
Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 1.6% since 2019, growing by 1,148. Population is expected to increase by 1.0% between 2024 and 2029, adding 709.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs declined by 5.6% in Wood County, WI from 42,518 to 40,124. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.4% by 10.0%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 65.5% to 60.5% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **15.0% of Wood County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.5% below the national average), and **14.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (5.7% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are General Freight Trucking, General Medical and Surgical Hospitals, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).











Unemployment by Ethnicity










Wood County, WI had an August 2025 unemployment rate of 3.34%, decreasing from 6.32% 5 years before.


Wood County, WI has 12,757 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 15,137.


Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Wood County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 31,454 racially diverse people, while there are 6,961 here.




Veterans

Wood County, WI has 2.5 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.38 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP





Top Occupation Employment Concentration



Educational Pipeline

In 2024, there were 1,205 graduates in Wood County, WI. This pipeline has grown by 39% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from "Nursing Assistant/Aide and Patient Care Assistant/Aide" (Certificate), "Emergency Medical Technology/Technician (EMT Paramedic)" (Certificate), and "Registered Nursing/Registered Nurse" (Associate's).
