North between Sections 14 and 15, 80.00 chains, set Section Corner Post to Sections 10, 11, 14, and 15, from which the following bear; Hemlock, 10", N31°W, 26 lks., Tamarac, 8", S66°E, 10 lks. In 1928, Melindy, a Local Surveyor, subdivided Section 14. At the corner position he found an Original Hemlock, N31°W, 26 lks. From bearing tree evidence, set a 5"x5" Cedar Post, from which the following bear;


