- From 2019 to 2024, jobs declined by 0.3% in Langlade County, WI from 8,781 to 8,753. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.1% by 4.4%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 59.3% to 56.2% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.5% of Langlade County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.0% below the national average), and **10.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Crop Production, Warehouse Clubs, Supercenters, and Other General Merchandise Retailers, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).












Langlade County, WI had a March 2025 unemployment rate of 4.76%, decreasing from 6.79% 5 years before.















### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**






### **Top Occupation Employment Concentration**




