

Stefan, a Land Surveyor with the U.S. Forest Service, found a 5"x5"x3' scribed cedar post burnt and fallen next to a fence corner, and found the original bearing trees to verify the corner position. In place of cedar post, he set a 2" diam. aluminum pipe monument 36" long, with an aluminum cap stamped as follows: T37N, R12E, S4, S5, S8, S9, 1982, S-1558, from which the following bear:


