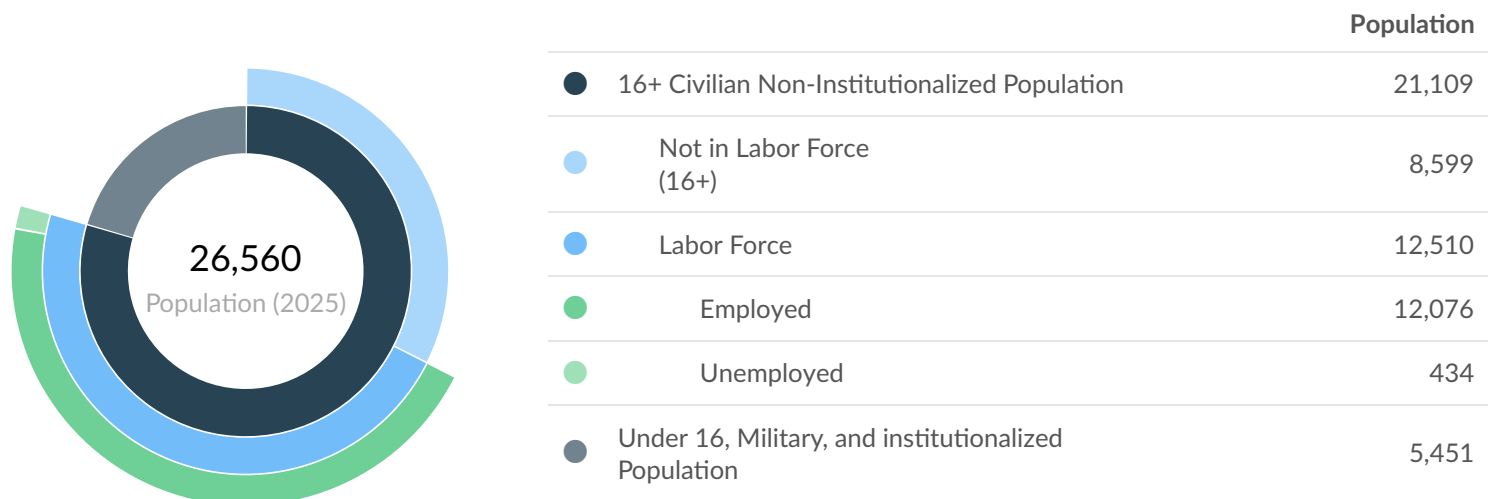
Median household income is **\$13.4K below** the national median household income of \$78.5K.

Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population **declined by 0.4%** since 2019, falling by 95. Population is expected to **decrease by 1.1%** between 2024 and 2029, losing 285.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs **declined by 1.0%** in Juneau County, WI from 10,599 to **10,497**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 4.3% by 5.3%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 61.5% to 59.3% between 2019 and 2024**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.1% of Juneau County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.4% below the national average), and **11.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.1% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Education and Hospitals (State Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

