

Median household income is **\$2.4K below** the national median household income of \$78.5K.

Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 2.5% since 2019, growing by 3,394. Population is expected to increase by 1.8% between 2024 and 2029, adding 2,545.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs declined by 0.8% in Marathon County, WI from 78,402 to 77,760. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.4% by 5.2%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 69.5% to 67.4% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **19.2% of Marathon County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (2.4% below the national average), and **13.3% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.5% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Dairy Product Manufacturing.






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity










Marathon County, WI had an August 2025 unemployment rate of 2.83%, decreasing from 5.03% 5 years before.






Millennials




Veterans

Marathon County, WI has 7,625 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 6,830.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Marathon County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 42,058 people 55 or older, while there are 47,139 here.




Violent Crime

Marathon County, WI has 1.58 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.38 per 1,000 people.




Racial Diversity

Marathon County, WI has 5.17 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 16.44 per 1,000 people.










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP





Top Occupation Employment Concentration












Educational Pipeline

In 2024, there were 2,123 graduates in Marathon County, WI. This pipeline has shrunk by 2% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from "Nursing Assistant/Aide and Patient Care Assistant/Aide" (Certificate), "Welding Technology/Welder" (Certificate), and "Emergency Medical Technology/Technician (EMT Paramedic)" (Certificate).
