


## **Takeaways**

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 9.7% since 2019, growing by 2,142. Population is expected to increase by 6.4% between 2024 and 2029, adding 1,556.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 1.6% in Vilas County, WI from 9,587 to 9,738. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.3% by 2.7%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 52.8% to 49.7% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, 20.1% of Vilas County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (1.4% below the national average), and 11.4% hold an Associate's Degree (2.5% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).








# **Unemployment by Gender**







## **Job Trends**






Vilas County, WI had a May 2025 unemployment rate of 3.75%, decreasing from 7.43% 5 years before.





Retirement risk is high in Vilas County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 7,210 people 55 or older, while there are 12,534 here.


#### **Racial Diversity**

Racial diversity is low in Vilas County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 9,947 racially diverse people, while there are 3,269 here.




#### **Veterans**

Vilas County, WI has 0.13 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.




#### **Property Crime**










## **Top Industry Employment Concentration**








## **Top Occupation Employment Concentration**