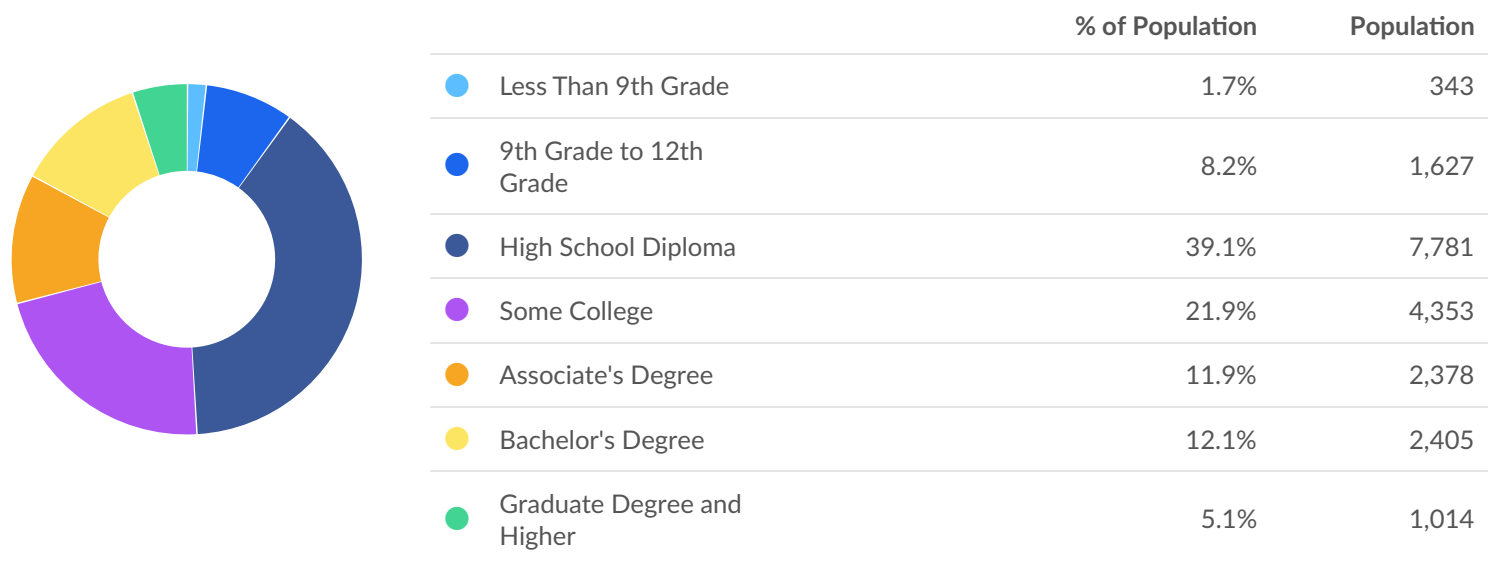

May 2025 Labor Force Breakdown



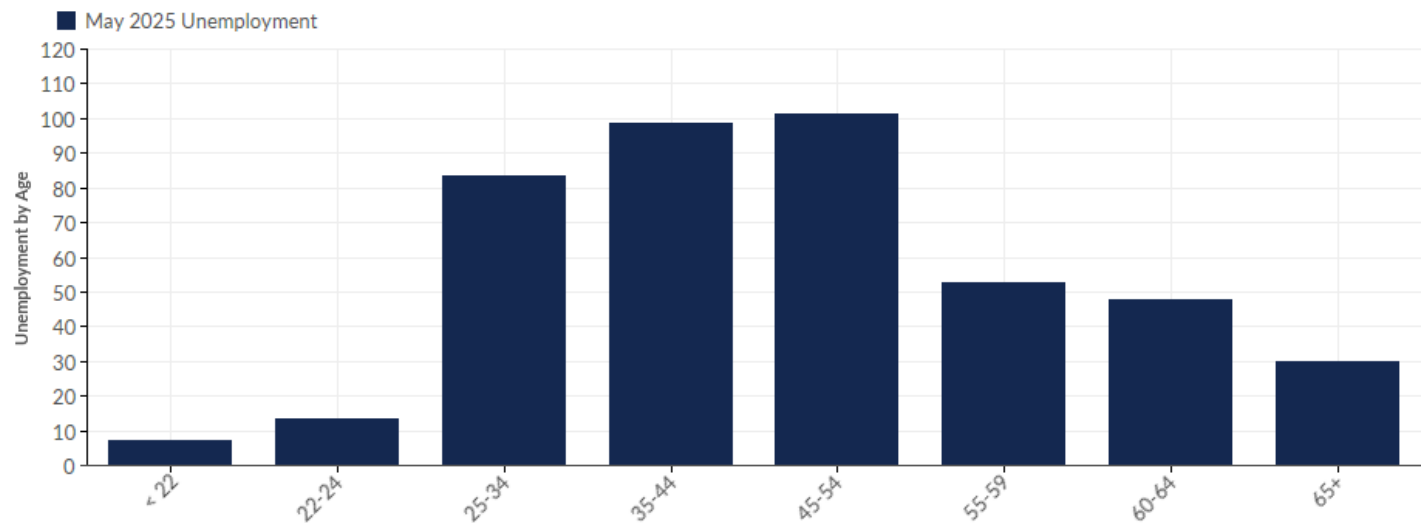
Educational Attainment

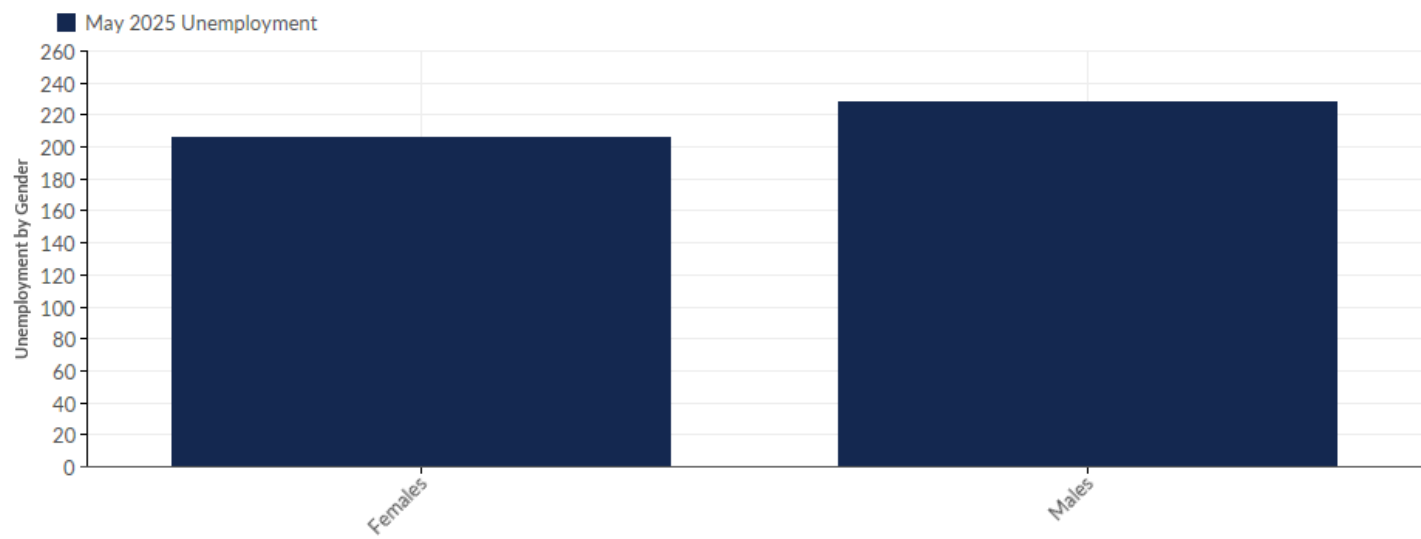

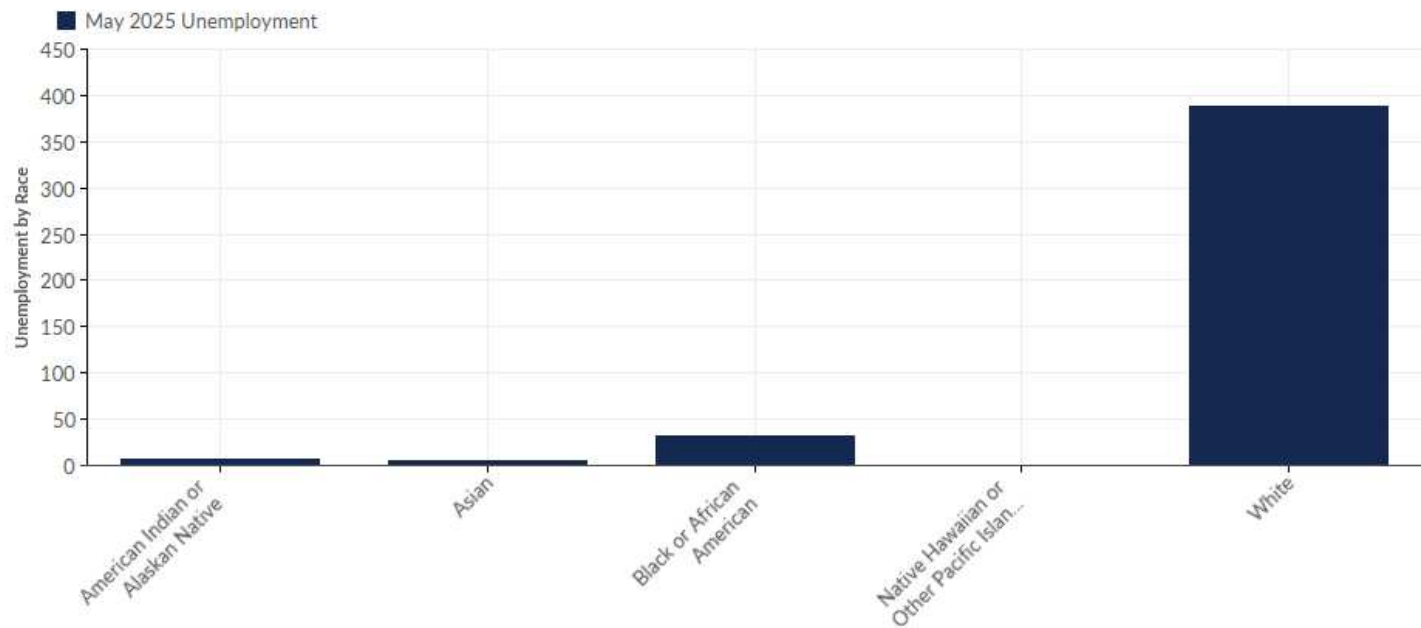

Unemployment by Gender



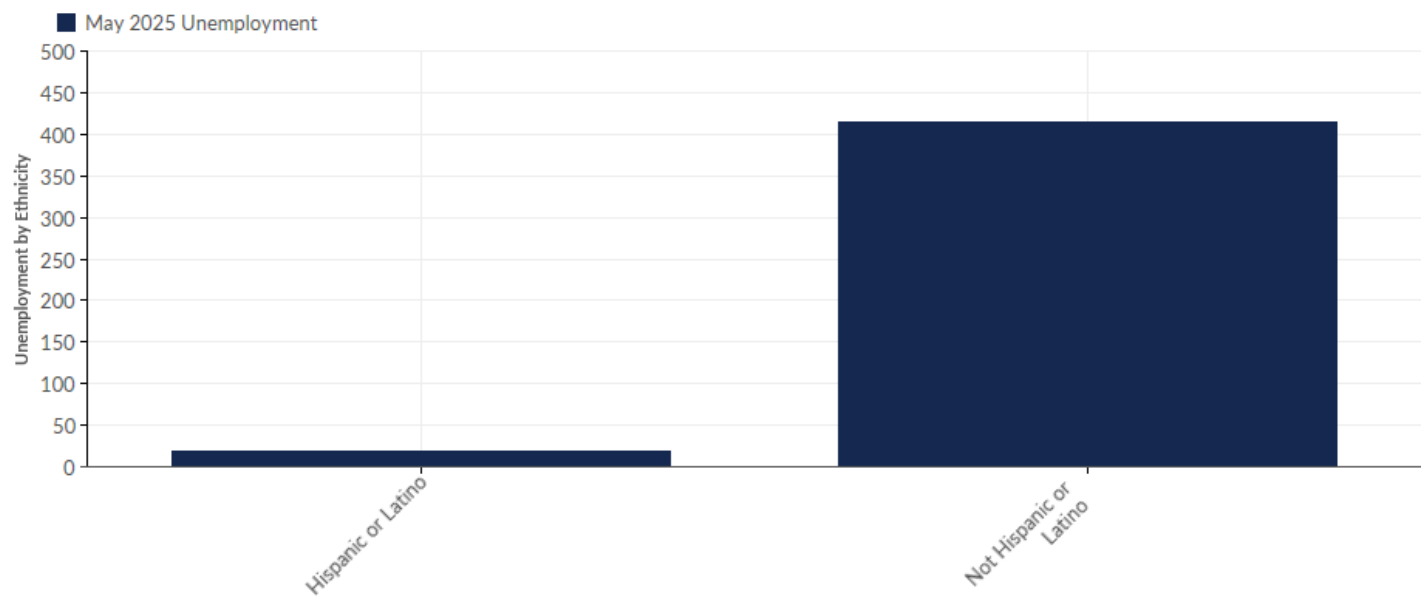

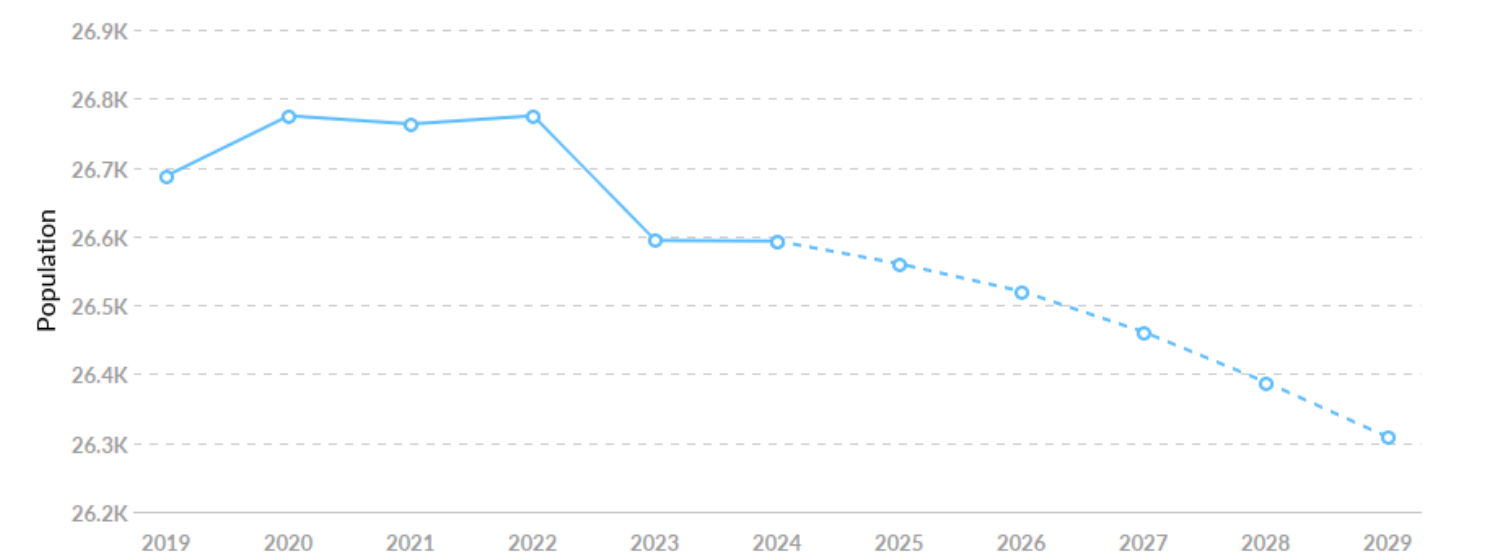

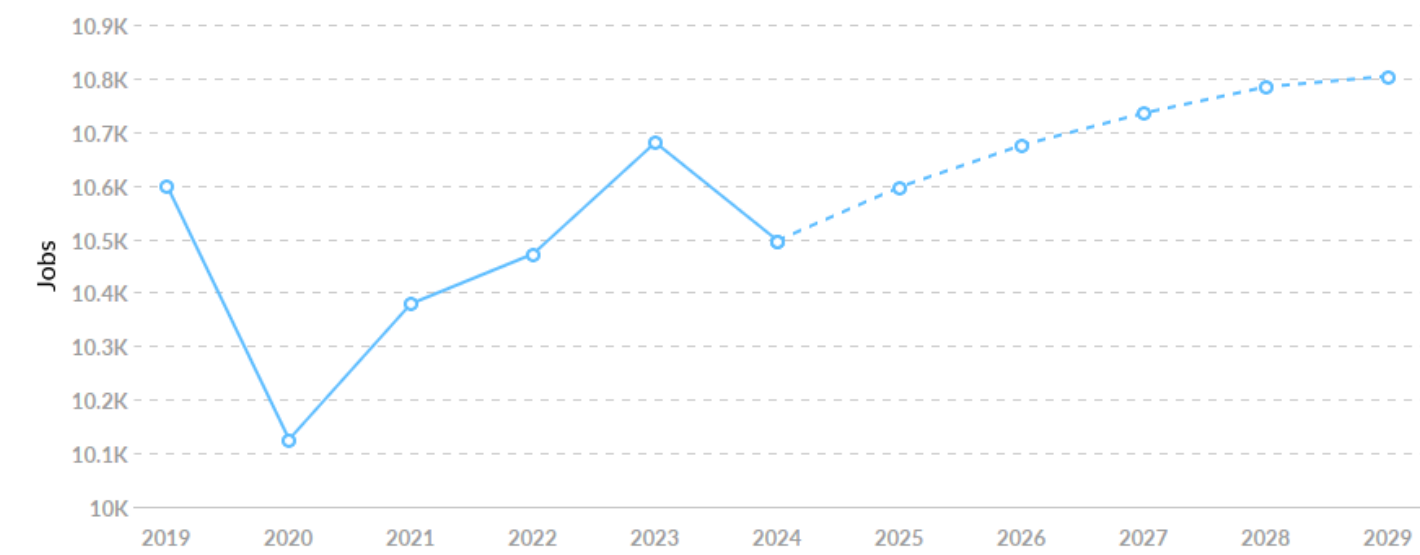

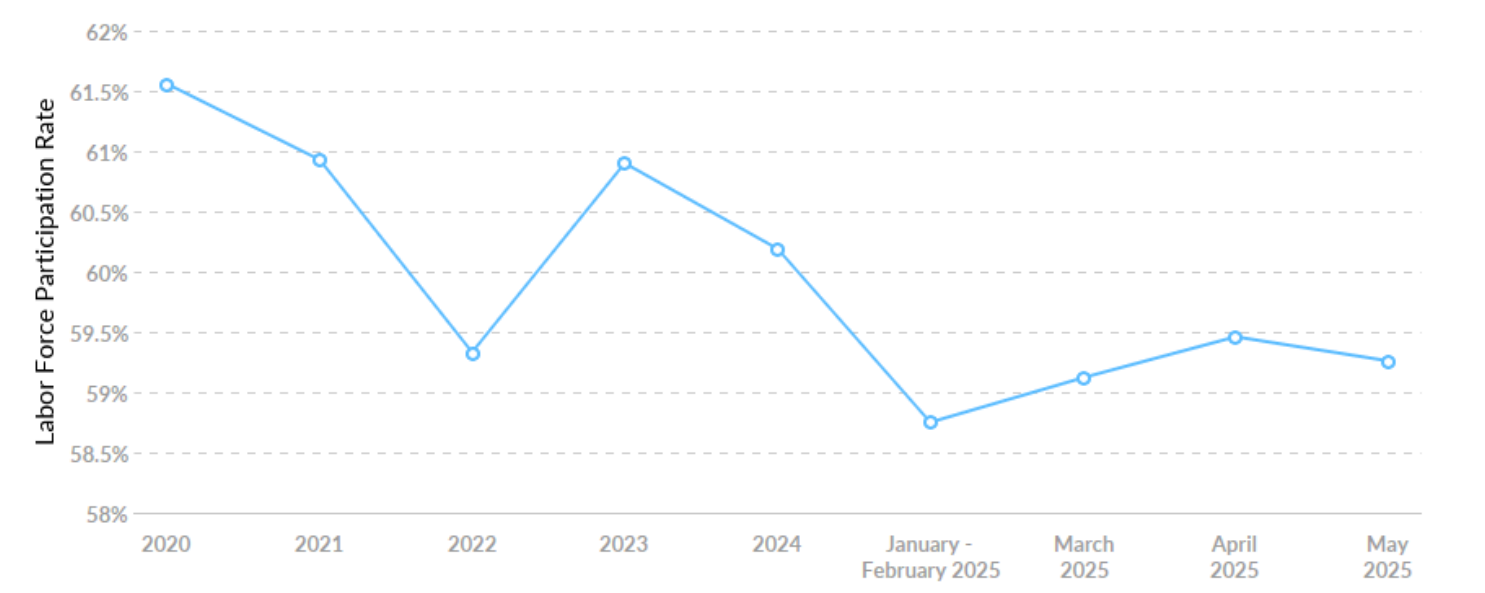
Job Trends

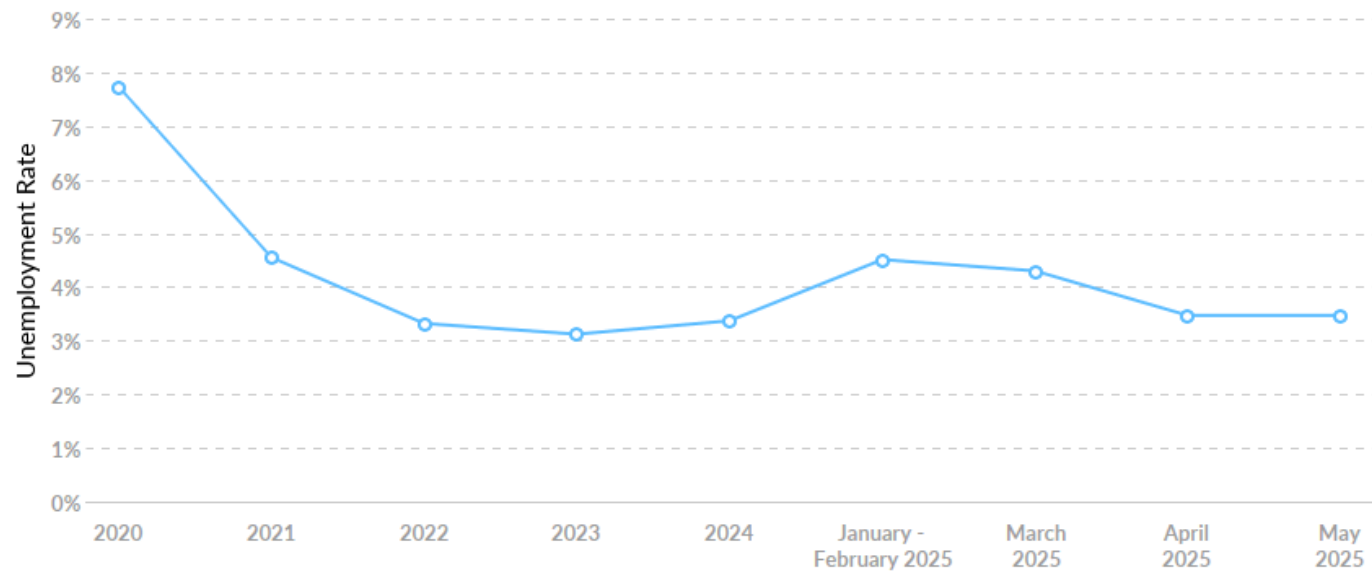

