Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 2.7% since 2019, growing by 3,617. Population is expected to increase by 1.7% between 2024 and 2029, adding 2,331.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs declined by 0.9% in Marathon County, WI from 78,409 to 77,685. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.3% by 5.2%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 69.5% to 67.3% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **19.2% of Marathon County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (2.3% below the national average), and **13.3% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.4% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Dairy Product Manufacturing.




May 2025 Labor Force Breakdown



Educational Attainment









Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Marathon County, WI had a May 2025 unemployment rate of 2.92%, decreasing from 5.03% 5 years before.






Millennials




Veterans

Marathon County, WI has 7,625 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 6,858.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Marathon County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 41,844 people 55 or older, while there are 46,594 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Marathon County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 57,728 racially diverse people, while there are 18,268 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP





Top Occupation Employment Concentration












Educational Pipeline

In 2023, there were 2,171 graduates in Marathon County, WI. This pipeline has shrunk by 6% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from "Nursing Assistant/Aide and Patient Care Assistant/Aide" (Certificate), "Welding Technology/Welder" (Certificate), and "Emergency Medical Technology/Technician (EMT Paramedic)" (Certificate).
