



No original corner evidence was found. At the calculated corner position, I found remnants of an ancient fence to the West and a recent steel post fence to the East of Wozniak road. Using the centerline of Wozniak road and the existing fencelines results in a distance of 2636.33 feet to the Section corner to the North and 2636.02 feet to the Section corner to the South. I restored corner at the intersection of the existing fencelines and at the centerline of Wozniak road.
