

Median household income is \$21.3K below the national median household income of \$78.5K.


Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 1.7% since 2019, growing by 327. Population is expected to increase by 1.0% between 2024 and 2029, adding 203.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs declined by 0.4% in Langlade County, WI from 8,781 to 8,747. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.4% by 4.8%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 59.3% to 55.8% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.5% of Langlade County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.1% below the national average), and **10.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Crop Production, Warehouse Clubs, Supercenters, and Other General Merchandise Retailers, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).








Unemployment by Gender







Unemployment by Ethnicity










Langlade County, WI had an August 2025 unemployment rate of 3.81%, decreasing from 6.79% 5 years before.



Millennials


Langlade County, WI has 2,846 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 3,999.






Veterans

Langlade County, WI has 1,405 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 956.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Langlade County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 5,907 people 55 or older, while there are 8,536 here.




Violent Crime

Racial diversity is low in Langlade County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,310 racially diverse people, while there are 1,493 here.




Property Crime










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP








Top Occupation Employment Concentration


Top Occupation Earnings






