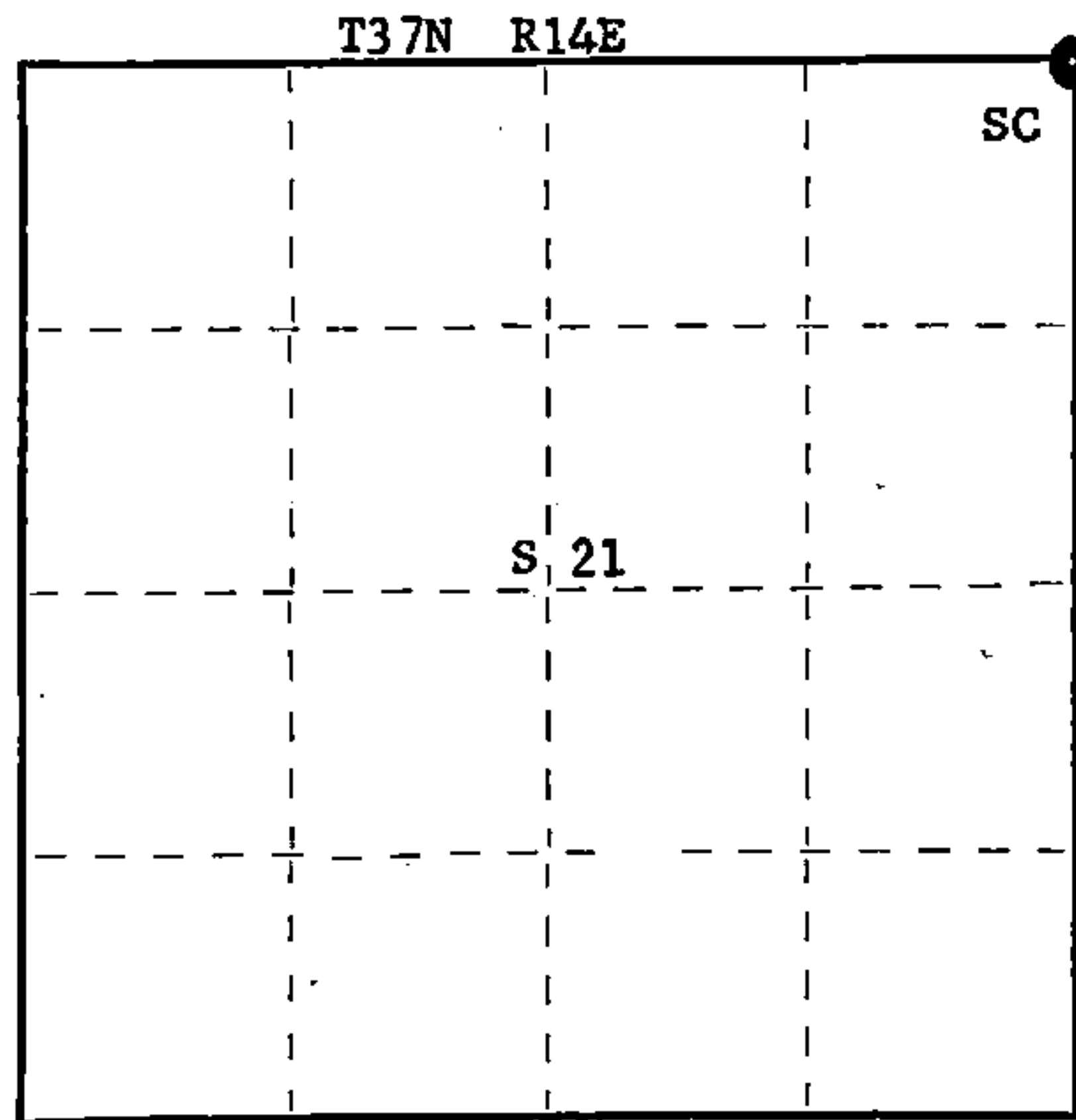
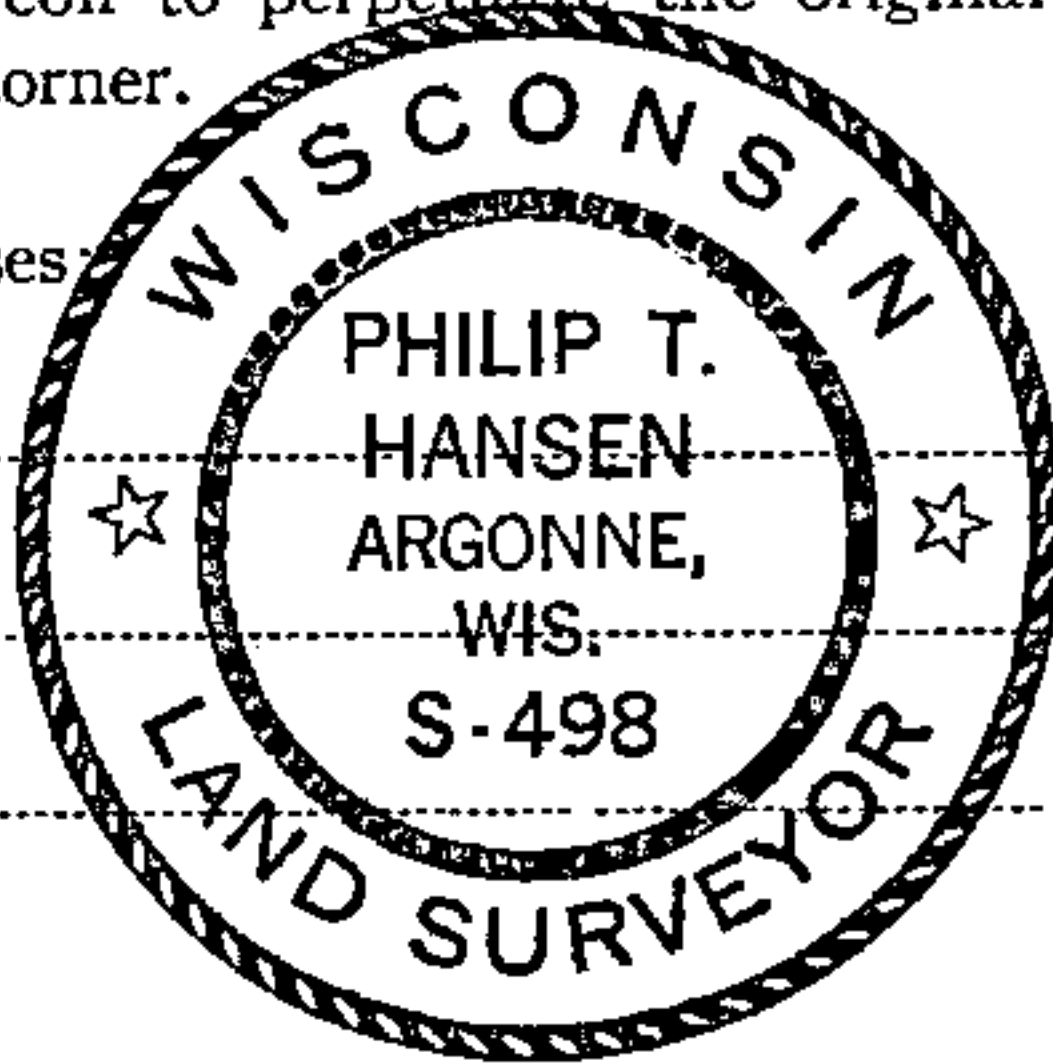

