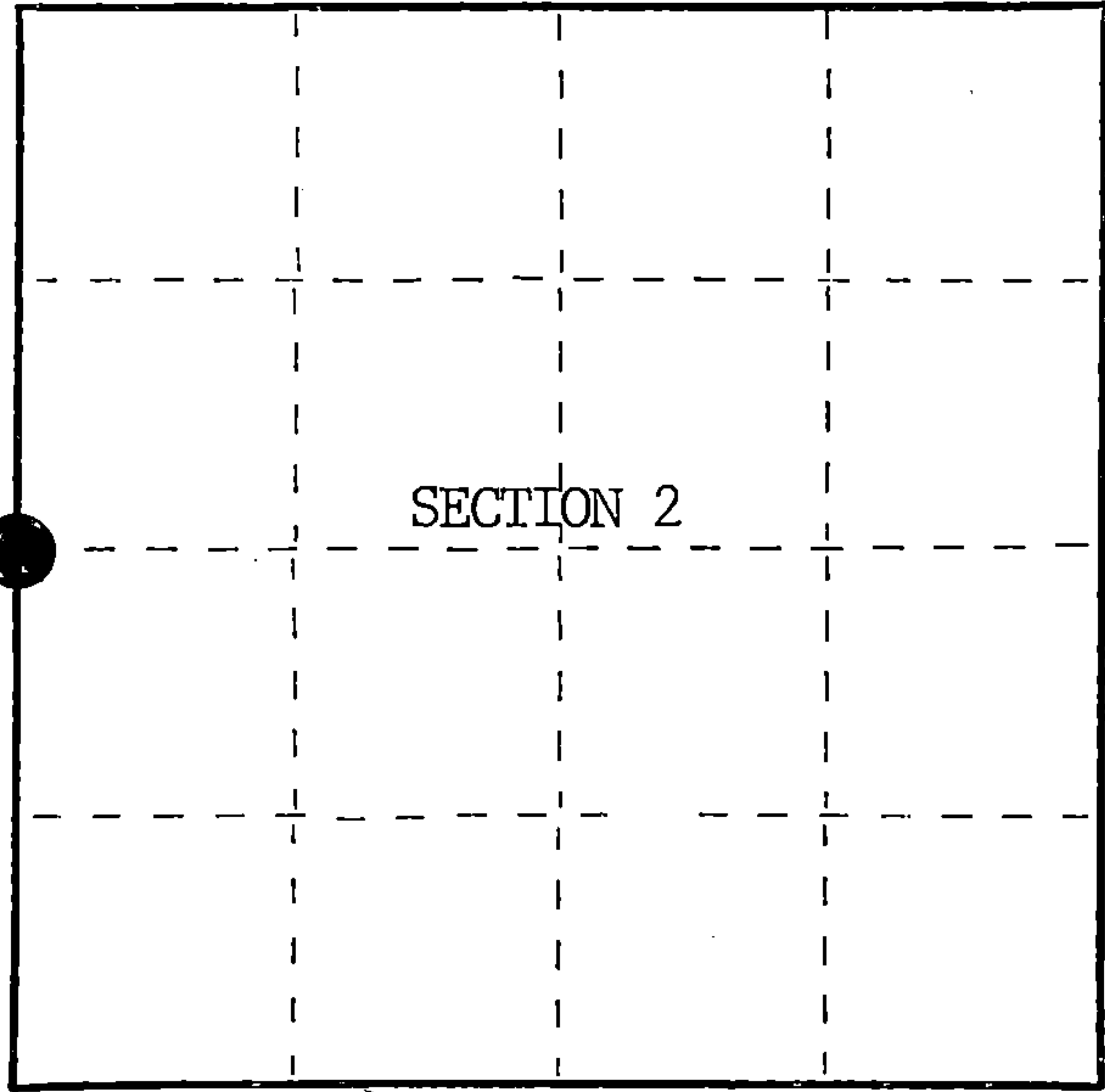

History of original corner establishment:

Original Government Survey in 1865 by William E. Daugherty and Alex McDill. South corrected between Sections 2 and 3, 40.28 chains, set Quarter Section Post to Sections 2 and 3, from which the following bear;

Fir	8"	S33°W	7 lks.
Fir	6"	S39°E	5 lks.

