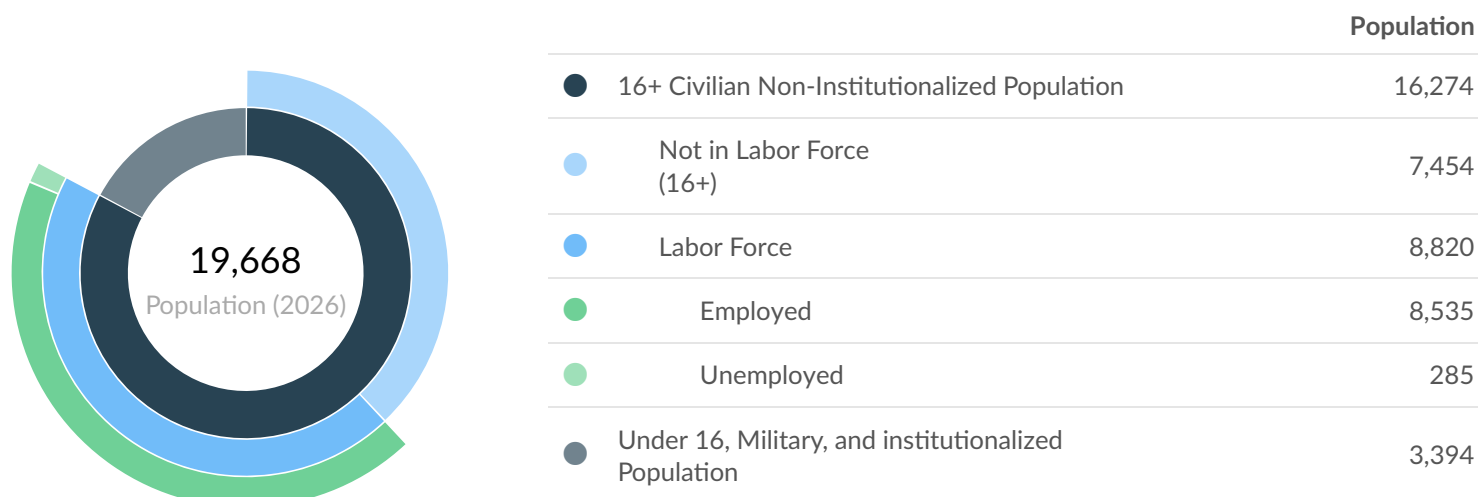
Median household income is **\$24.9K below** the national median household income of \$80.7K.

Takeaways

- As of 2025 the region's population **increased by 0.8%** since 2020, growing by 156. Population is expected to **increase by 0.5%** between 2025 and 2030, adding 90.
- From 2020 to 2025, jobs **declined by 0.5%** in Langlade County, WI from 8,527 to **8,485**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 10.7% by 11.2%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 56.7% to 54.4% between 2020 and 2025**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.4% of Langlade County, WI residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.4% below the national average), and **12.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.7% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2025 are Crop Production, Warehouse Clubs, Supercenters, and Other General Merchandise Retailers, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.

