
PLAT OF SURVEY for BUREAU OF INDIAN **AFFAIRS**

## PROJECT HISTORY This survey was requested by the Bureau of Indian Affairs to determine the boundaries of Government Lots 10 & 11, Section 27, T35N, R12E, Forest County, Wisconsin and various small parcels within the Government Lots. The Bureau of Indian Affairs also requested that the surveys be recorded with the Forest County Register of Deeds. In June and July, 1978 the Bureau of Land Management conducted a Dependent Resurvey in the area which included Section 27. All section and ½ corners were recovered or replaced at this time and were used for the section subdivision. The only corner not found in place was the south ½ corner. The bearing trees and hole where the monument had been placed were located and a one inch iron pipe was set in the position of the corner. Upon completion of the survey two certified surveys were filed with the Forest County Register of Deeds.