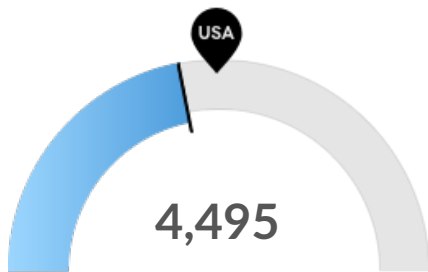
Unemployment Rate Trends

Juneau County, WI had a May 2025 unemployment rate of 3.47%, **decreasing from 7.73%** 5 years before.



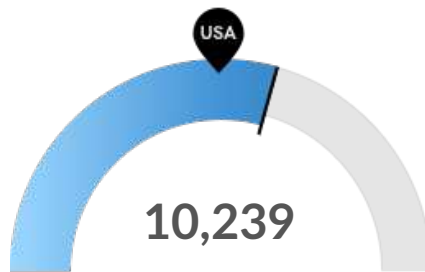

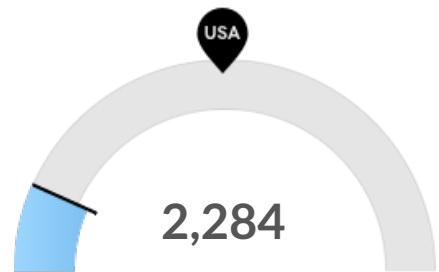
Millennials

Juneau County, WI has 4,495 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 5,403.



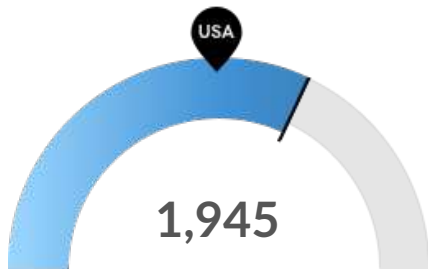
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Juneau County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,028 people 55 or older, while there are 10,239 here.



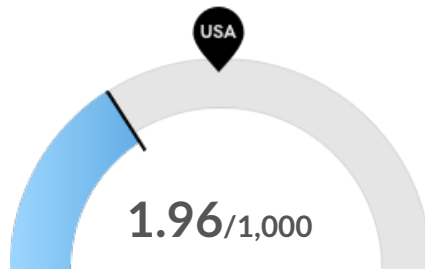
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Juneau County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 11,076 racially diverse people, while there are 2,284 here.



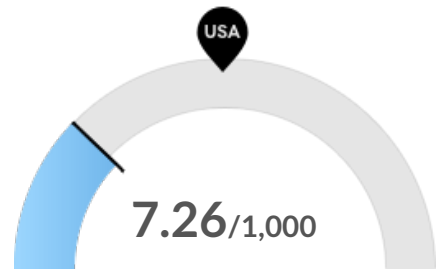
Veterans

Juneau County, WI has 1.96 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.

