Being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the South 1/4 corner of Section 10. Thence N00°58'57"E, along the North-South 1/4 line of said section, a distance of 973.48' to a point on the former south right-of-way of County Trunk Highway B; Thence N78°35'01"E, along said former south right-of-way, a distance of 330.00' to a point: Thence, leaving said right-of-way, S00°58'57"W, along the west line of lands described in document number 169237, a distance of 27.68' to the new south right-of-way of County Trunk Highway B as referenced on R/W Project Number 9329-01-00 dated 1995 and

being the POINT OF BEGINNING (POB) of lands to be described:

Thence, continuing, S00°58'57"W, along said west line, a distance of 180.32', to a point being the southwest corner of lands described in document number 169237;

Thence leaving said West line, S78°35'01"E, along the extension of the south line of lands described in said document and being parallel with the former south right-of-way of County Trunk Highway B, a distance of 80.87' to a point:

thence leaving line extended, N00°58'57"E, parallel with the North-South 1/4 line of said section, a distance of 185.70' to a point on the new south right-of-way of said highway;

Thence, N84°17'39"E, along the new south right-of-way of said highway, a distance of 52.77'; Thence, N78°35'01"E, continuing along said new right-of-way line, a distance of 27.21' to the Point of Beginning.

That said parcel contains 0.33 acres more or less.