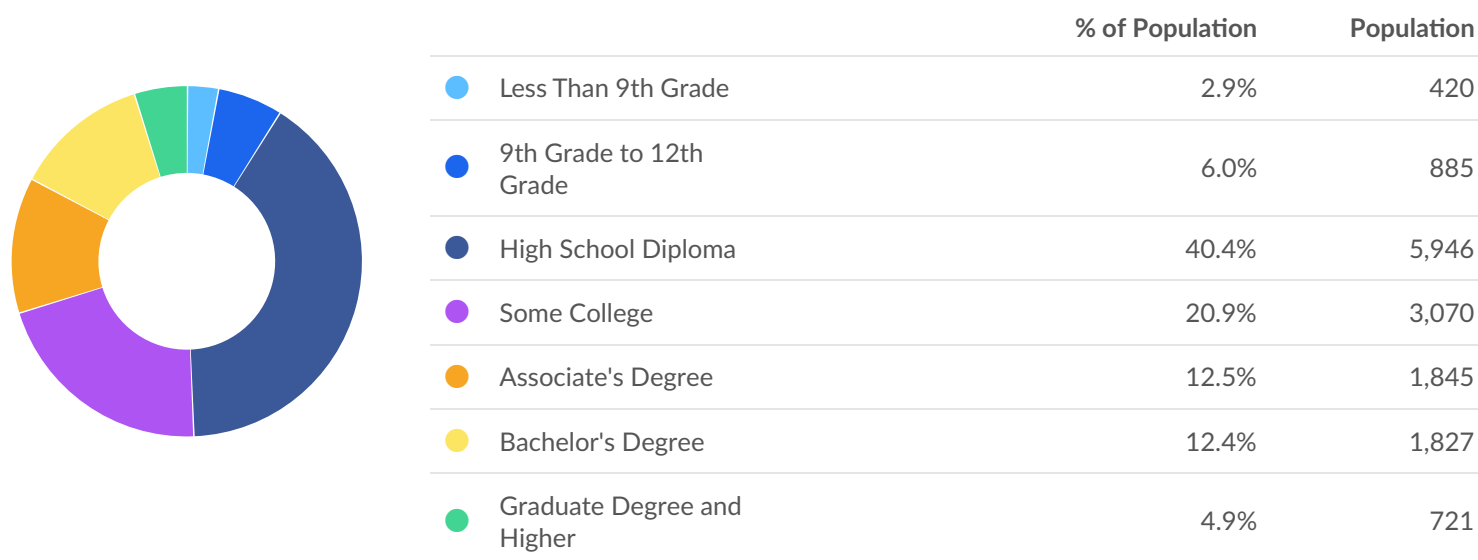

May 2026 Labor Force Breakdown



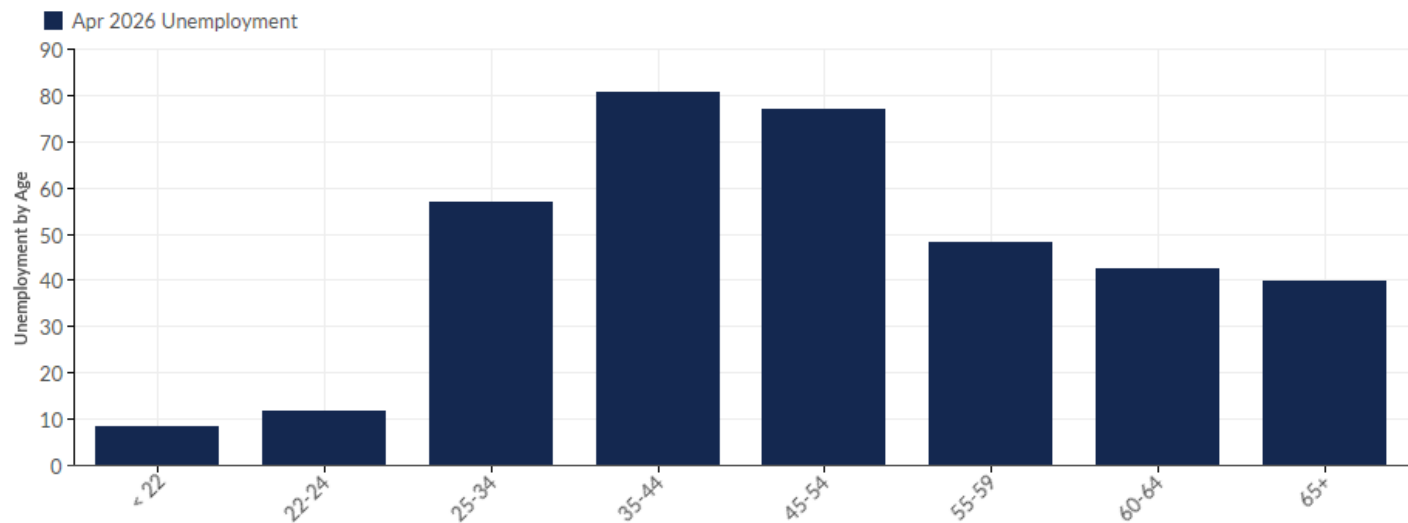
Educational Attainment

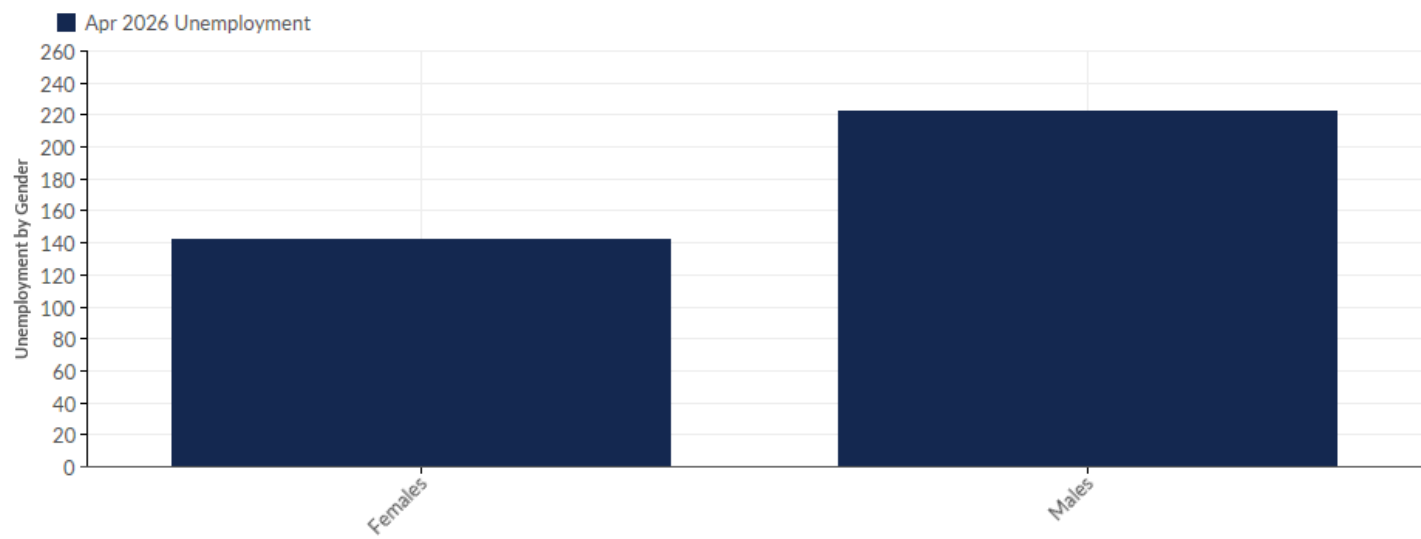
Unemployment by Demographics

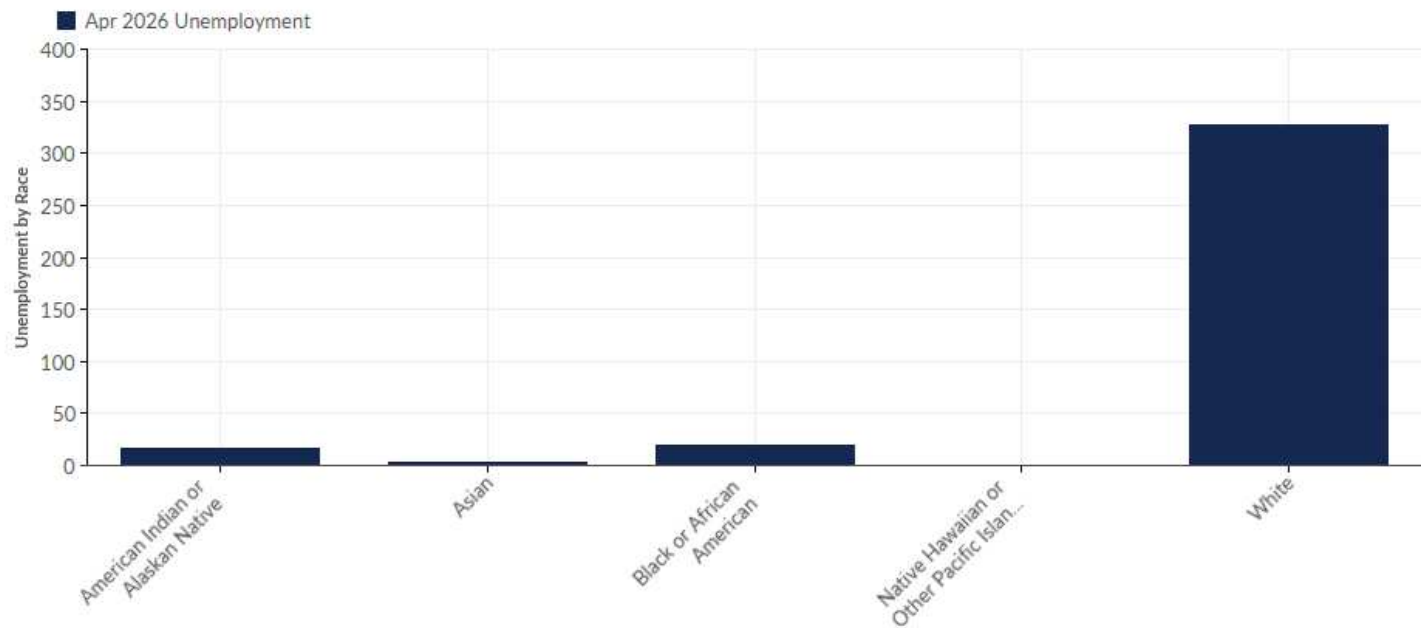

Unemployment by Gender



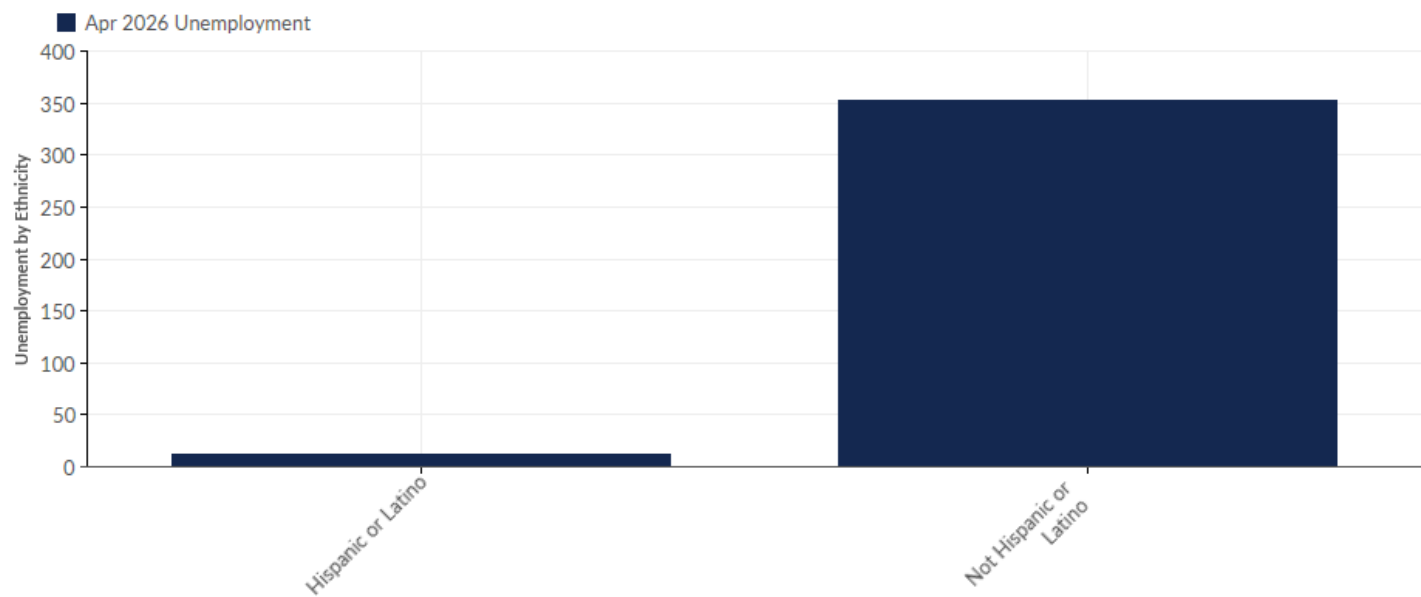

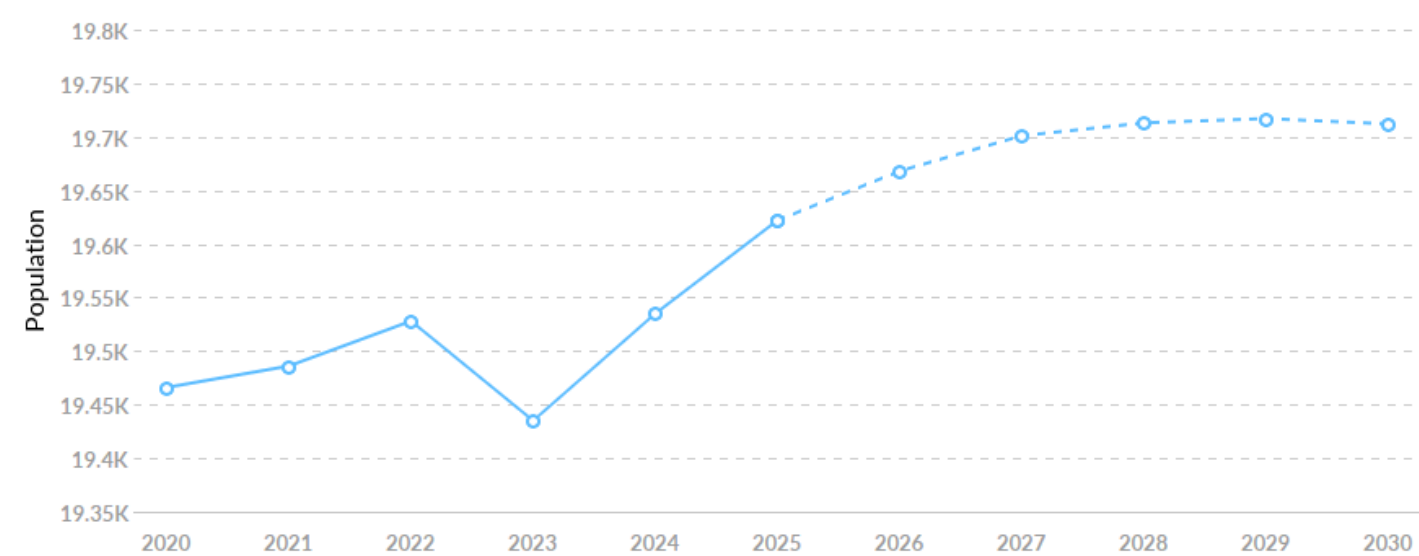

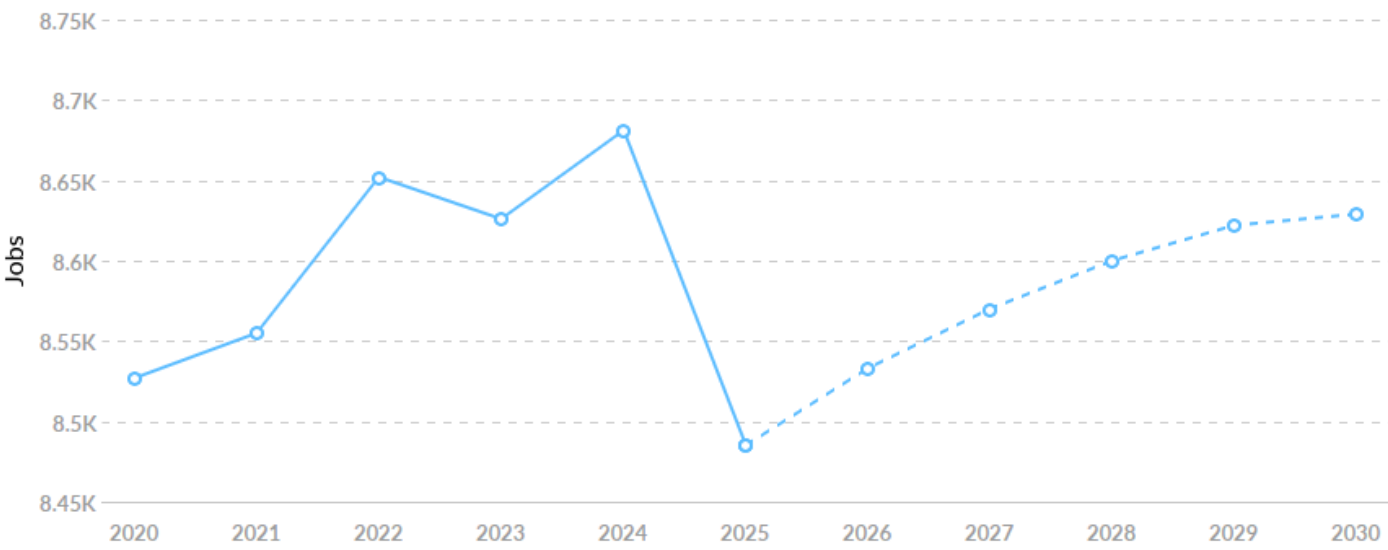

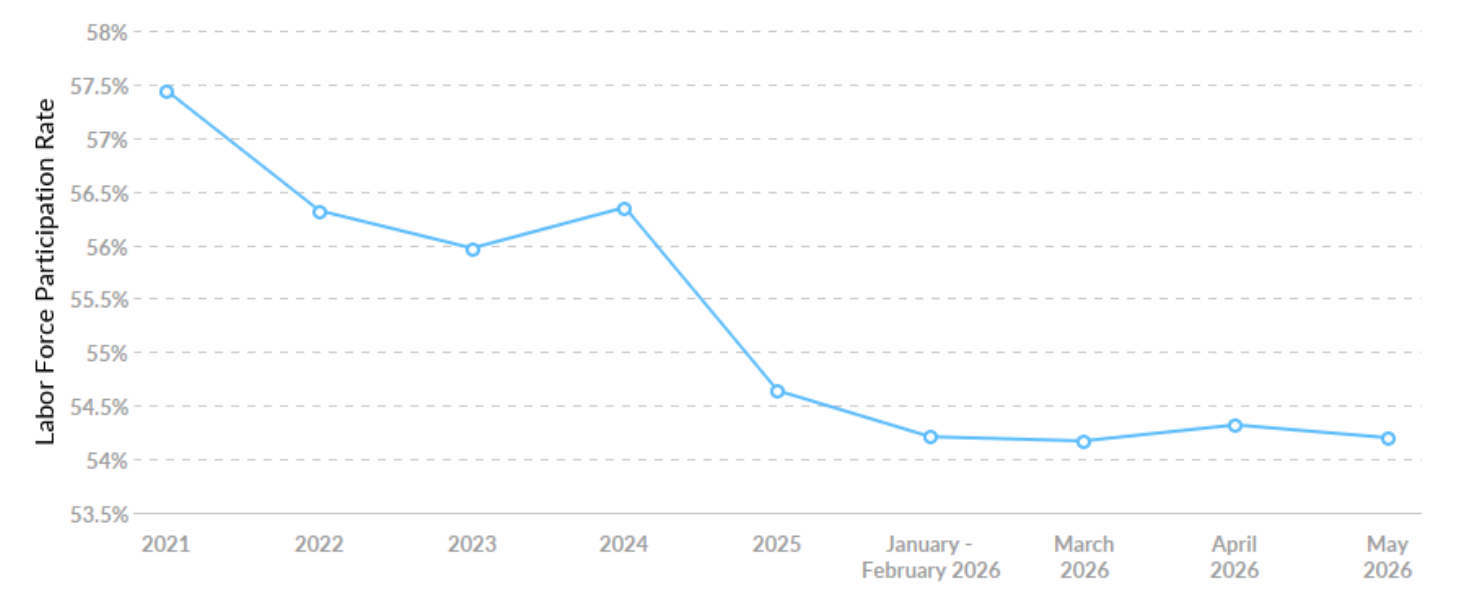
Job Trends

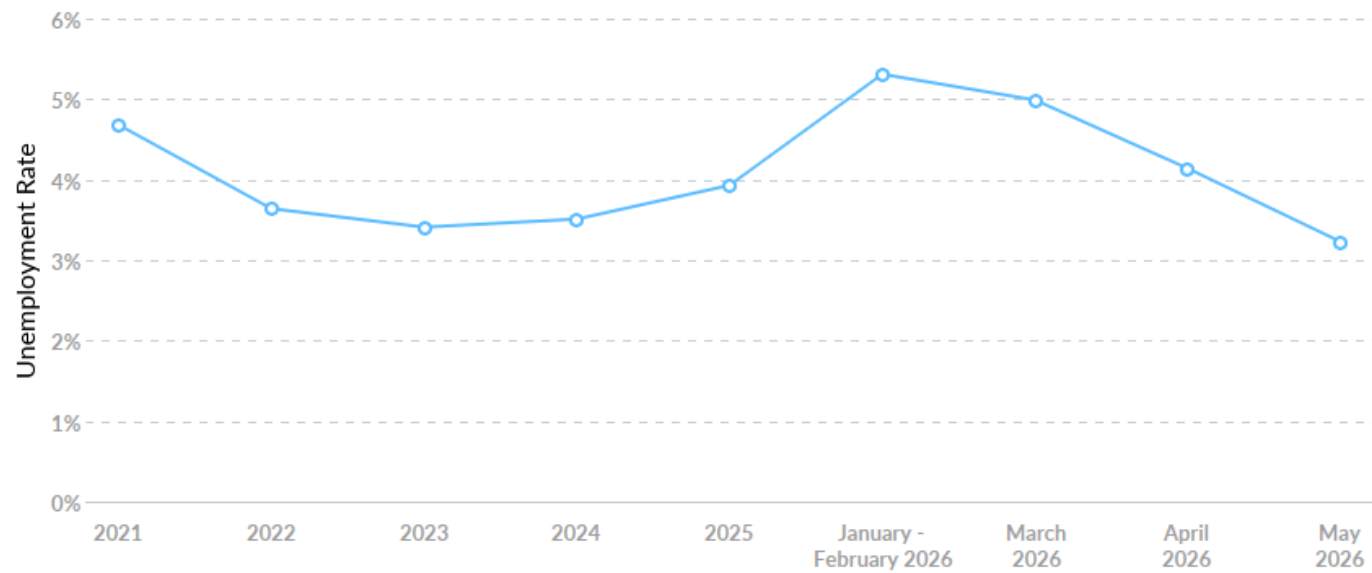