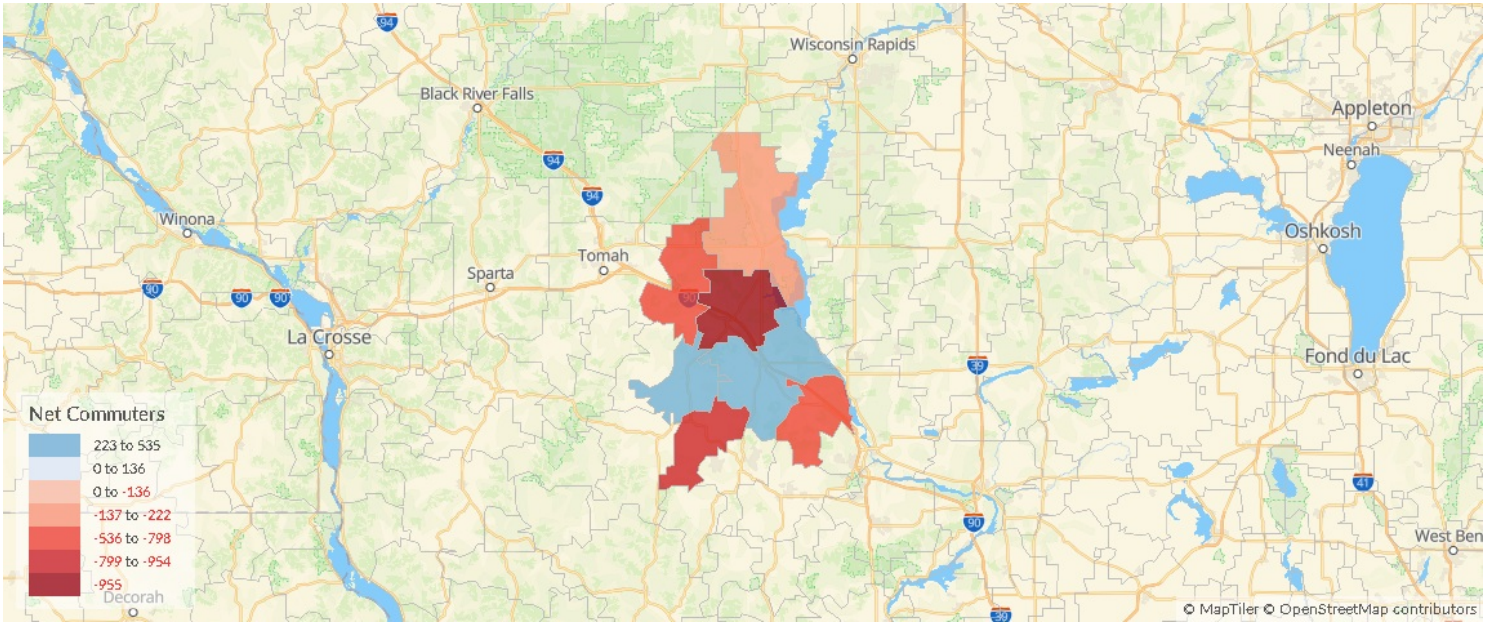


Property Crime

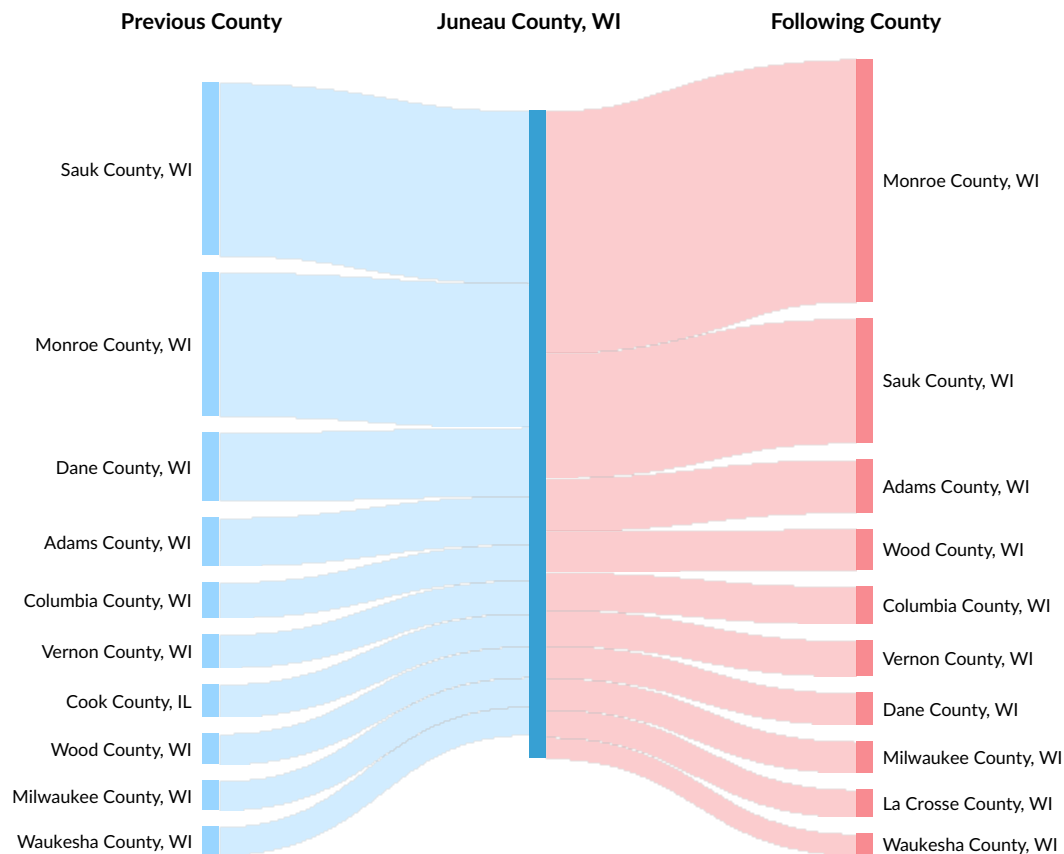

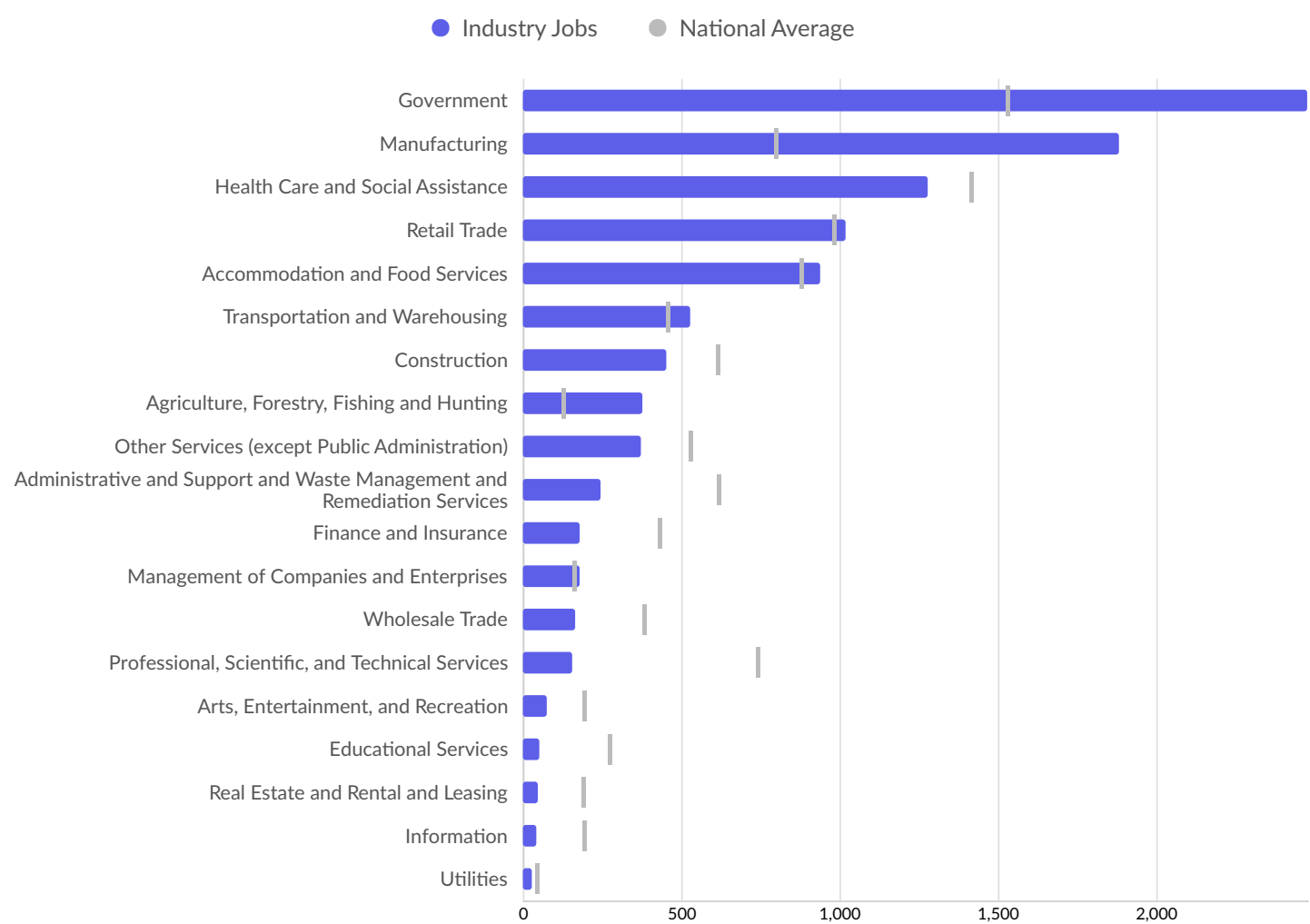

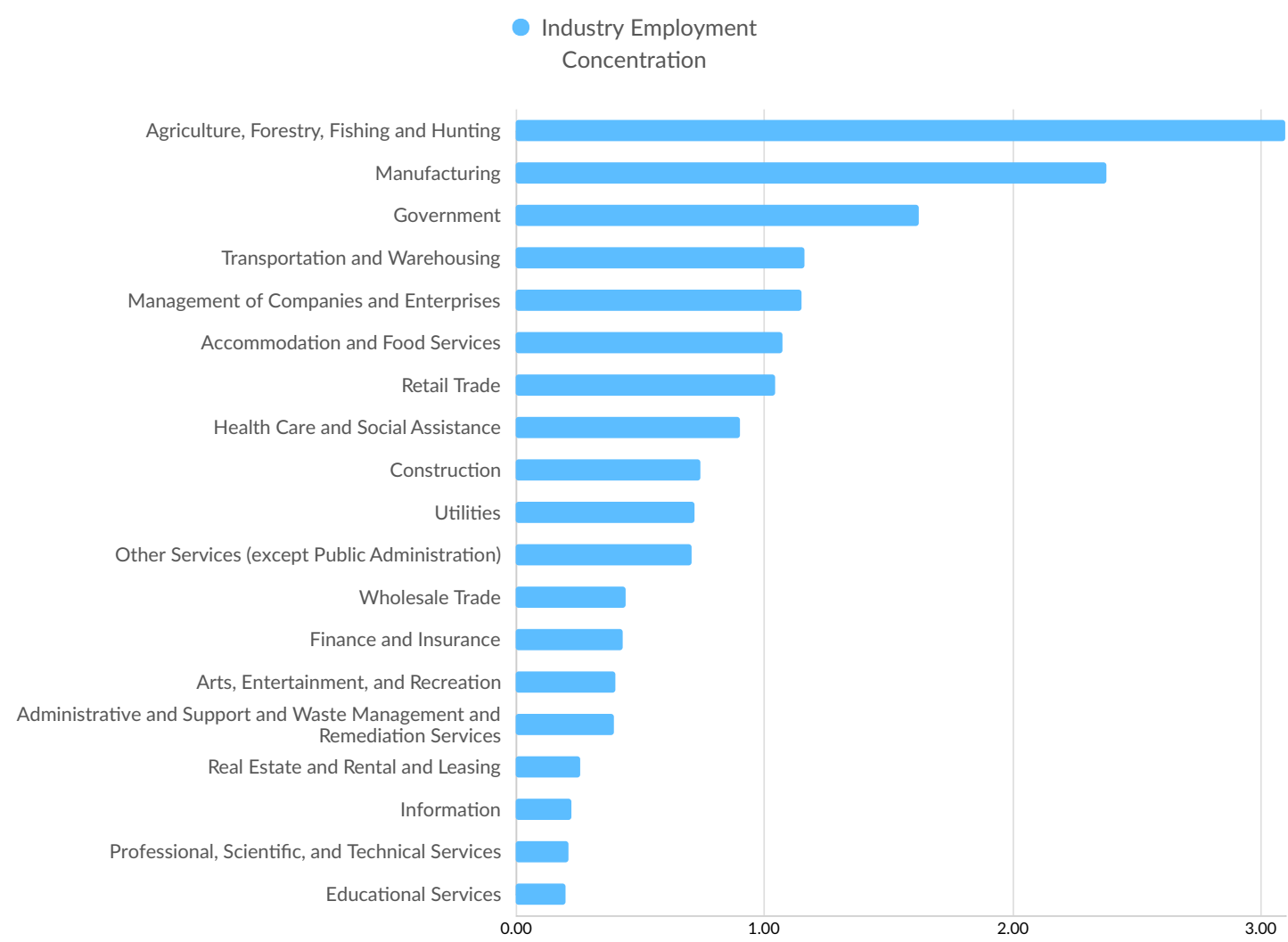

