
Regional average earnings per job are **\$26.4K below** the national average earnings of \$88.5K per job.

### Takeaways

- As of 2025 the region's population **increased by 2.5%** since 2020, growing by 5,128. Population is expected to **increase by 3.1%** between 2025 and 2030, adding 6,512.
- From 2020 to 2025, jobs **increased by 4.1%** in Grow North from 80,970 to **84,307**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 10.6% by 6.5%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 59.0% to 56.0% between 2020 and 2025**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **15.5% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.4% below the national average), and **13.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.6% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2025 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).



## Nov 2025 Labor Force Breakdown




## Educational Attainment





## Unemployment by Gender





## Unemployment by Ethnicity



## Population Trends




## Job Trends




**Millennials**

Your area has 30,029 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 42,309.




**Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in your area. The national average for an area this size is 62,495 people 55 or older, while there are 93,016 here.




**Racial Diversity**














## Top Industry Employment Concentration




## Largest Occupations




## Top Growing Occupations




## Top Occupation Employment Concentration







## Educational Pipeline

In 2024, there were 380 graduates in Grow North. This pipeline has grown by 1% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from "Nursing Assistant/Aide and Patient Care Assistant/Aide" (Certificate), "Liberal Arts and Sciences/Liberal Studies" (Associate's), and "Emergency Medical Technology/Technician (EMT Paramedic)" (Certificate).