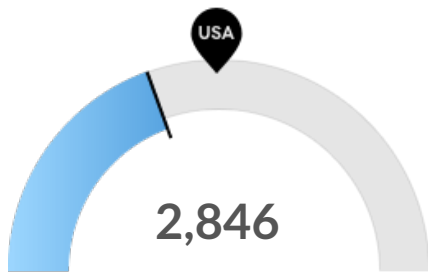
Unemployment Rate Trends

Langlade County, WI had a May 2026 unemployment rate of 3.23%, **decreasing from 4.68%** 5 years before.



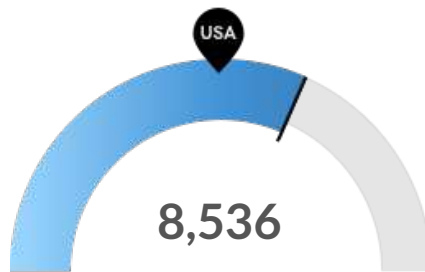

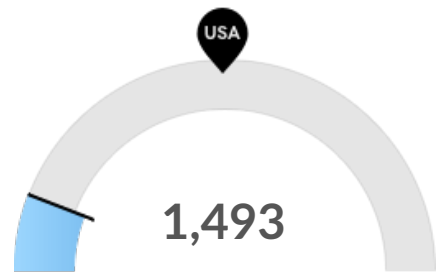
Millennials

Langlade County, WI has 2,846 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 3,999.



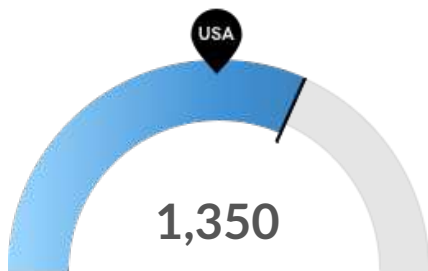
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Langlade County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 5,907 people 55 or older, while there are 8,536 here.



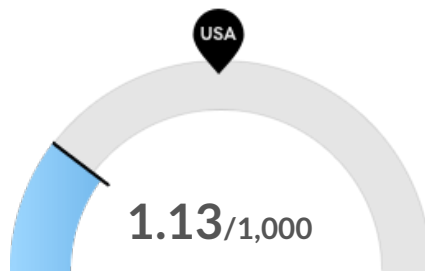
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Langlade County, WI. The national average for an area this size is 8,310 racially diverse people, while there are 1,493 here.



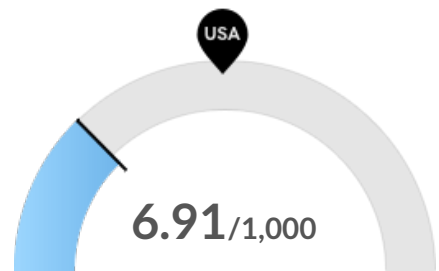
Veterans

Langlade County, WI has 1.13 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.38 per 1,000 people.

