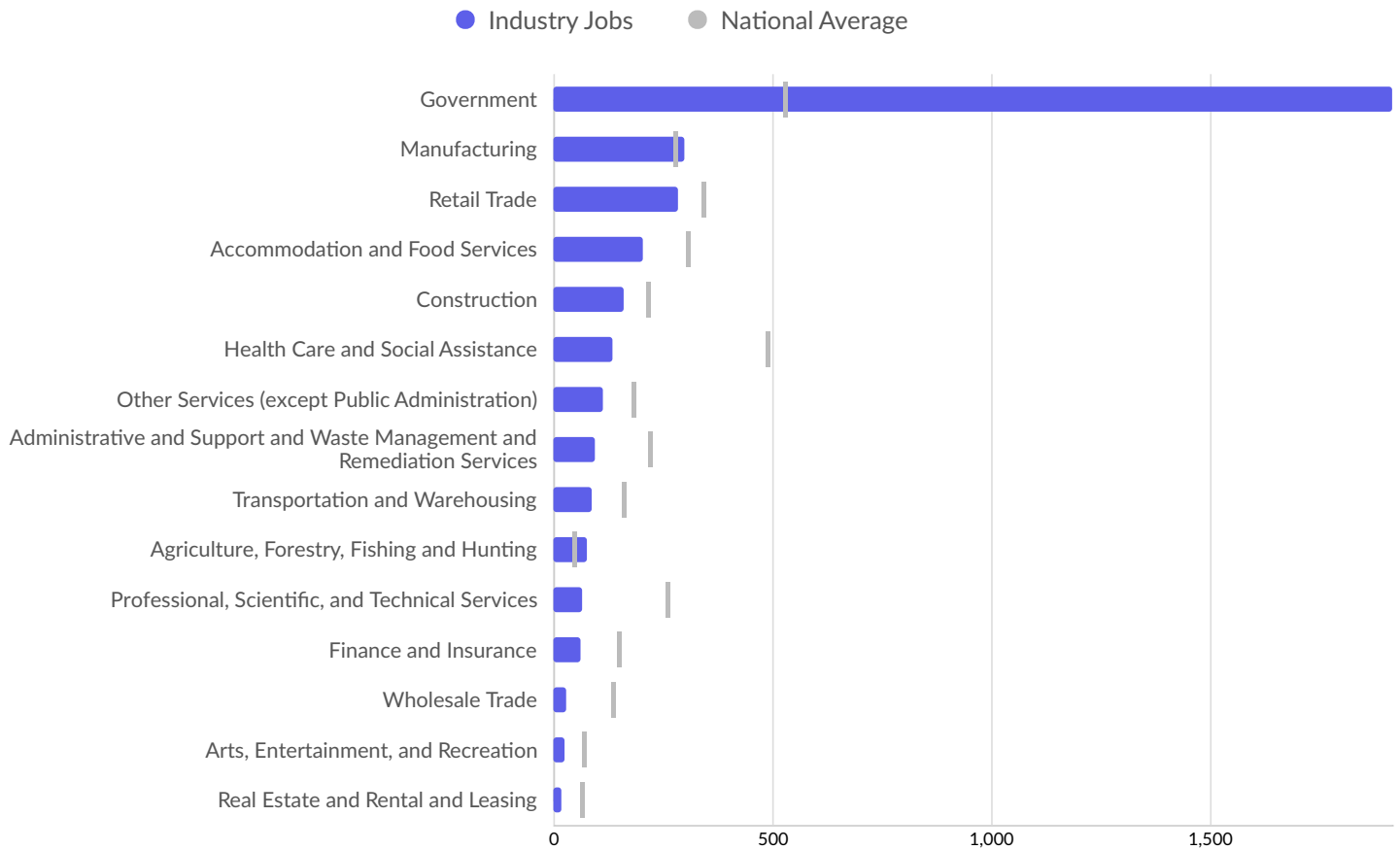

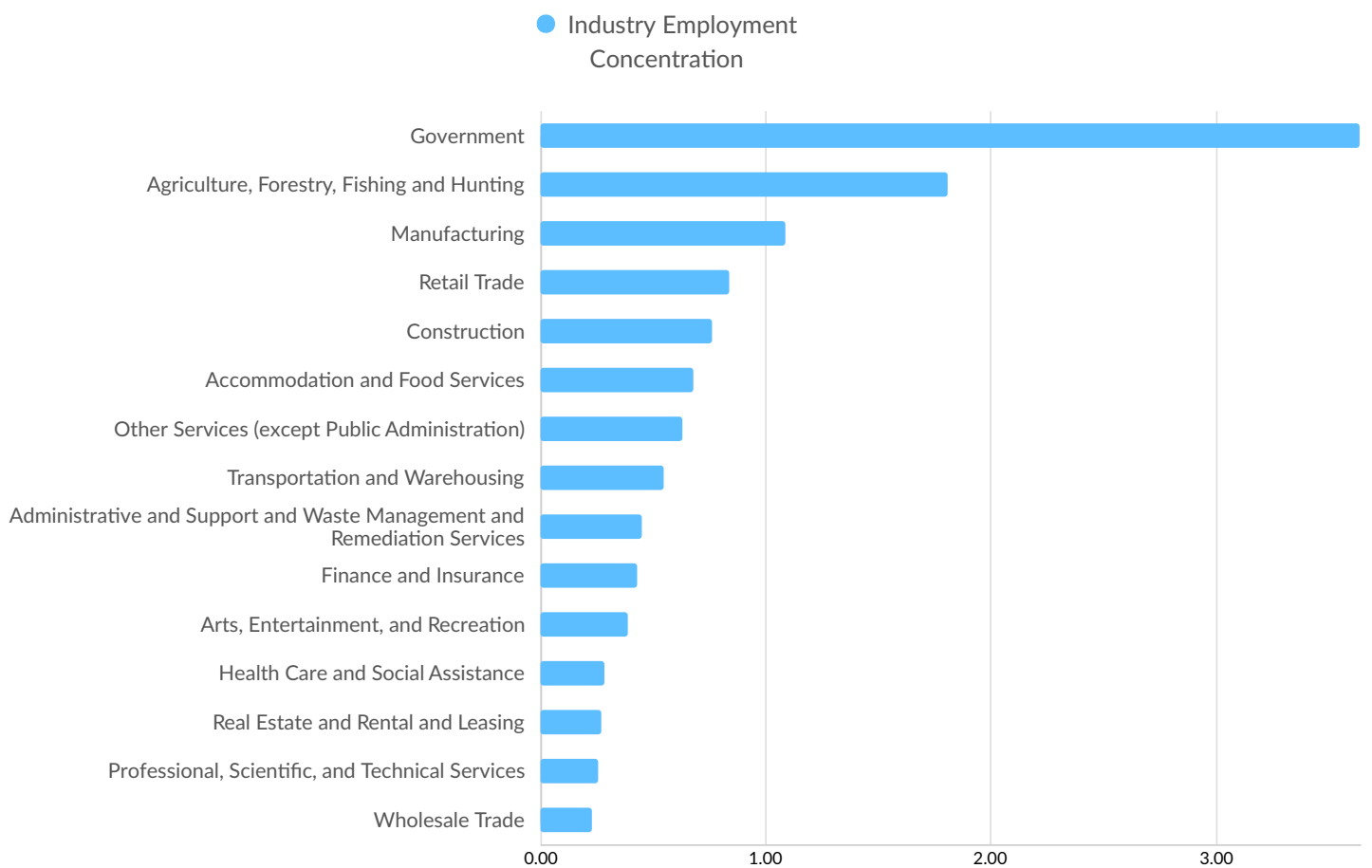

