SURVEY MADE JANUARY & FEBRUARY 1908.

--EXPLANATION--

All Courses are reckoned from the true Meridian as ascertained by Observation of Polaris at Western Elongation, and by Solar Observations at various times during the progress of the Survey.

Magnetic Declination January 21, 1908 at Seven A.M. -- 3°-05'-30" East.

Points where Monuments of United States Survey where found and fully identified are indicated by -- X

Bearing trees of U.S. Survey are indicated thus: -- (U.S.S.)

All lines were run by transit.

Meanders of lake are from Stadia Survey.

Stakes are set 200 feet apart.

Trees near line are marked by a blaze with one hack.

Trees on line are marked by a blaze with Three Notches.

Bearing trees notched in Survey are marked -- "O"

All Measurements reduced to 60° -F.

Red Alphabet Letters refer to index of witness trees for indicated posts and corners.

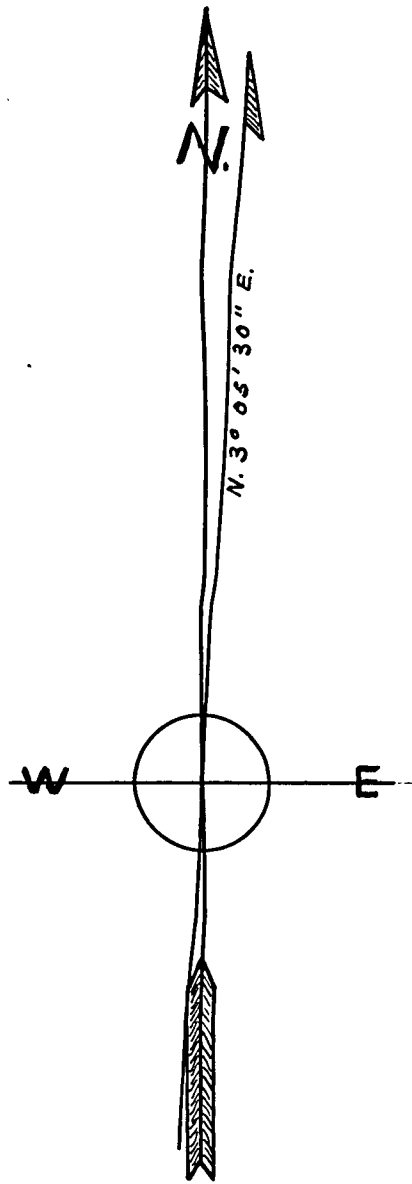
Posts set at Circled Corners.
