

Cochrane, do hereby certify that on the 2nd day of October, 1986, I found evidence of the East Quarter corner of Section 20 Township 39 North, Range 14 East, Fourth Principal Meridian, as described hereon; and that from this evidence I established a new monument and accessories as described hereon to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

History of original corner establishment:

Original Government Survey in 1865 by William E. Daugherty and Alex McDill. North between Sections 20 and 21, at 40.00 chs. set Quarter Section Post to Sections 20 and 21, from which the following bear;

Tamarac	7"	N62°E	16 lks.
Tamarac	4"	N40°W	15 lks.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found 5" x 5" Wood Post, from which a scribed Tamarac stump bears N40°W, 17.25 feet. It is not known who set the post or made the bearing tree. Distance does not fit the original record.

I accept the wood post as the best available evidence for restoring the corner position.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

In place of 5" x 5" Wood Post, set a 2½ inch diameter aluminum pipe monument, 5 feet long, 4 feet in the ground, with an aluminum cap stamped; T39N R14E, 1/4, S20, S21, 1986, S-1107. From which the following new blazed and scribed bearing trees bear;

Tamarac (Stump)		N40°W	17.25 feet
Steel Sign Post		SW	1.00 feet

From the Reference Monument, a Steel Sign Post bears NW, 1.00 feet