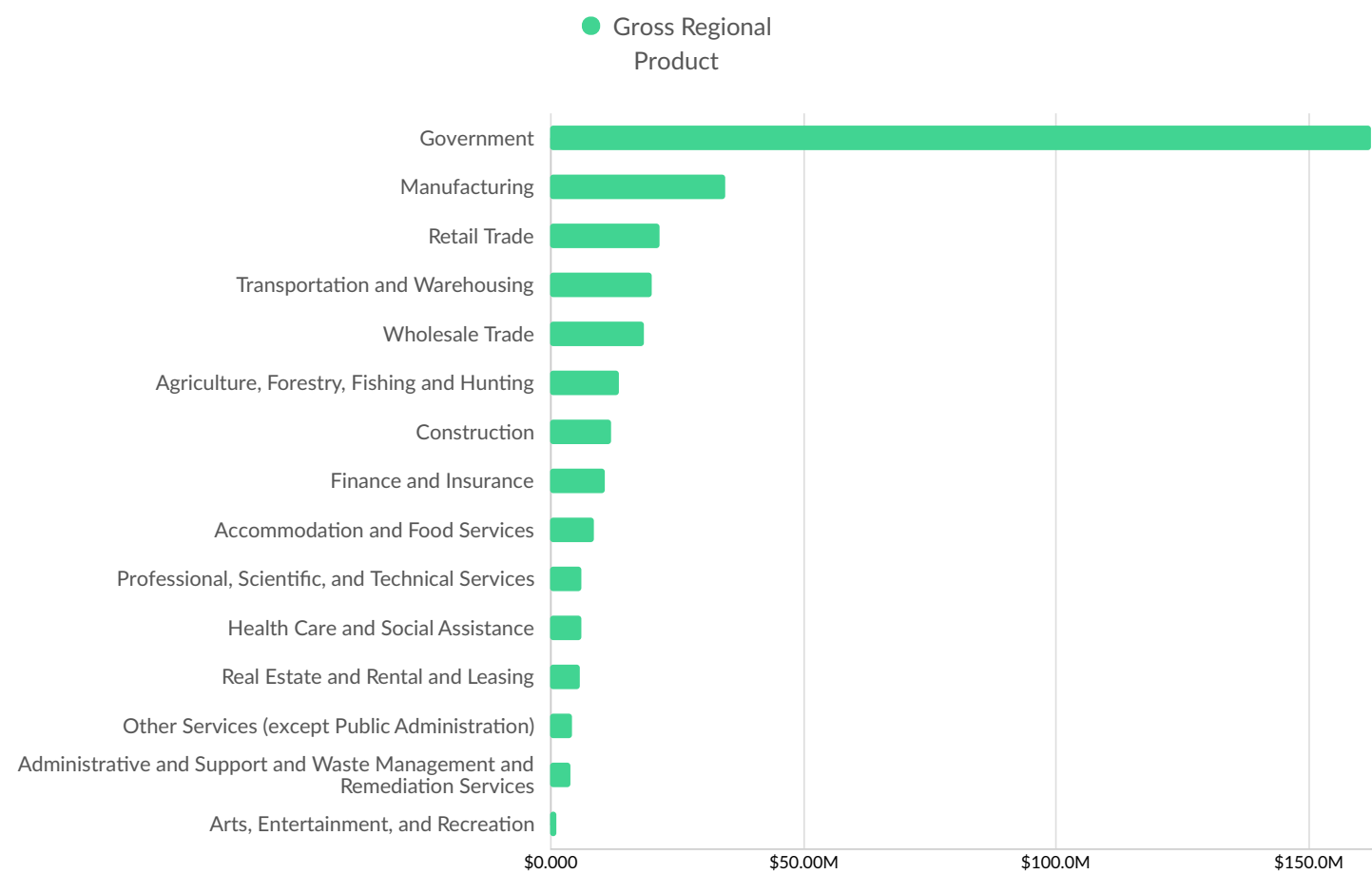
Top Growing