

Set a 2" x 36" aluminum post with stamped cap at corner position. Ties are to aluminum nails driven into the tree centers, which trees were blazed and scribed. Bearings are magnetic


In 1858 James McBride, contract surveyor, set this corner position at 80 chains with the following bearing trees:

Swamp call North at 25 chains

At the double proportionate search area for this corner a large downed Hemlock tree was recovered. It was retraced back to its root system and N35W for 9 feet a rotted post was found. The three sugar bearing tree calls were measured and possible hardwood stump holes were located. The swamp call to the north of 25 chains fit within a chain of distance also. I accepted the rotted post and monumented same.

(Witness monuments shall be made of concrete, natural stone, iron or other equally durable material, except wood other than bearing trees.)
