JUNE 30, 1930 - J.L. MILLER "A SURVEYOR" PREPARES THE COOK AND BURNS PLAT ON PICKEREL LAKE, SAID PLAT CONSISTS OF ALL OF GOVERNMENT LOT 1, SECTION 29, TOWNSHIP 34 NORTH, RANGE 13 EAST, 4TH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, SOUTH OF THE QUARTER LINE.

JANUARY 6, 2006 - SURVEYOR 1935 - DANIEL E. HIGGINBOTHAM FOUND AND ACCEPTED A 1" IRON PIPE AT THIS LOCATION AND PLACED A SMP NAIL AT THE SURFACE IN BT PATCH. HIGGINBOTHAM PREPARED A USPLS MONUMENT RECORD ON FILE AT FOREST COUNTY AS DOCUMENT NUMBER 189850.

I DETERMINED THE SMP NAIL TO BE OBLITERATED REESTABLISHED ITS POSITION WITH A STANDARD MAG NAIL FROM HIGGINBOTHAM'S WITNESSES AS SHOWN BELOW.

The coordinate value shown is the average of two or more GPS observations at a markedly different time.

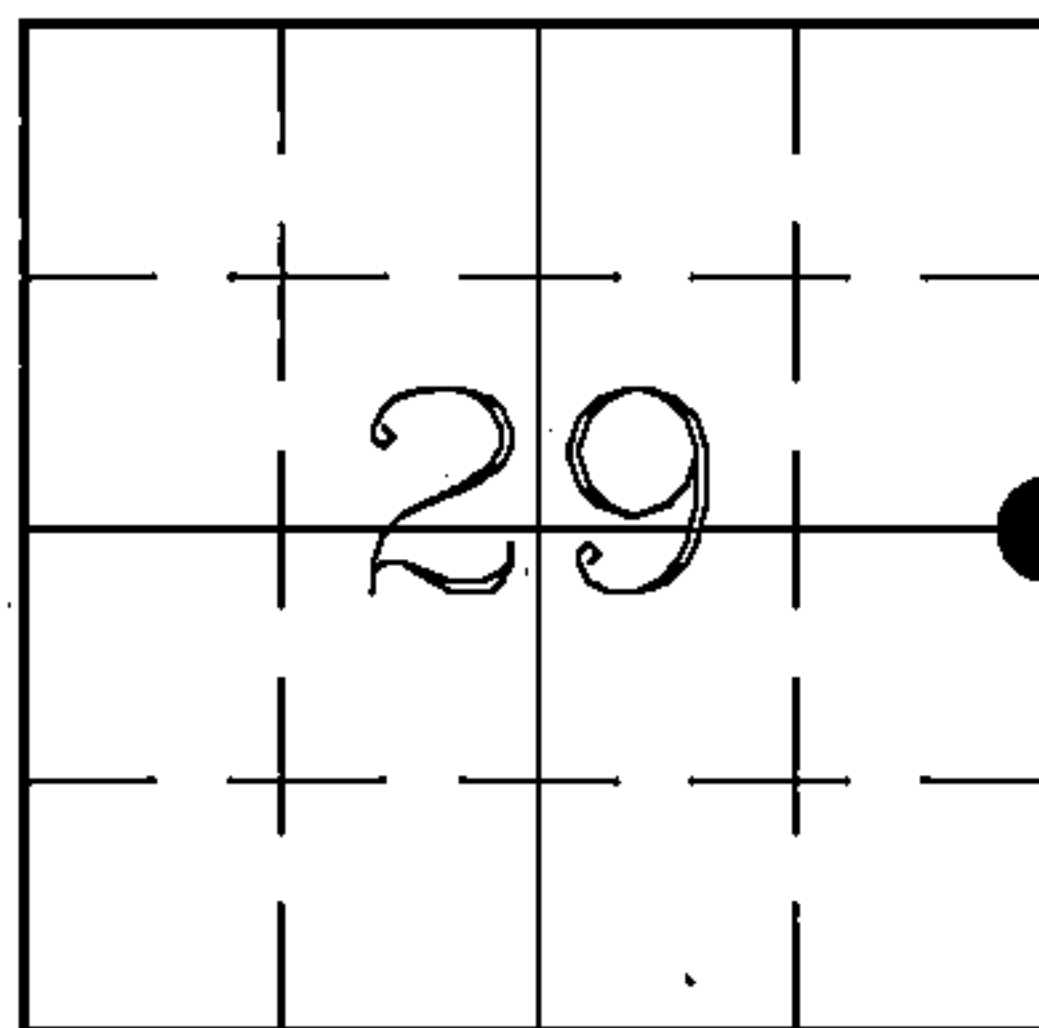

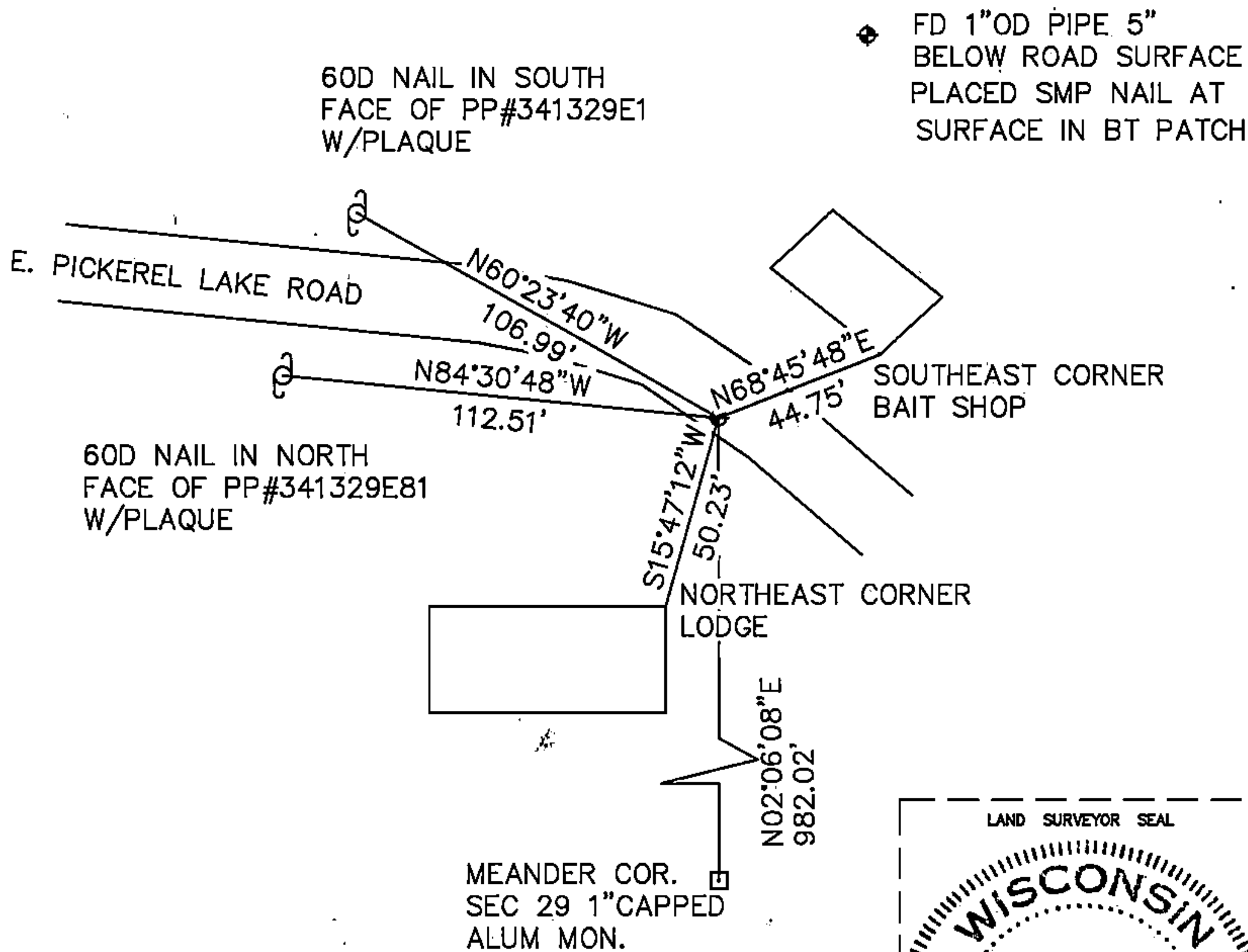

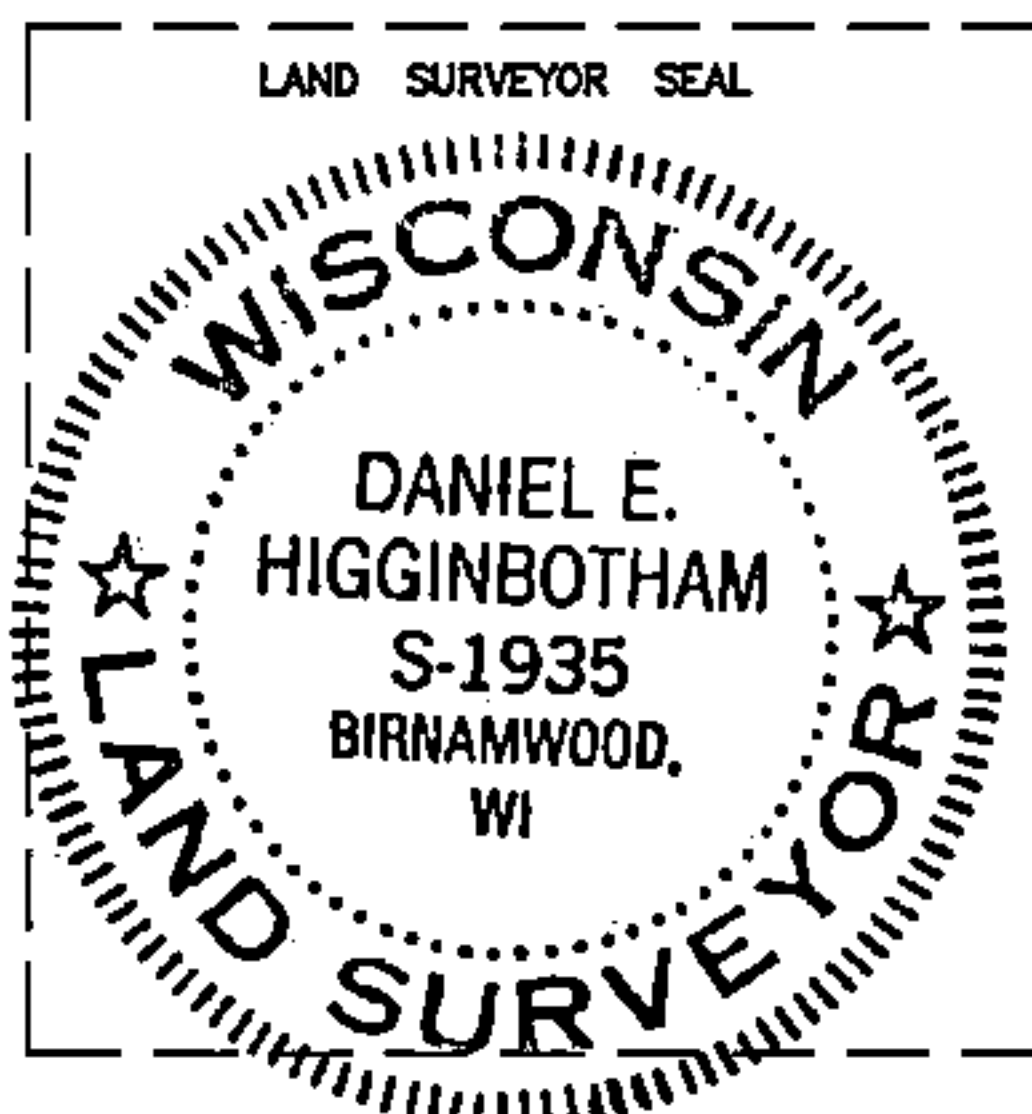
