Original Government Survey in 1865 by William E. Daugherty. North between Sections 5 and 6, at 81.10 chains, intersect 4th Correction Line 289 links West of the Standard Quarter Section Corner of Section 31, T41N R14E. At the corner position set a Wood Post, from which the following bear;

Birch 14" S49°E 40 1ks. Birch 8" S14°W 35 1ks.

Description of corner evidence found:

No corner evidence was recovered.

The corner position is re-established at proportionate distance and on line between the Standard Section Corner common to Sections 31 and 32, and the Standard Quarter Section Corner of Section 32.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

At the corner position, set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch diameter aluminum pipe monument, 3 feet long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  feet in the ground, with an aluminum cap stamped; T41N R14E, S32, S5, S6, CC, T40N, 1986, S-1107. From which the following new blazed and scribed bearing trees bear;