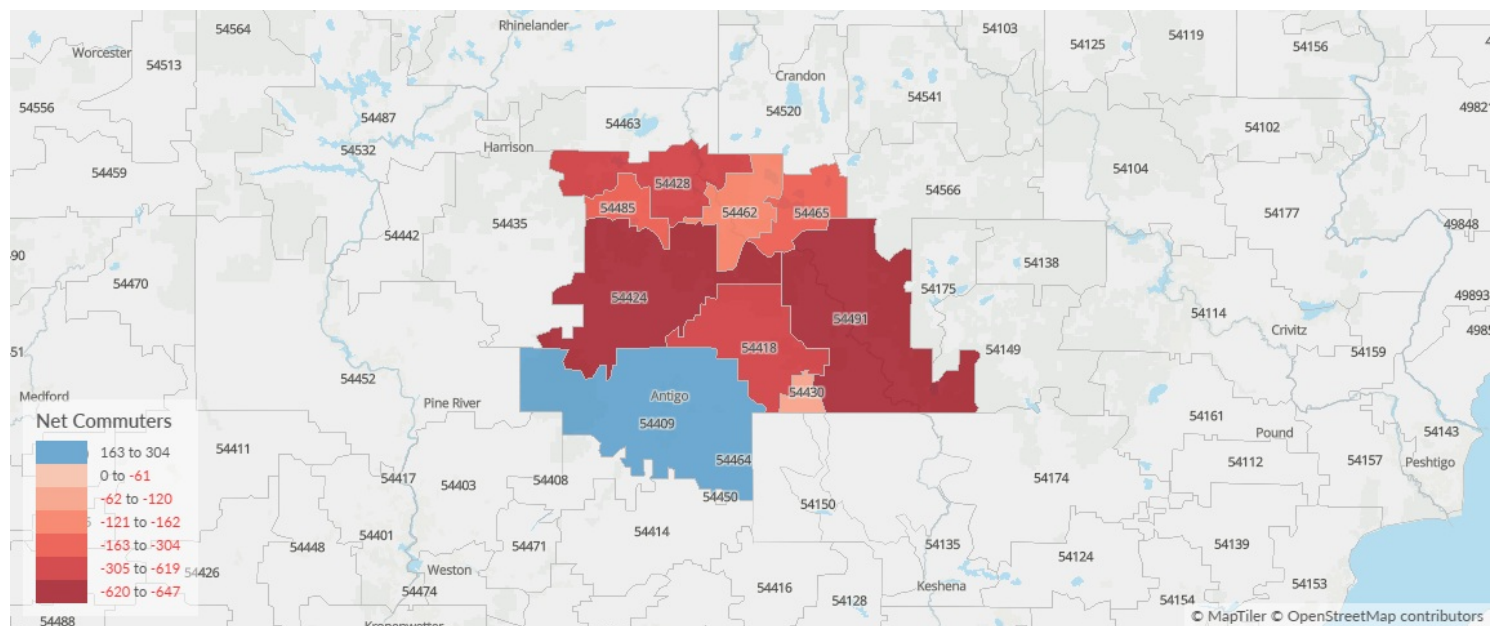


Property Crime

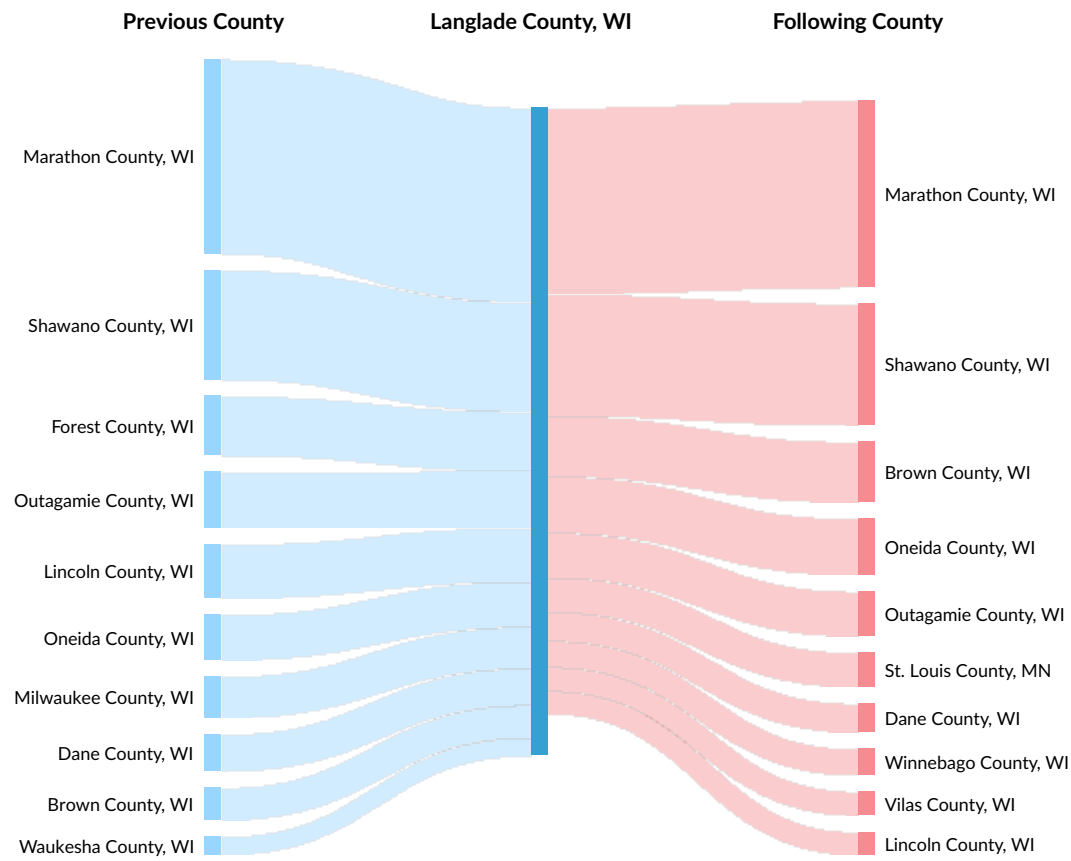

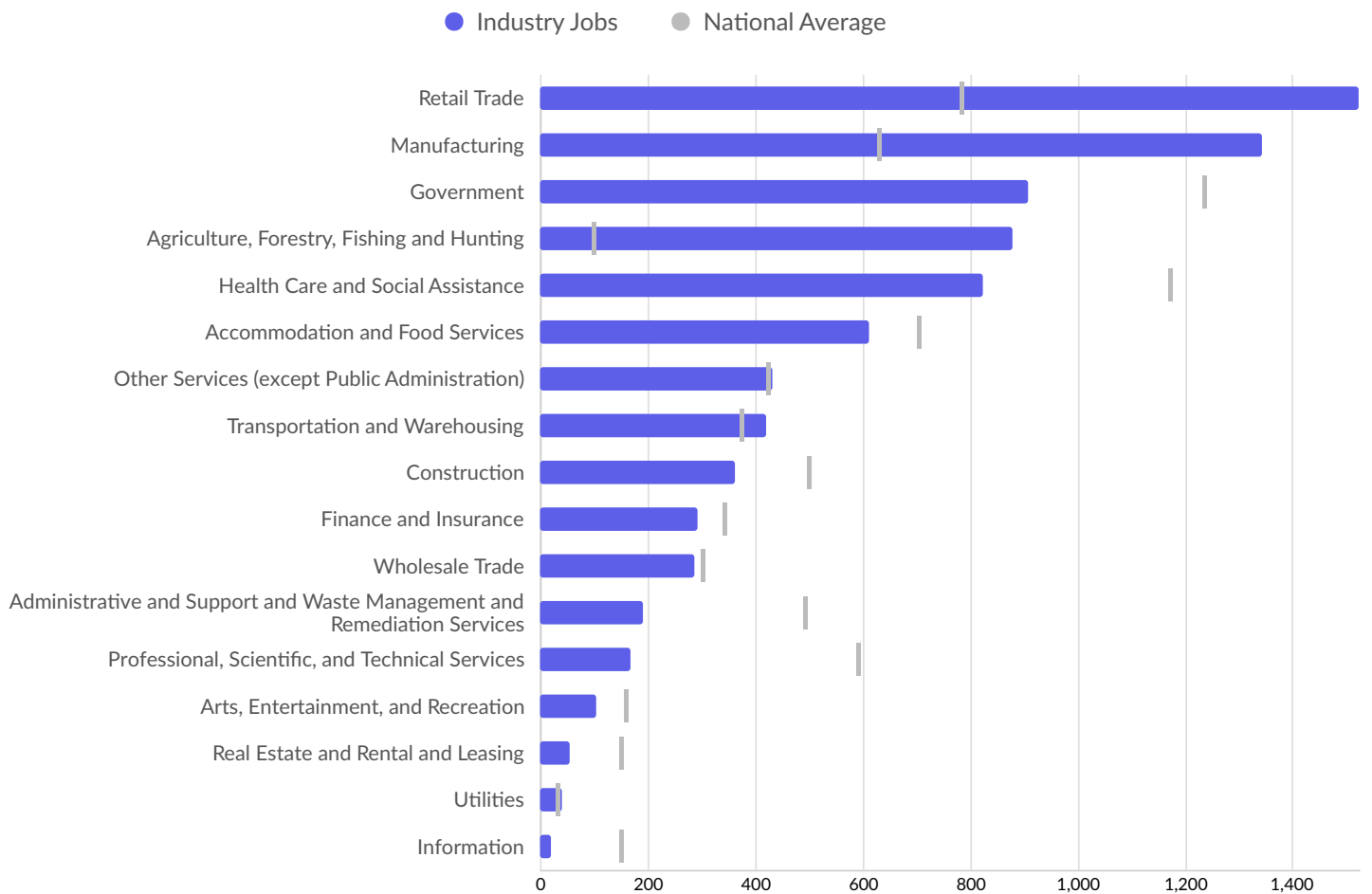

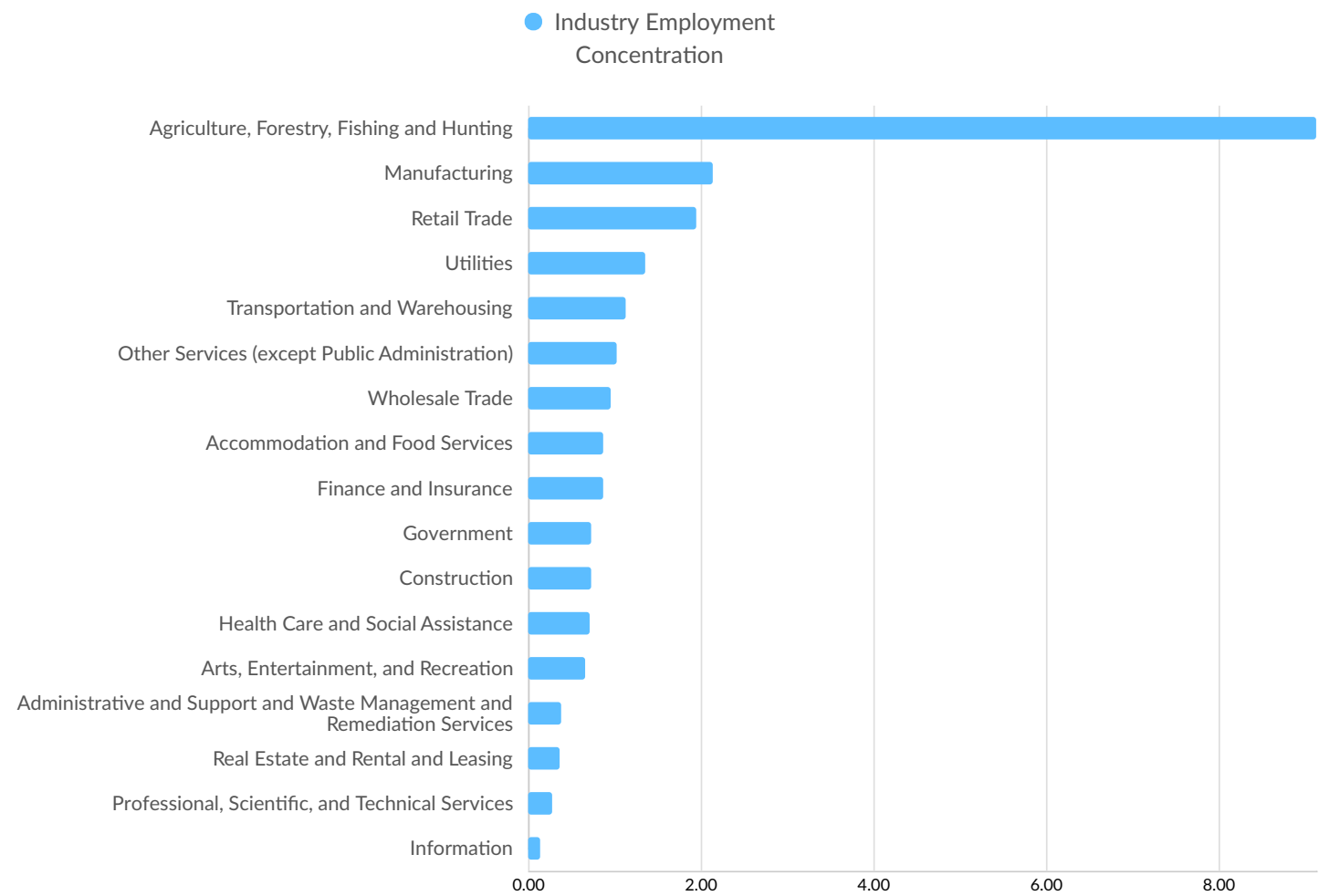

