Original Government Survey in 1865 by William E. Daugherty and Alex McDill. North between Sections 21 and 22, at 80.00 chains set Section Corner Post to Sections 15, 16, 21, and 22. West corrected between Sections 15 and 22, at 47.50 chains, creek runs Northeast.

S25°W 18 1ks. Sugar N41°E 23 1ks. W. Pine

Description of corner evidence found:

Found F.R. #2168 which bears East and West.

Found creek running Northeast.

I restored the corner position using the creek call to the East and in the Center-Line of F.R. #2168.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

At the corner position, set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch diameter aluminum pipe monument, 3 feet long, 3½ feet in the ground(6"below road surface), with an aluminum cap stamped; T39N, R14E, S15, S16, S21, S22, 1986, S-1107. From which the following new blazed and scribed bearing trees bear;