Description of corner evidence found:

Because of harvesting of infected trees it was necessary to cut the established bearing trees. Elm 12" N12°E, 91.2 links and Elm 14" S74°W, 73.5 links.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.  
Replaced elm BT's with 3 witness monuments.

- #1 1½" x 48" iron pipe south 8 feet
  - #2 1½" x 48" iron pipe west 10 feet
  - #3 1½" x 48" iron pipe S45°E, 12 feet
- all witness monuments project 24" above ground.

History of original corner establishment: Original corner established by James L. Nowlin, Government Deputy Surveyor, in 1865, from which aspen 8" bears S23°E 45 links and aspen 10" bears N43°W 50 links.

Corner recovered by E.B. Hurst, Consolidated Papers, Inc. forester, in 1930 during mapping for acquisition in 1930. Recovered wood post but no evidence of BT's. Corner perpetuated by Consolidated's foresters and P.T. Hansen, Registered Land Surveyor, since 1930.

Description of corner evidence found:  
Recovered old squared cedar stake in poor condition.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.  
Replaced old wood stake with 2-1/2" x 30" Berntsen A-1 Federal Monument, aluminum pipe with magnet installed in cap and base. The post projects 6" above the ground.  
Cap stamped -

NBT's - Elm 12" N12<sup>0</sup>E 91.2 links scribed SC BT.  
Elm 14" S74<sup>0</sup>W 73.5 links scribed SC BT.

Post and accessories painted blue.