Industries

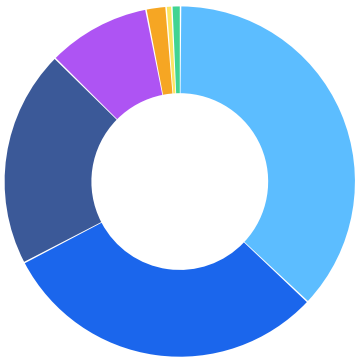

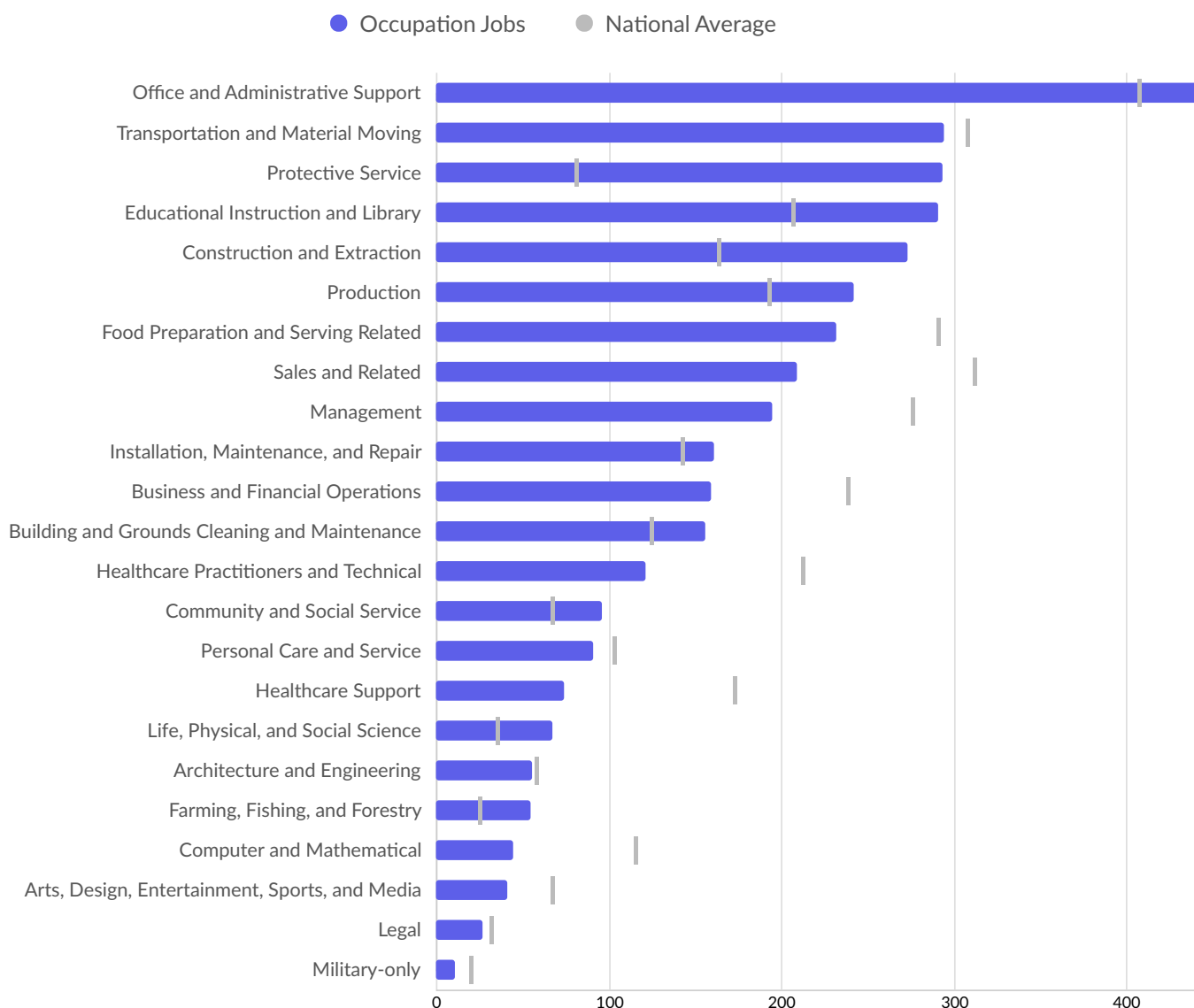

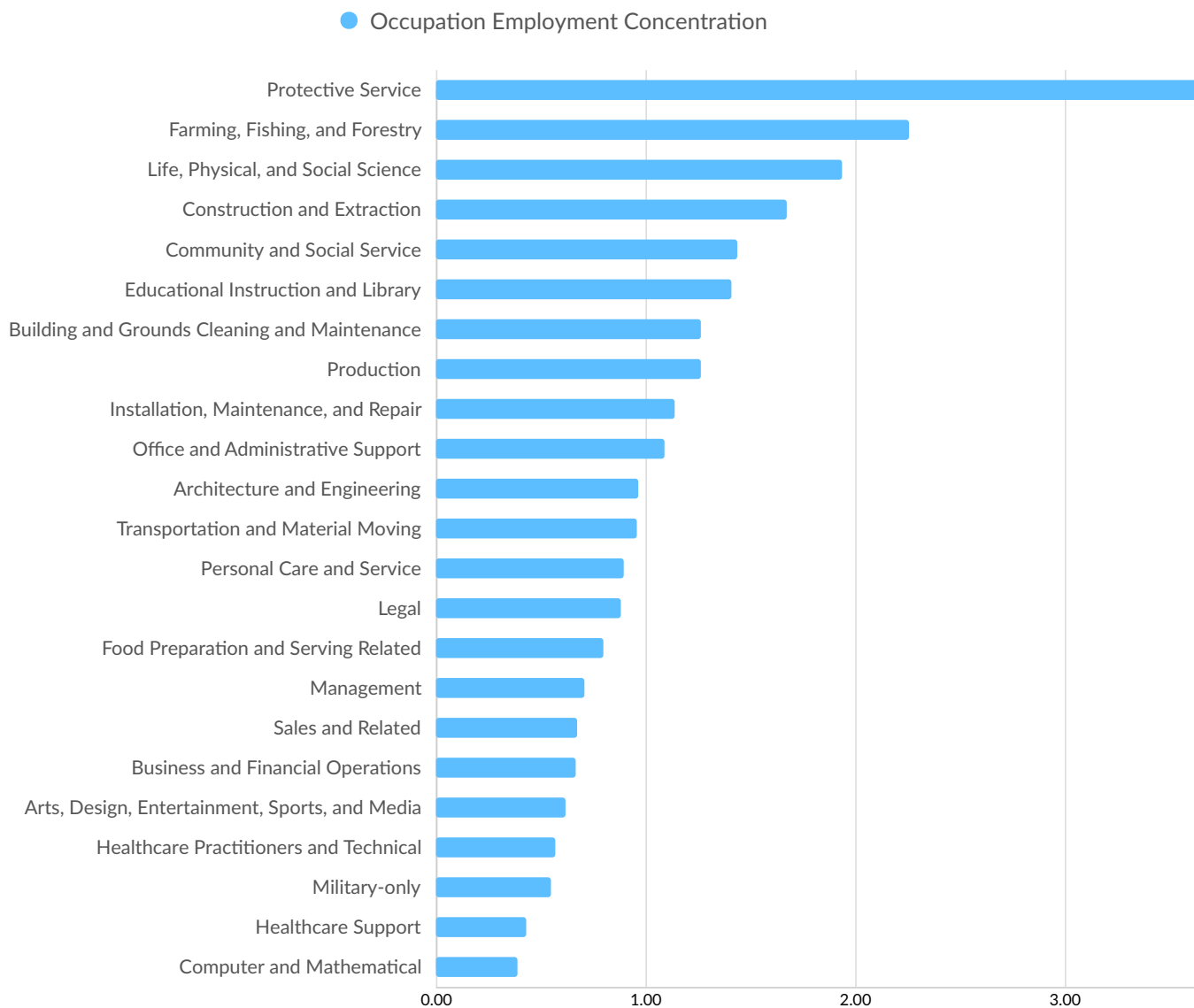

