Description of corner evidence found:

Recovered fence line running west from Cole Road, accepted the intersection of centerline of Cole Road with extended fence line east as the true corner for 1/4 corner. No evidence of any BTs, having been destroyed by road construction.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner. Set R.R. spike in centerline of Cole Road with fence line west for true corner. Set 2½" Berntsen A-1 Federal Monument for witness corner 60 links east, stamped: Monument projects 18" above ground.


