

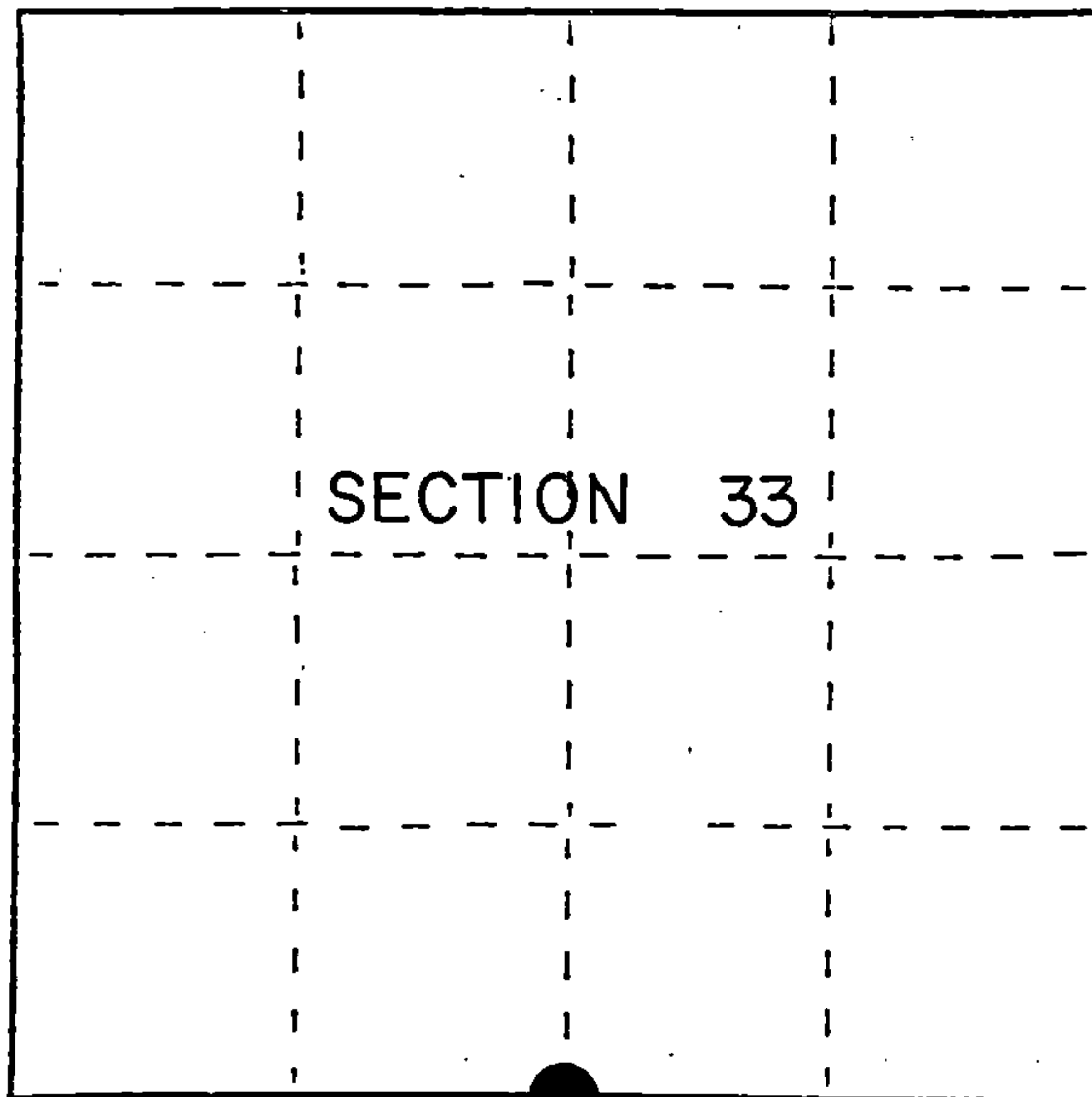
# U.S. PUBLIC LAND SURVEY MONUMENT RECORD

evidence of the South Quarter  
corner of Section 33  
Township 38, North, Range  
14 East, Fourth Principal Meridian,  
as described hereon; and that from this evidence  
I established a new monument and accessories  
as described hereon to perpetuate the original  
location of this corner.

## History of original corner establishment:

Original Government Survey in 1858 by Alfred Millard. At 40.00 chains set Quarter Post, from which the following bear; Spruce, 12", N28°W, 25 lks., Yellow Birch, 10", S70°E, 10 lks.