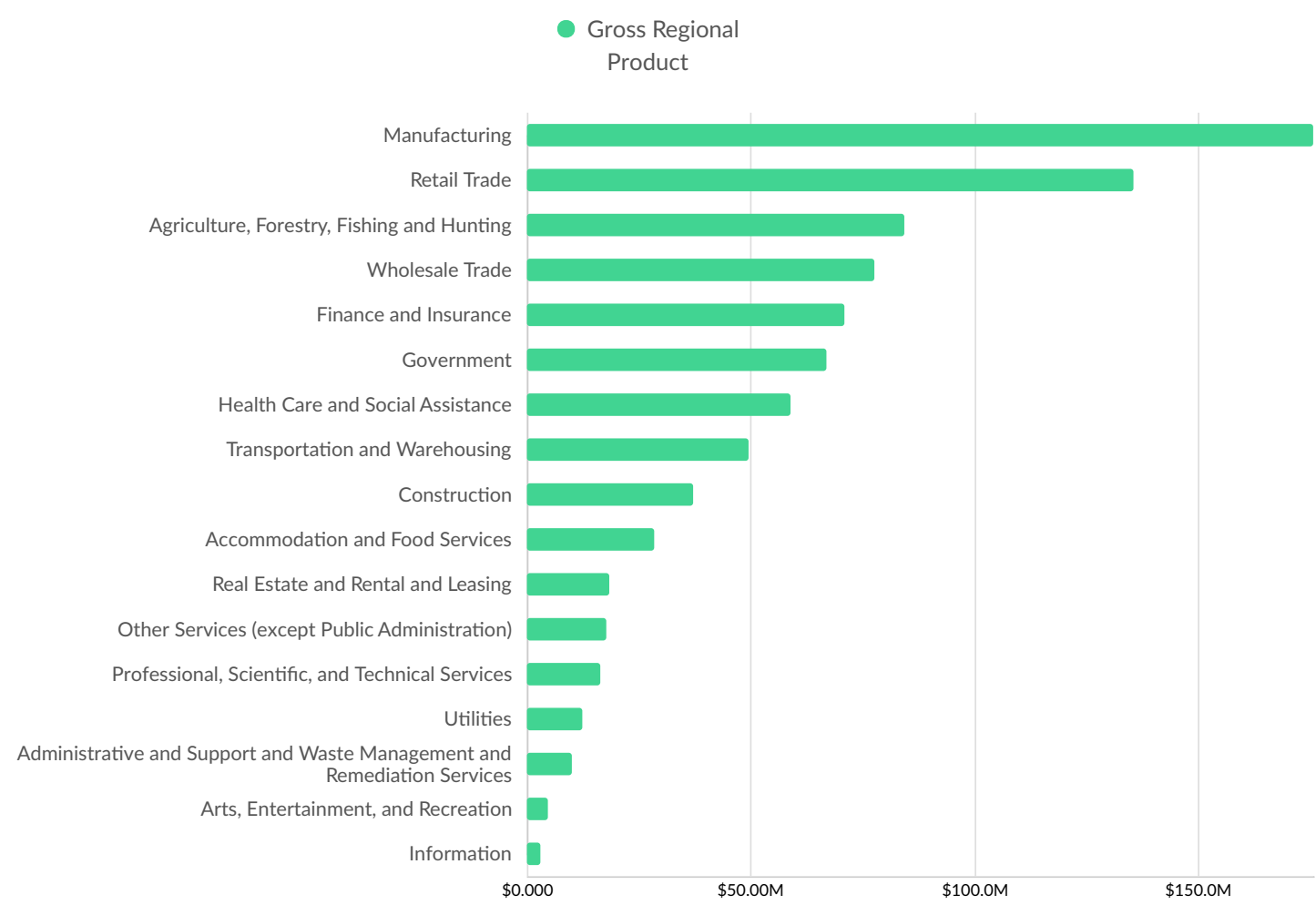
Top Growing Industries



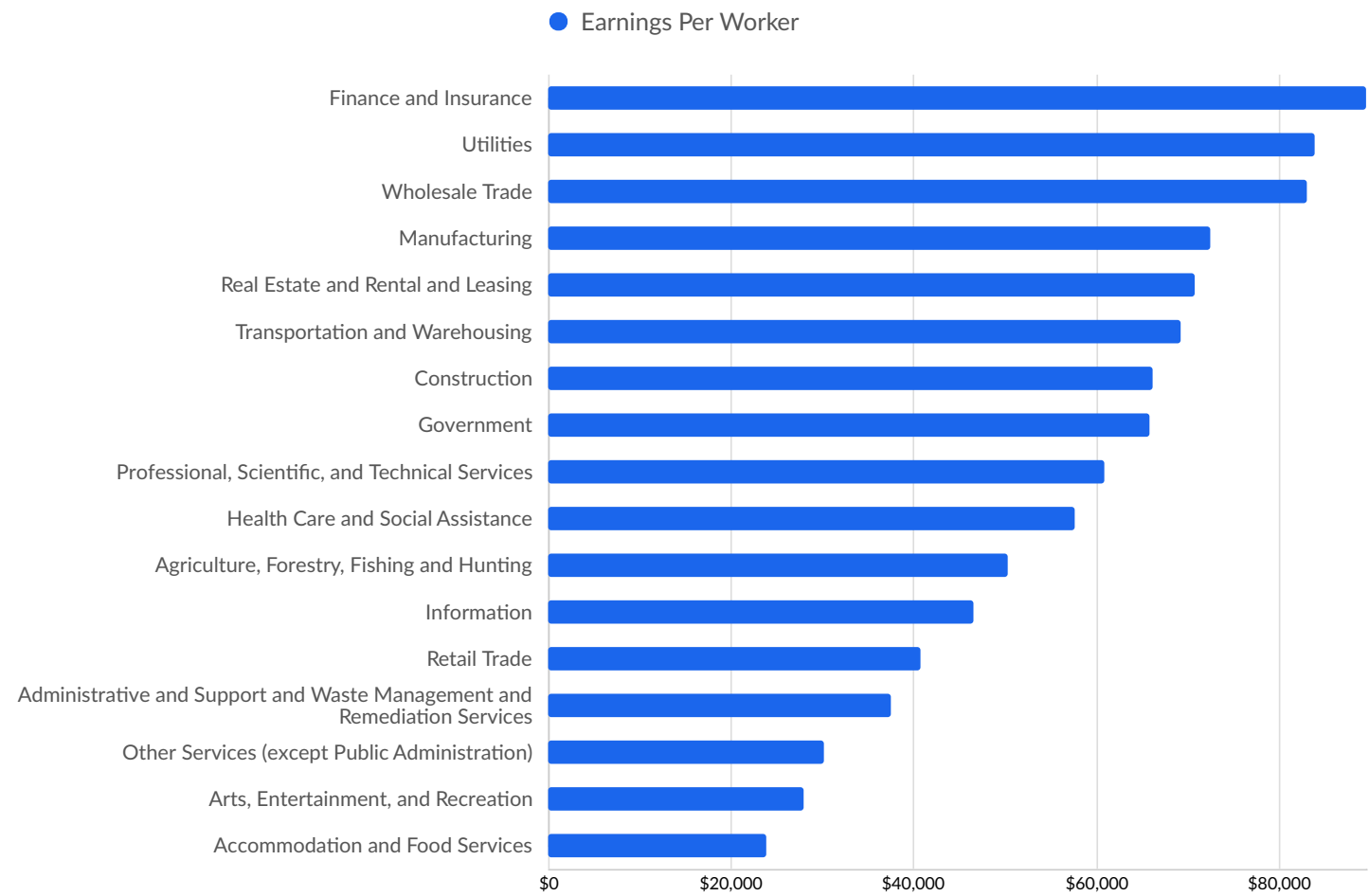
Top Industry Employment Concentration