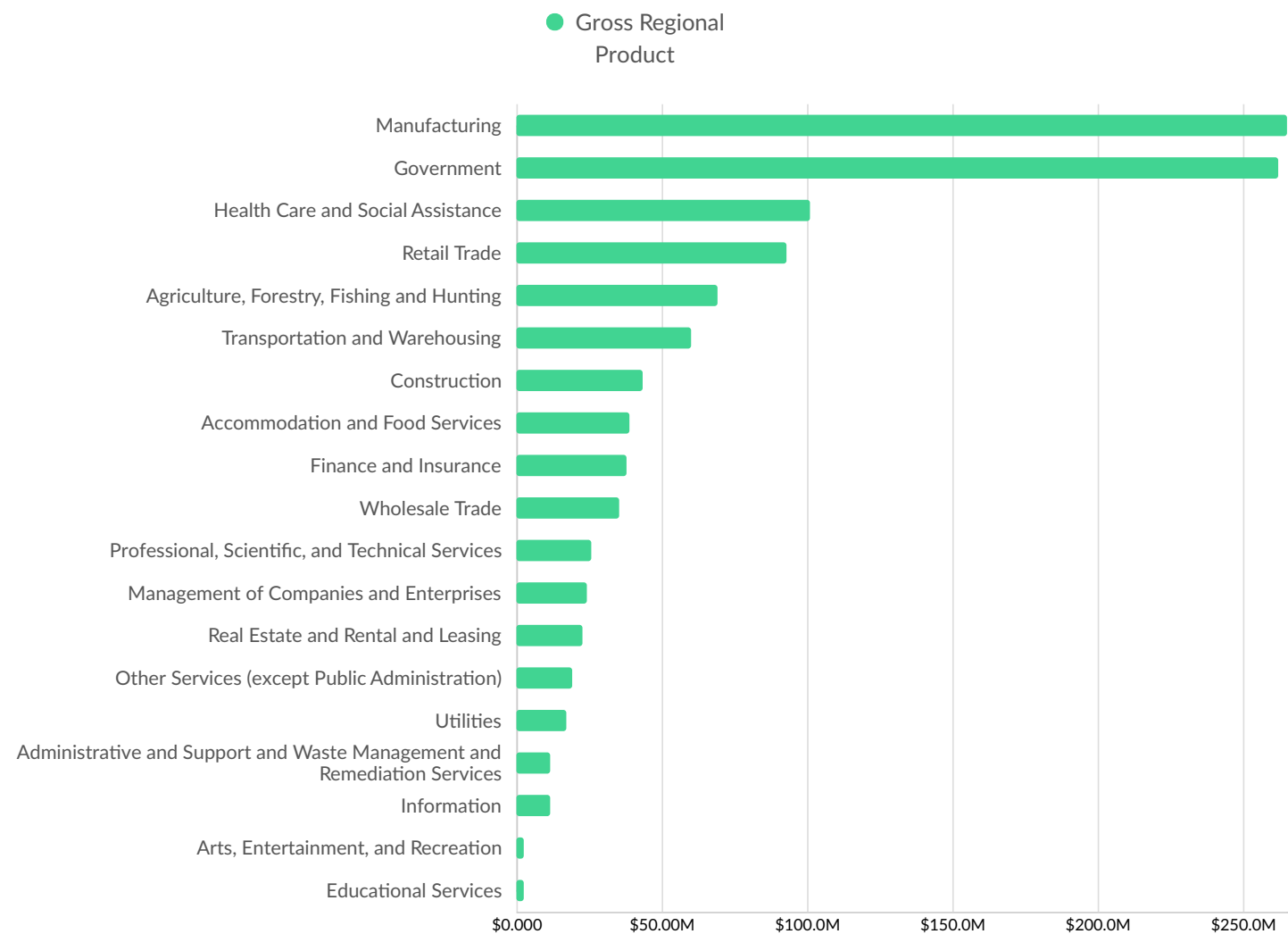
Top Growing Industries



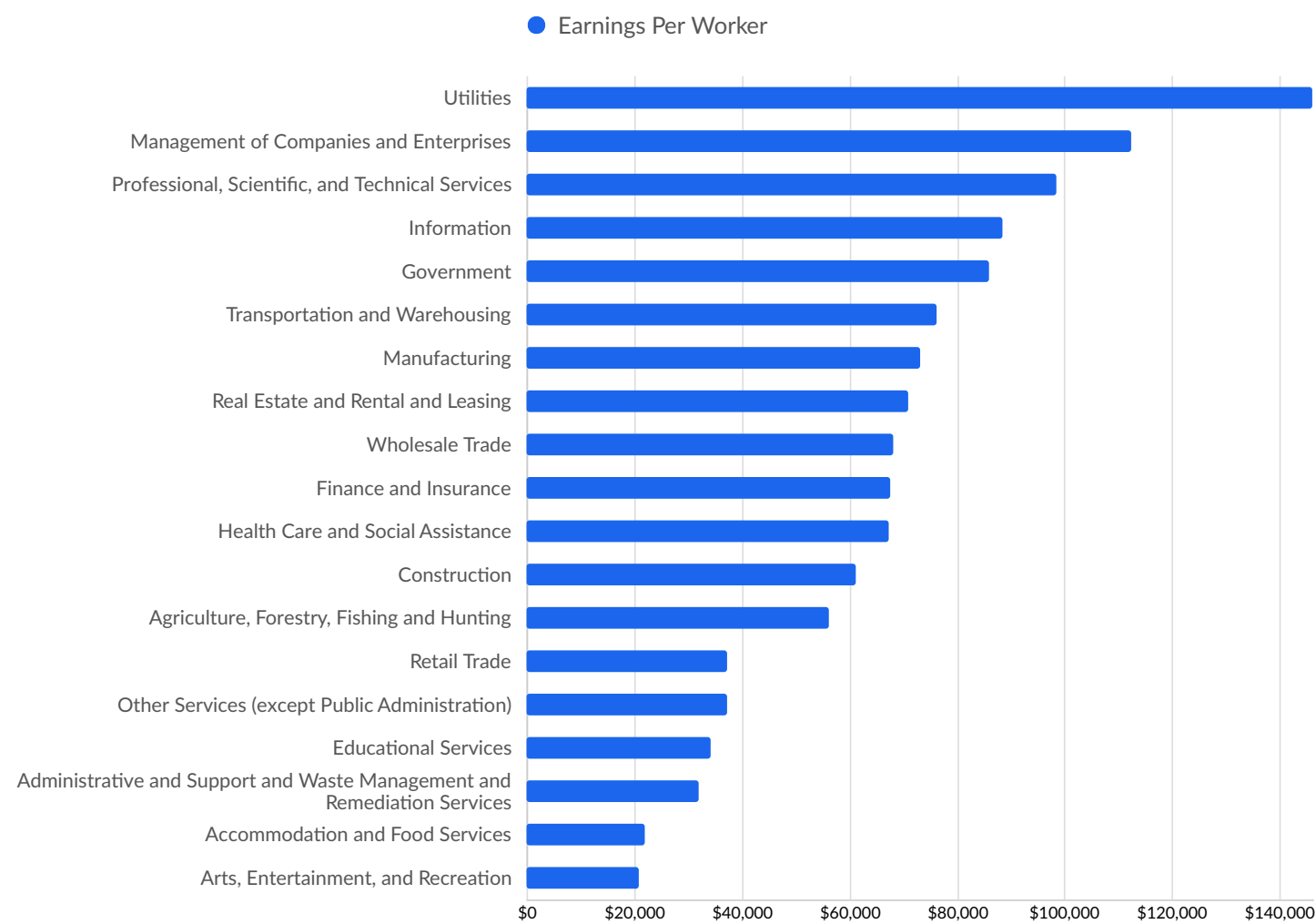
Top Industry Employment Concentration

