



 - 1858 Original post set by James McBride, witnessed by 24 Hemlock S81E 12 1ks.; 24 Hemlock N66W 32 1ks.
 - 1928 Goodman Lumber Co. notes show corner restored with flue pipe from existing NW Hemlock BT.
 - 1968 Iron pipe and post recovered by J. Resvick, S-802; Hemlock BT stump in place N66°W 21.1'. Additional references were established: Spruce 7' N34°W 21.40'; Aspen 6' S22°E 30.87'; 4x4' Cedar post Southeast 2.2'. (Forest Co. Document #95887)
- 1991 Coleman Engineering Company recovered 2" iron pipe with stamped brass cap set Feb. by J. Resvick and Spruce NBT. Established additional corner references.
