
Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 5.3% since 2019, growing by 1,084. Population is expected to increase by 5.3% between 2024 and 2029, adding 1,137.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 1.7% in Adams County, WI from 5,731 to 5,831. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.4% by 2.7%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 49.4% to 45.2% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.1% of Adams County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.5% below the national average), and **9.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Crop Production, Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Traveler Accommodation.








Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends




Adams County, WI had an August 2025 unemployment rate of 4.19%, decreasing from 9.63% 5 years before.


Millennials

Adams County, WI has 2,995 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 4,371.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Adams County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 6,456 people 55 or older, while there are 11,166 here.




Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Adams County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 9,083 racially diverse people, while there are 2,247 here.




Veterans

Adams County, WI has 2.86 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.38 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime








Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP




Top Growing Occupations





Top Occupation Employment Concentration