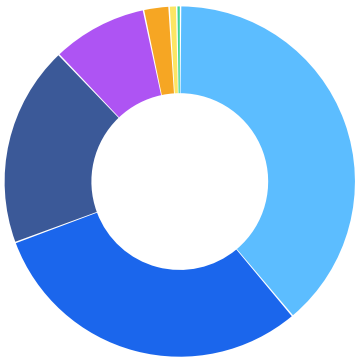

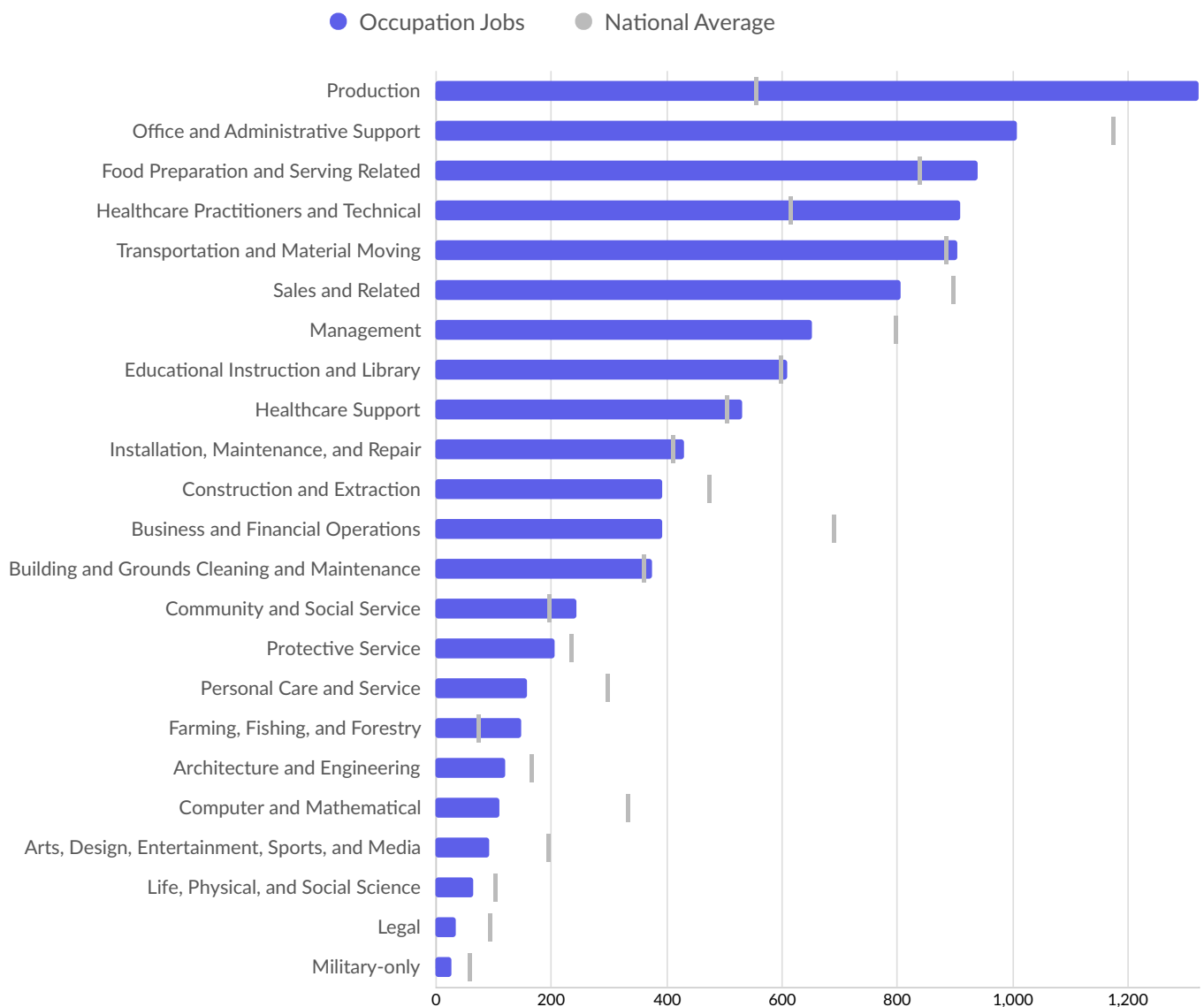

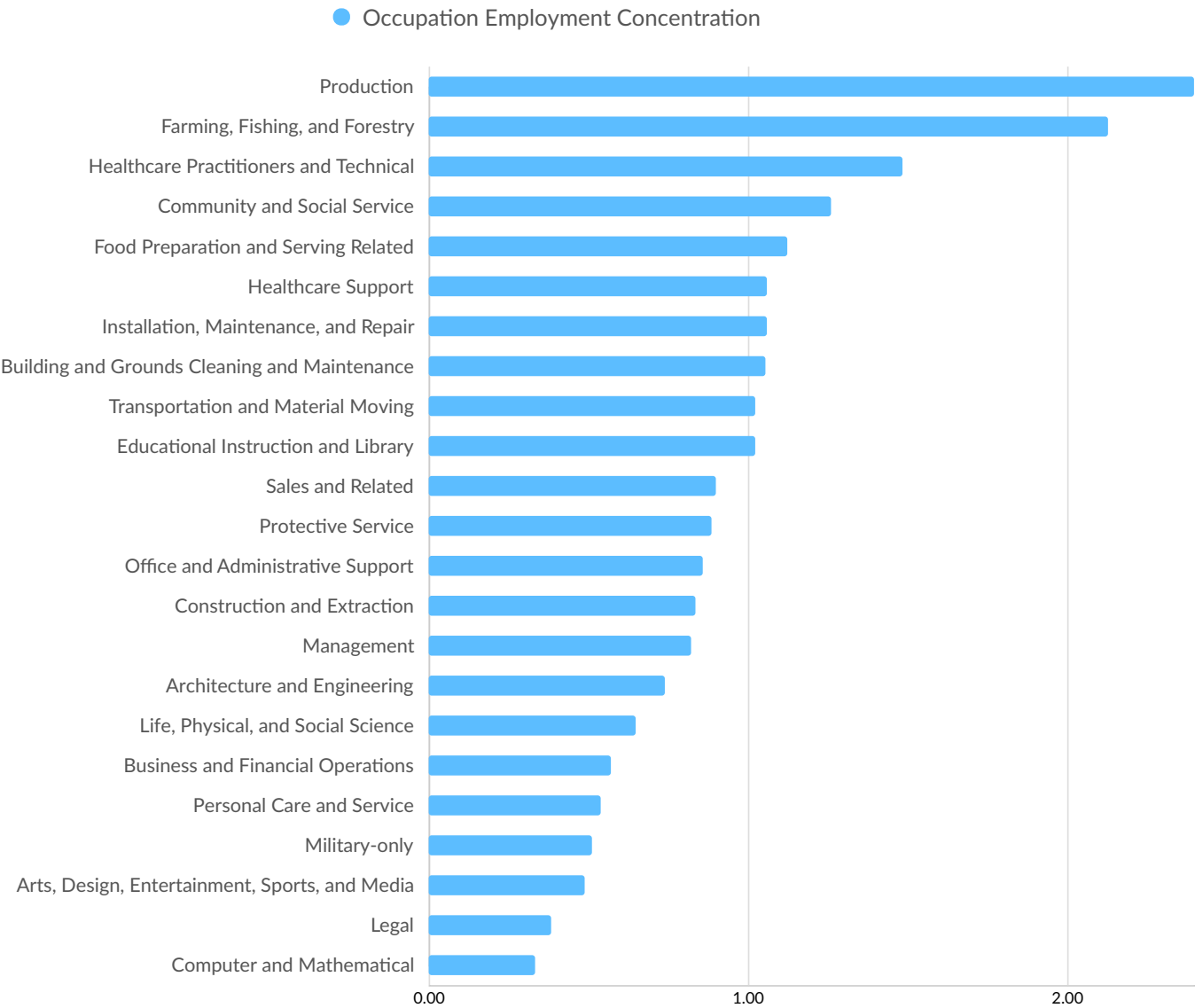

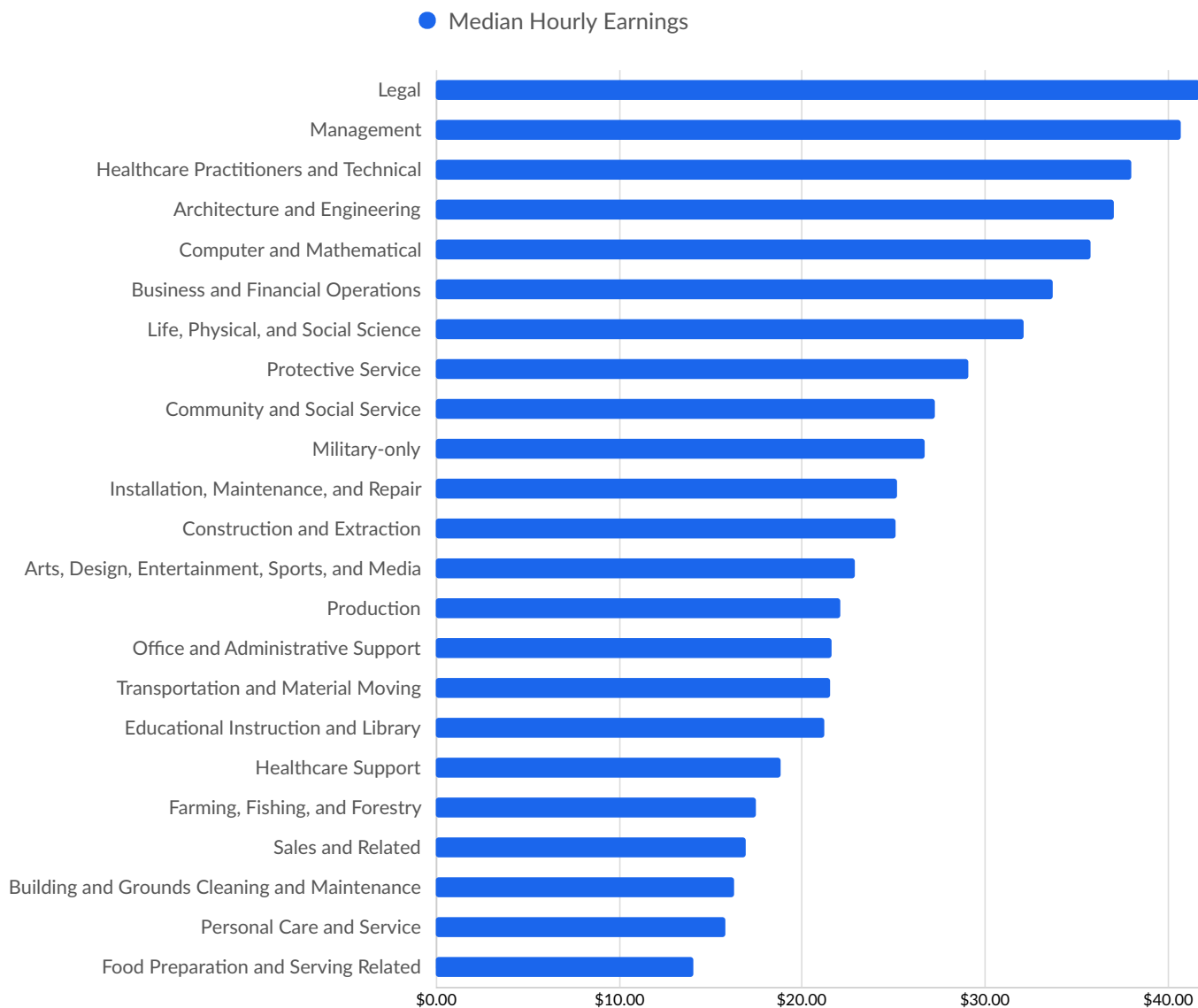
