


In 1935 Marinette County Surveyor F. P. Gould set a four inch iron post with brass cap for corner by proportion.

In 1975 J. Resvick found corner by Gould and made the following B.T.'s: W. Spruce, 7", N.81°W., 13.57 feet; W. Spruce, 7", N.04°W., 2.91 feet.

In 1989 Alan Harrison found corner by Gould and B.T.'s by Resvick. B.T. N.04°W. was cut down on property line. Made two new B.T.'s.
