


U. S. PUBLIC LAND SURVEY MONUMENT RECORD

History of original corner establishment, record evidence, monument evidence, occupational evidence, testimonial evidence or any other material evidence, and what you found and how the monument was set.

In 1859 James McBride, contract surveyor, set this corner at 40 chains west of the northeast corner of section 19 and marked the following bearing trees:
Birch 14" N69W 35 links
Sugar 8" S34W 21 "

At single proportionate search area I found a number of old sugar stumps but none of them witnessing any post evidence. However, a CCC tag was found tacked onto a small diameter Maple tree near this corner location. I scraped the ground in a 20 ft radius from this CCC tag and located a squared 3" post hole with vertical wood fibers. S34W for 13.98 ft. a hardwood stump hole was noted with Maple clump growing just north of the hole. The other BT, N69W for 23 feet fell in an old logging road now used as snowmobile route. I accepted the post evidence found near the CCC tag and monumented same. Cutting east and west from this corner fell along an old blazed line during true line placement.



Set a 2"x 36" aluminum monument with cap stamped for corner. Ties are to aluminum nails driven into the tree centers which trees were blazed and scribed. Bearings are magnetic.