Top Growing Occupations



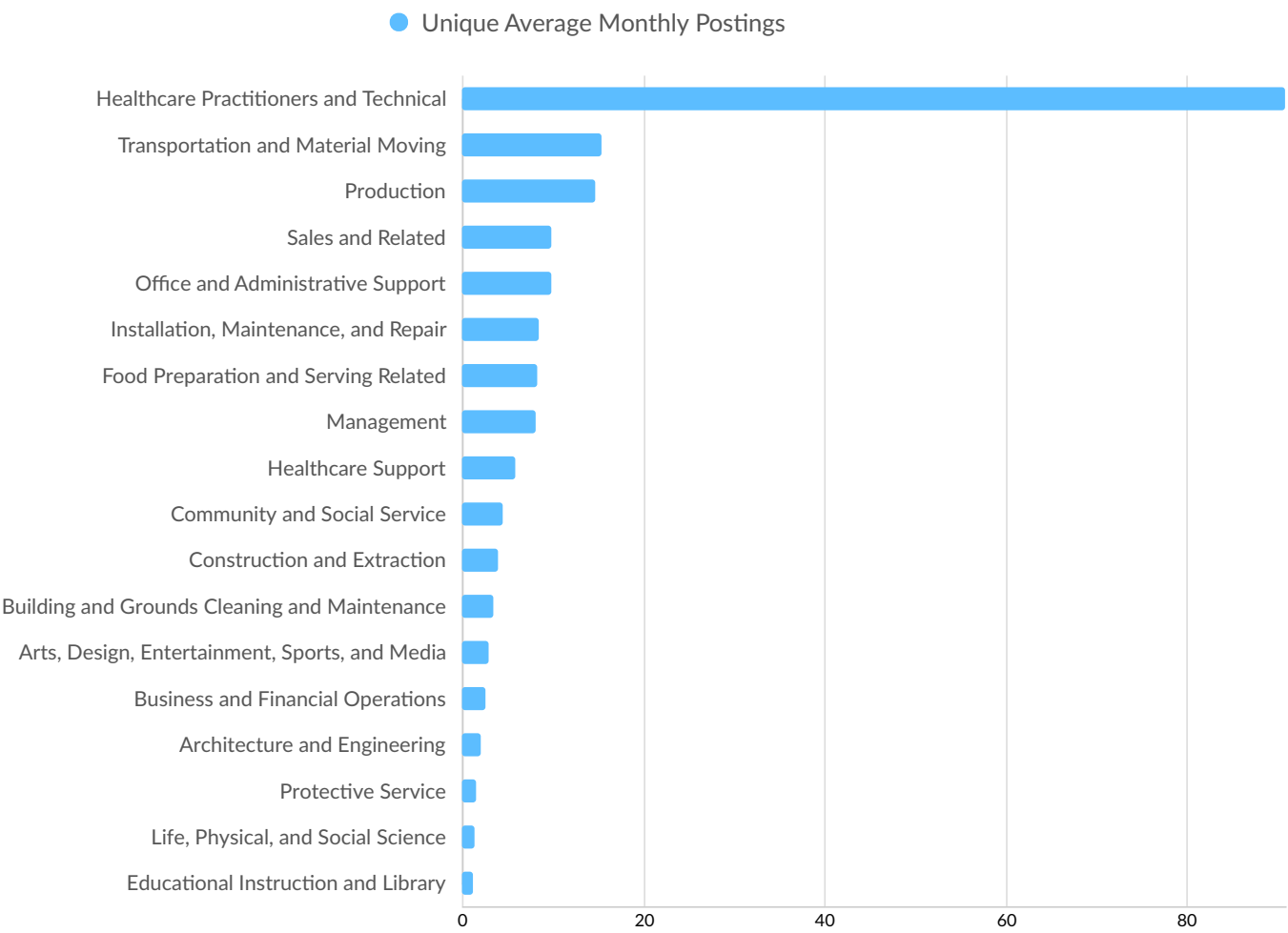
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



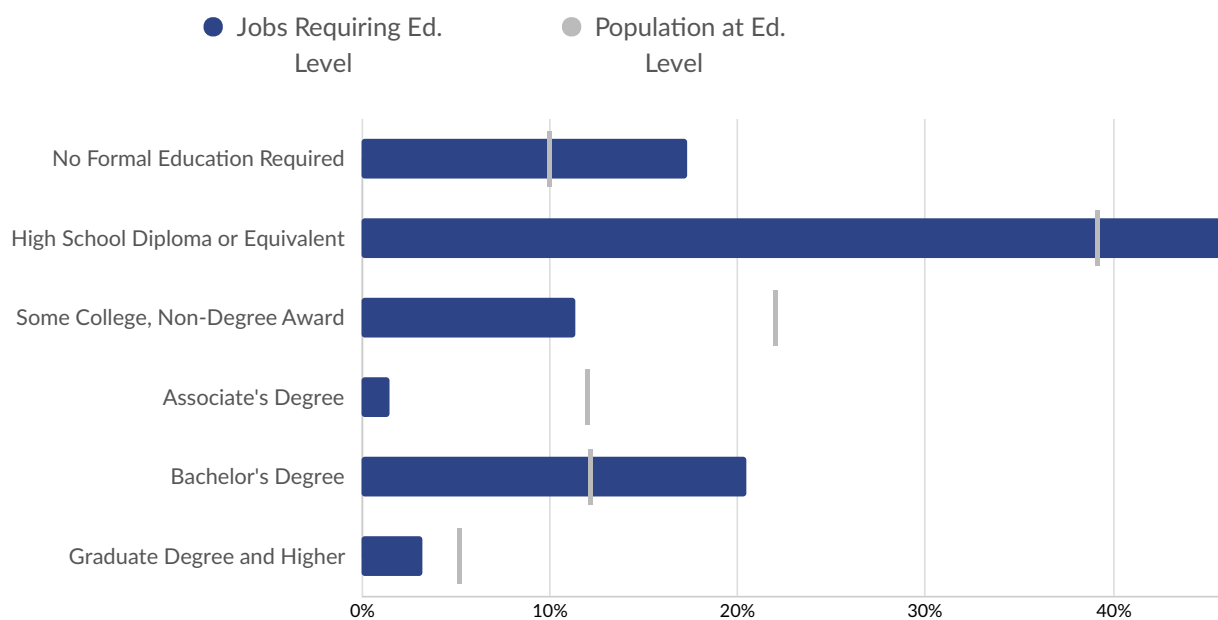
