



N.00°09'E. between Sections 22 and 23, at 71.60 chains, set Witness Corner which is a 6" diameter concrete monument, 24 inches long, with an iron post in center and a brass cap mkd; WC, T40N, R14E, S14, S15, S22, S23, 1945. From which the following bear;

Poplar 5" N.27°45'E. 191 links Cherry 5" S.25°15'E. 84 links Cherry 6" S.04°45'W. 115 links

At 72.00 chains, the point for Section Corner is determined at the intersection of gravelled roads. At the corner point Set a 6" dia. concrete monument, 12" long Description of corner evidence found: 20" in the ground.

No evidence found of concrete monument marking section corner position. At the road intersection found a 1" diameter iron pipe marking the corner position, from which a WC concrete monument bears


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
