In 1859 James McBride, contract surveyor, set a wood post at this corner and scribed the following bearing trees:

Birch 14" N 37°W 21 links Birch 14" S 29°E 15 links

In 1980 Bill Cochrane found a rotted post with point in tact and two stump holes at the bearing tree calls. He placed a 2½" Aluminum post with cap stamped for corner at the post position and scribed two 7" Maple trees as accessories.

I found Bill's aluminum monument in tact and the two Maples had grown to 'll' diameter trees. I marked two more trees as shown below.
