

Median household income is \$12.1K below the national median household income of \$78.5K.


Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 2.0% since 2019, growing by 1,420. Population is expected to increase by 0.9% between 2024 and 2029, adding 651.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs declined by 5.6% in Wood County, WI from 42,518 to 40,136. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.3% by 9.9%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 65.5% to 60.3% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **15.0% of Wood County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.5% below the national average), and **14.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (5.7% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are General Freight Trucking, General Medical and Surgical Hospitals, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Wood County, WI had a May 2025 unemployment rate of 3.42%, decreasing from 6.32% 5 years before.



Millennials


Wood County, WI has 12,655 millennials (ages 25-39). The size is 15,023.






Veterans

Wood County, WI has 4,775 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 3,658.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Wood County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 22,320 people 55 or older, while there are 27,564 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Wood County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 30,793 racially diverse people, while there are 6,599 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP





Top Occupation Employment Concentration





Educational Pipeline

In 2023, there were 997 graduates in Wood County, WI. This pipeline has grown by 20% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from "Nursing Assistant/Aide and Patient Care Assistant/Aide" (Certificate), "Emergency Medical Technology/Technician (EMT Paramedic)" (Certificate), and "Registered Nursing/Registered Nurse" (Associate's).