South 25 chs., leave swamp  
South 41.5 chs., enter swamp  
Description of corner evidence found:

Found a 4"x4" Squared Cedar Post, from which a Fir stump bears S33°W, 7 lks.

Leave swamp South 25 chs.  
Enter swamp South 41.5 chs.

I accept the location of the wood post as the original corner position in concurrence with original bearing tree evidence and swamp calls.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

In place of wood post, set a 2½ inch diameter aluminum pipe monument, 3 feet long, 2½ feet in the ground, with an aluminum cap stamped; T39N, R14E, 1/4, S2, S3, 1985, S-1107. From which the following new blazed and scribed bearing trees bear;

Balsam	8"	S67°W	64.77 feet
Cedar	14"	N60°W	41.35 feet
Steel Sign Post		NW	2.00 feet

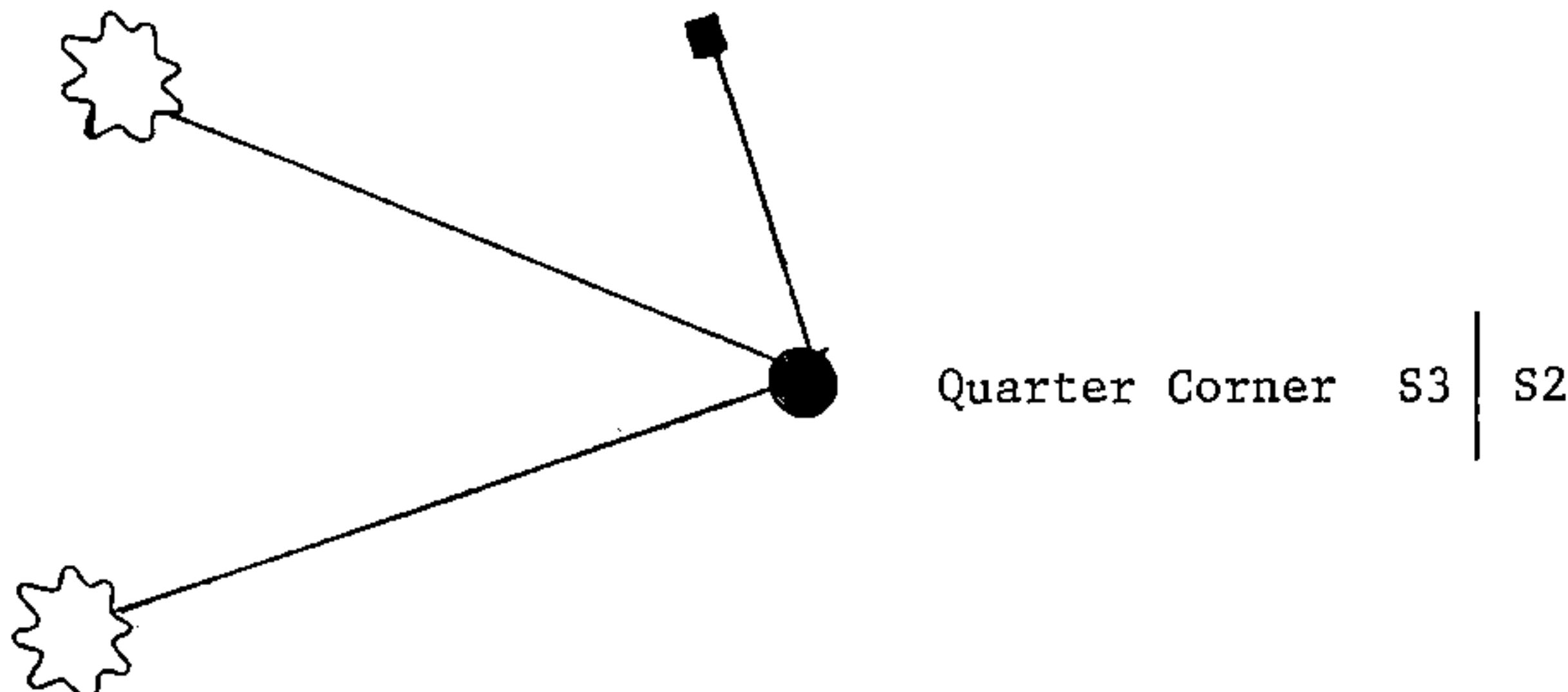