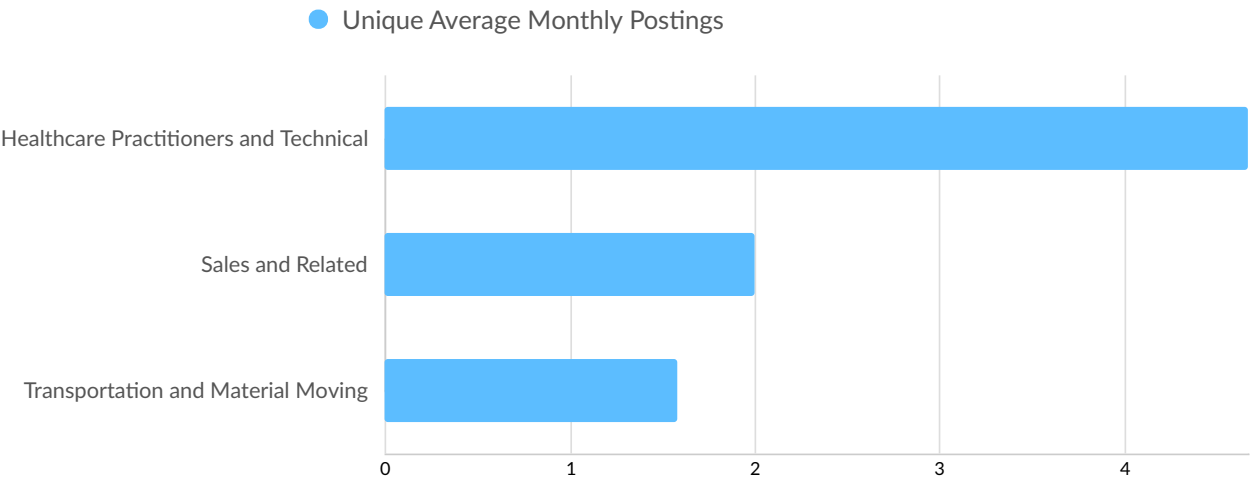
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