In 1989, Glen Barker, RLS, with Consolidated Papers, restored the corner position at proportionate and on line between the Southeast and Southwest Section Corners of Section 33. Set a 1" diameter aluminum pipe with an alloy cap stamped to identify corner. Blazed and scribed the following new bearing trees:

W. Birch	10"	N43°E	90.16 feet
Cedar	12"	N82°E	6.22 feet
Cedar	9"	S05°W	36.57 feet
Hemlock	11"	S64°W	18.67 feet

Found monument and bearing trees as described above;

W. Birch	11"	N43°E	90.10 feet
Cedar	14"	N82°E	6.23 feet
Cedar	10"	S05°W	36.59 feet
Hemlock	15"	S64°W	18.71 feet

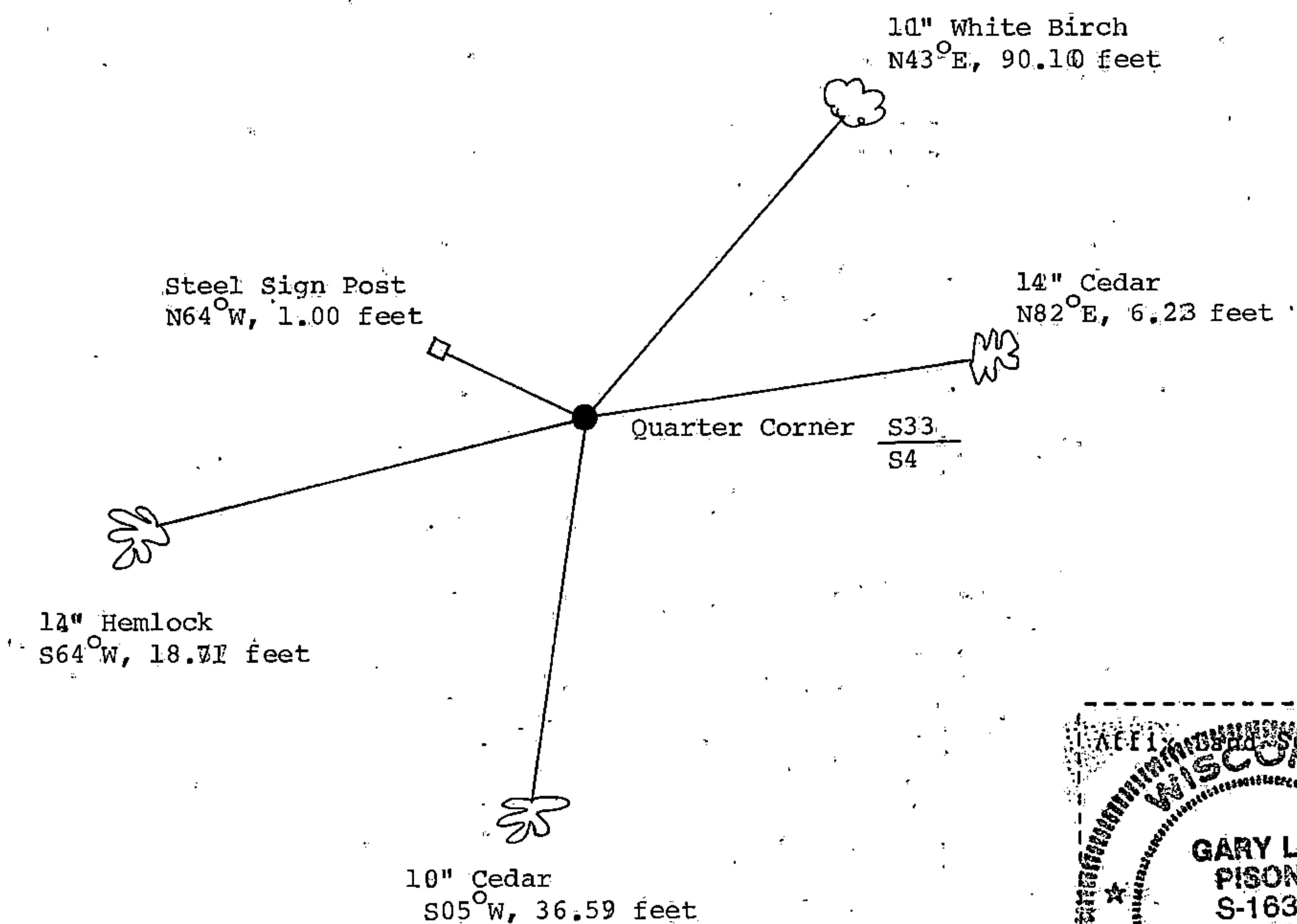
