



In 1940 C.E. Walker, County Surveyor, set a brass capped monument for corner.

In 1976 Thomas Arnott found corner as set by Walker and made the following references: Maple 10" S.84°W 7.32'; Maple 6" N.54°W. 10.65'.

In October, 1992 Alan Harrison found brass capped monument for corner as set by Walker and Arnotts references in good shape. Added one more B.T.
