N59°W 18 1ks. Birch S78°E Hemlock 34 1ks.

Description of corner evidence found:

No Corner evidence was recovered.

I restored the corner position at proportionate distance and on lineebetweennthee Southwest and Southeast Section Corners of Section 19.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner. At the corner position, set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch diameter aluminum pipe monument, 3 feet long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  feet in the ground, with an aluminum cap stamped; T39N, R14E, 1/4, S19,S30, 1982, S-1107. From which the following new blazed and scribed bearing trees bear;