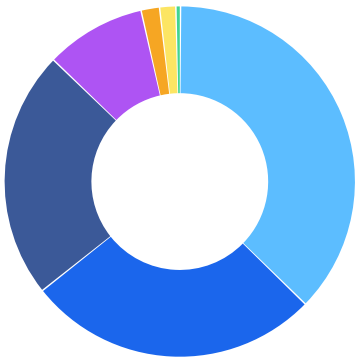

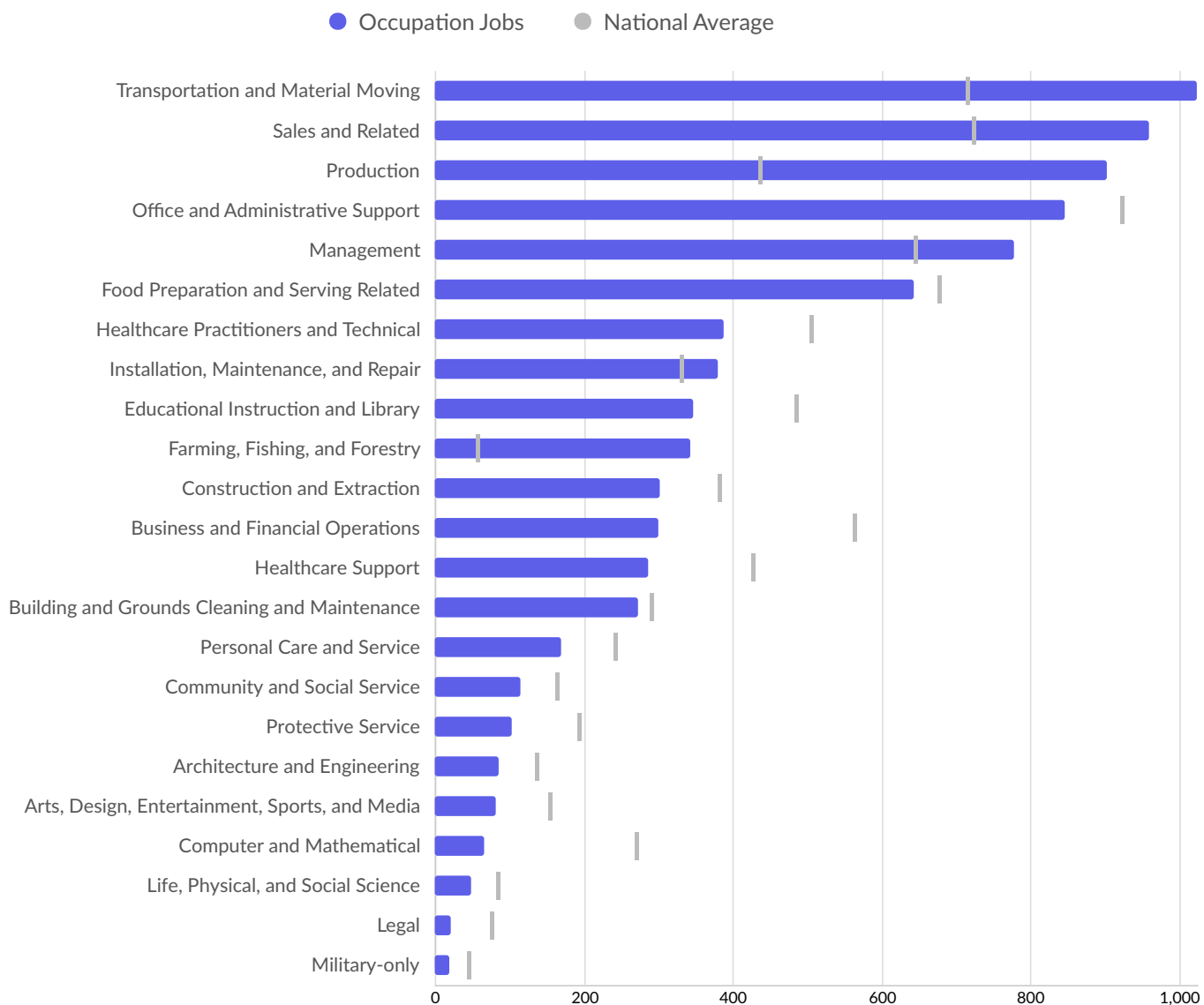

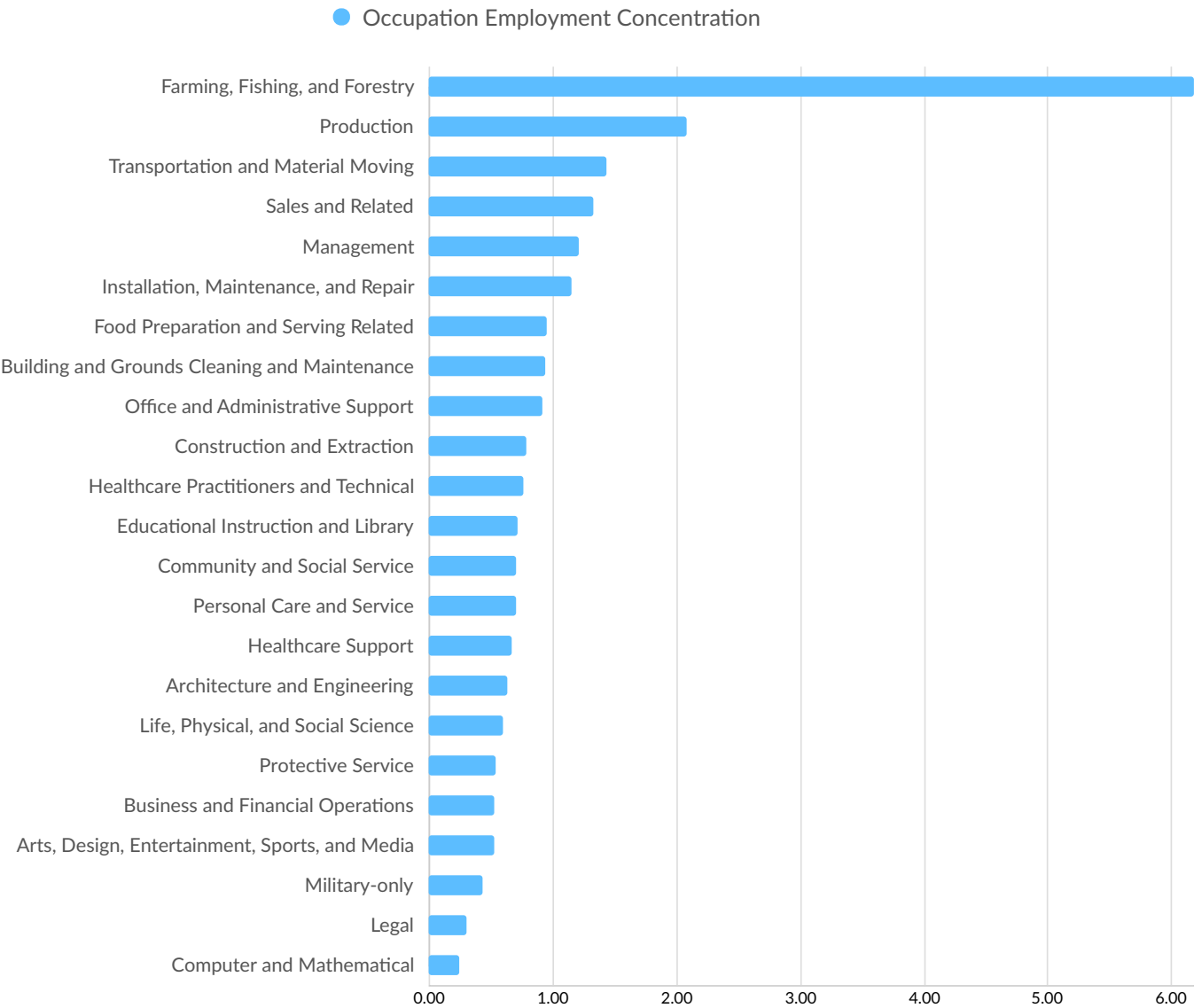

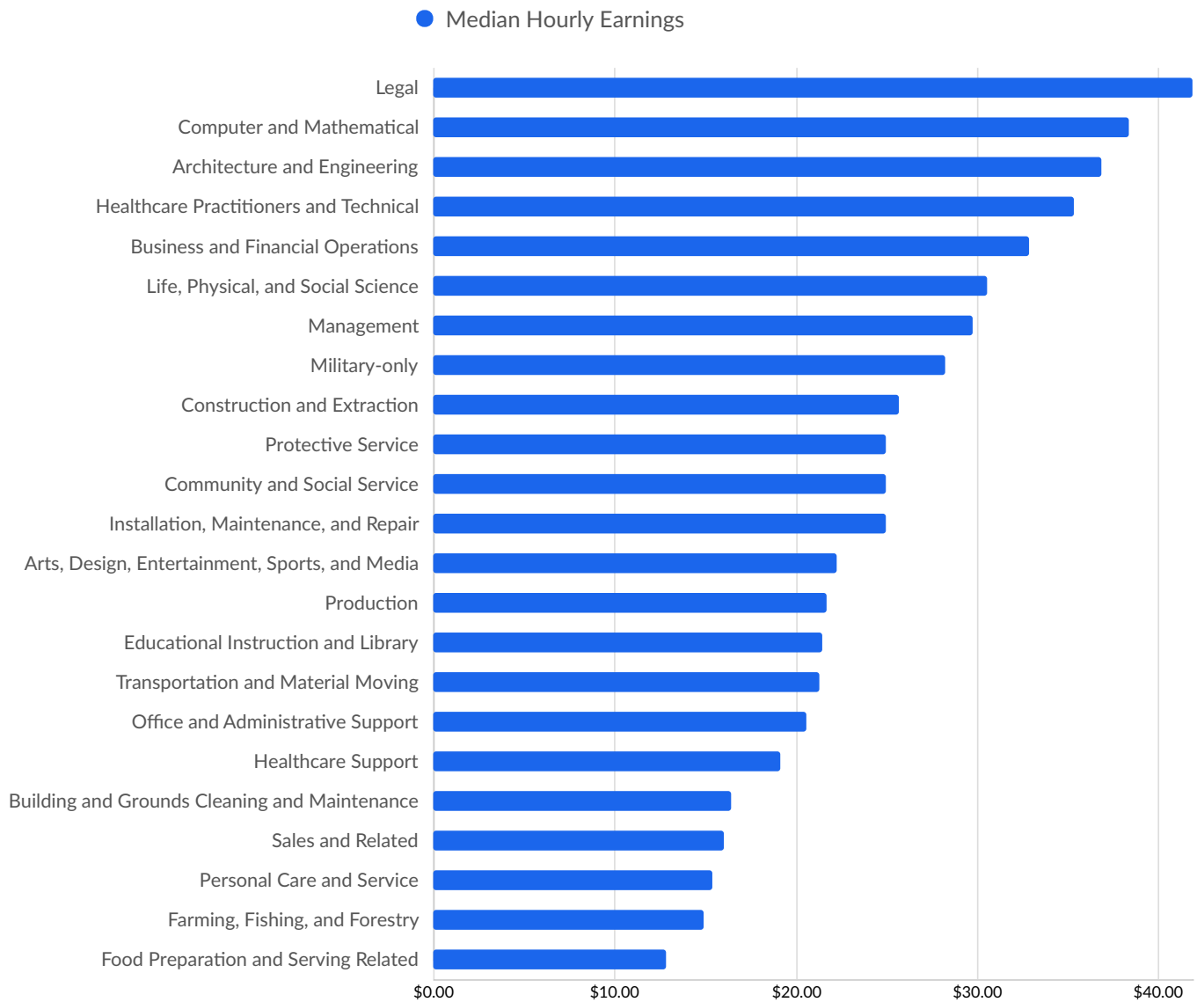