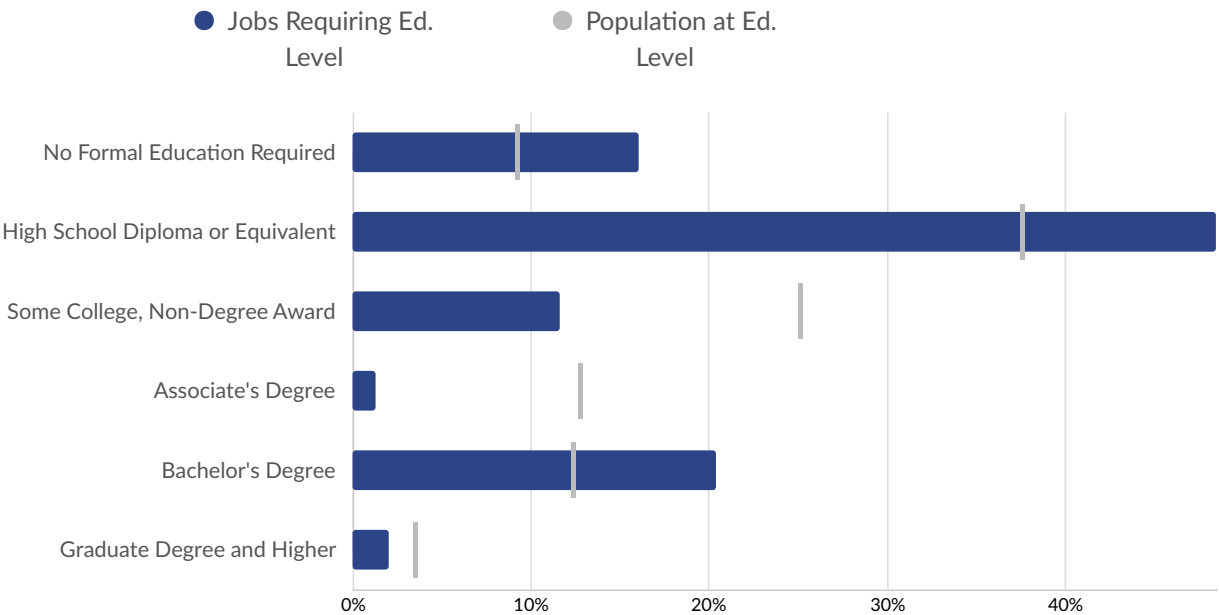
