
U. S. PUBLIC LAND SURVEY MONUMENT RECORD

INSTRUCTIONS:

This record shall show the location of the corner and shall include all of the following nine elements (a through 1).

- (a) Identify the corner by reference to the U.S. public land survey system.

Original Government Survey in 1857 by Artemas Curtis.


In 1972, Jean Resvick, a Land Surveyor with the U.S. Forest Service, found a 6"x6"x5" wood post lying on ground and in concurrence with original bearing tree evidence. From the evidence of the original bearing trees found, set a 2" diameter galvanized iron pipe, 5 feet long, with a brass cap stamped: T37N, R15E, R16E, S1, S6, S12, S7, 1972, S-802 from which the following bear:

Hemlock	13"	N 08°E	38.03 feet
Yellow Birch	14"	S 55°E	13.30 feet
Yellow Birch	5"	s 28°W	50.82 feet
Hemlock	14"	N 23°W	66.80 feet
Steel sign post		SE	1.0 feet
