History of original corner establishment:

Dependent Resurvey in 1945 by Hugh B. Crawford. North between Sections 14 and 15, 40.18 chains, corner set at proportionate distance and point falls near center of road, set a concrete monument, 12" long, 6" dia., no marks. In 1945, set a point East 40 links, distance set concrete, 3 feet long, 5" dia., 30" in the ground with brass cap marked as W.C. (witness corner).

In 1966, Jean F. Resvick found monuments as described above and set bearing trees to the witness corner on the East side of the road. No corner references were ever set for the quarter corner in the road. Description of corner evidence found:

Found monument as described above, monument at quarter corner position is presently flush with roadbed surface.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

Replaced concrete monument with no marks with a 21/2" diameter aluminum pipe monument, 3 feet long, 8" below the surface of the road, with an aluminum capped stamped: T40N, R14E, 1/4, S-15, S-14, 1989, S-1634. From which the following new blazed and scribed bearing trees bear (all measurements taken to a nail in side of tree):


