Birch 18" N85°W 21 1ks. Birch 15" S34°E 16 1ks.

Description of corner evidence found:

No corner evidence was recovered.

The corner position was re-established using double proportionate methods between the Northeast Section Corner of Section 2 and the Southeast Section Corner of Section 11, and between the Northwest Section Corner of Section 11 and the Northeast Section Corner of Section 12.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.


