


(b) Describe any record evidence, monument evidence, occupational evidence, testimonial evidence or any other material evidence you considered, and whether the monument was found or placed.

Original survey in 1859 by James McBride. Set wood post and the following bearing trees; Birch, 12", S.67°E., 12 links, Sugar, 15", N.11°EZ, 20 links.

In 1976, Thomas Arnott (RLS), found a 1" diameter iron pipe bent over. He replaced it with a new 1" diameter iron pipe and made the following corner references; Forest County Aluminum Monument, S.01°E., 25.39 feet, guy pole, N.16°E., 51.78 feet, guy pole, S.75°W., 51.76 feet, Power Pole #3414-27L9, N.49°W., 71.93 feet.

On 10-13-93, Alan Harrison (RLS), found 1" diameter iron pipe at intersection of Hwy 52 and Rangeline Road, from which Forest County witness corner monument bears S.01°E., 25.40 feet. Power Pole and guy pole references are gone. Made the following new corner references; Power Pole #3414-27R3, N.50°E., 39.50', Power Pole #3414-34E1, S.48°E., 41.20 feet. Set a Steel Sign Post, 0.60 feet, South of witness monument.