Top Growing Occupations



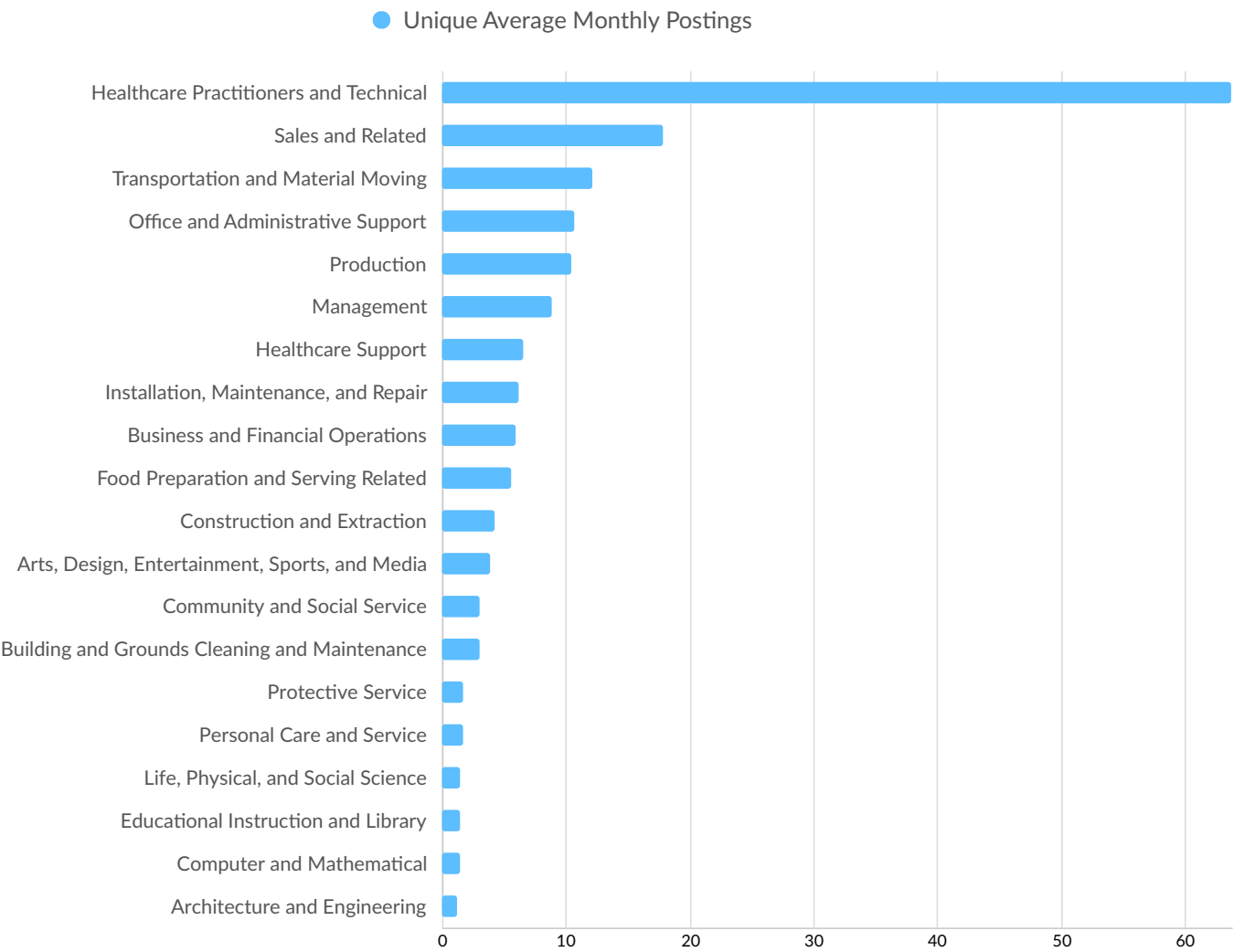
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



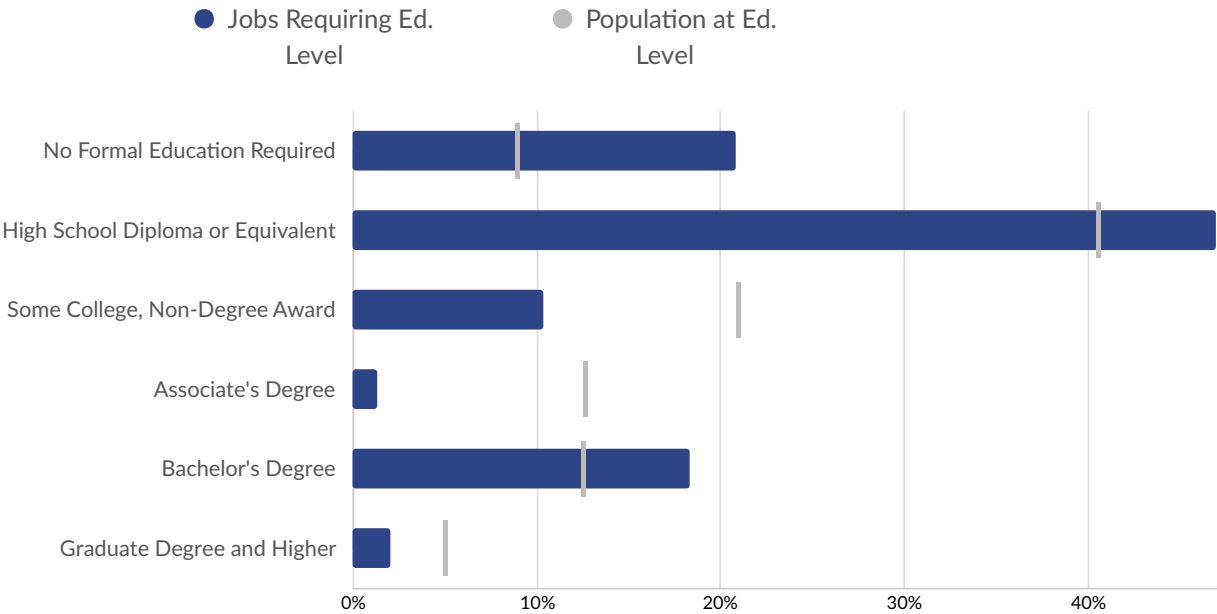
