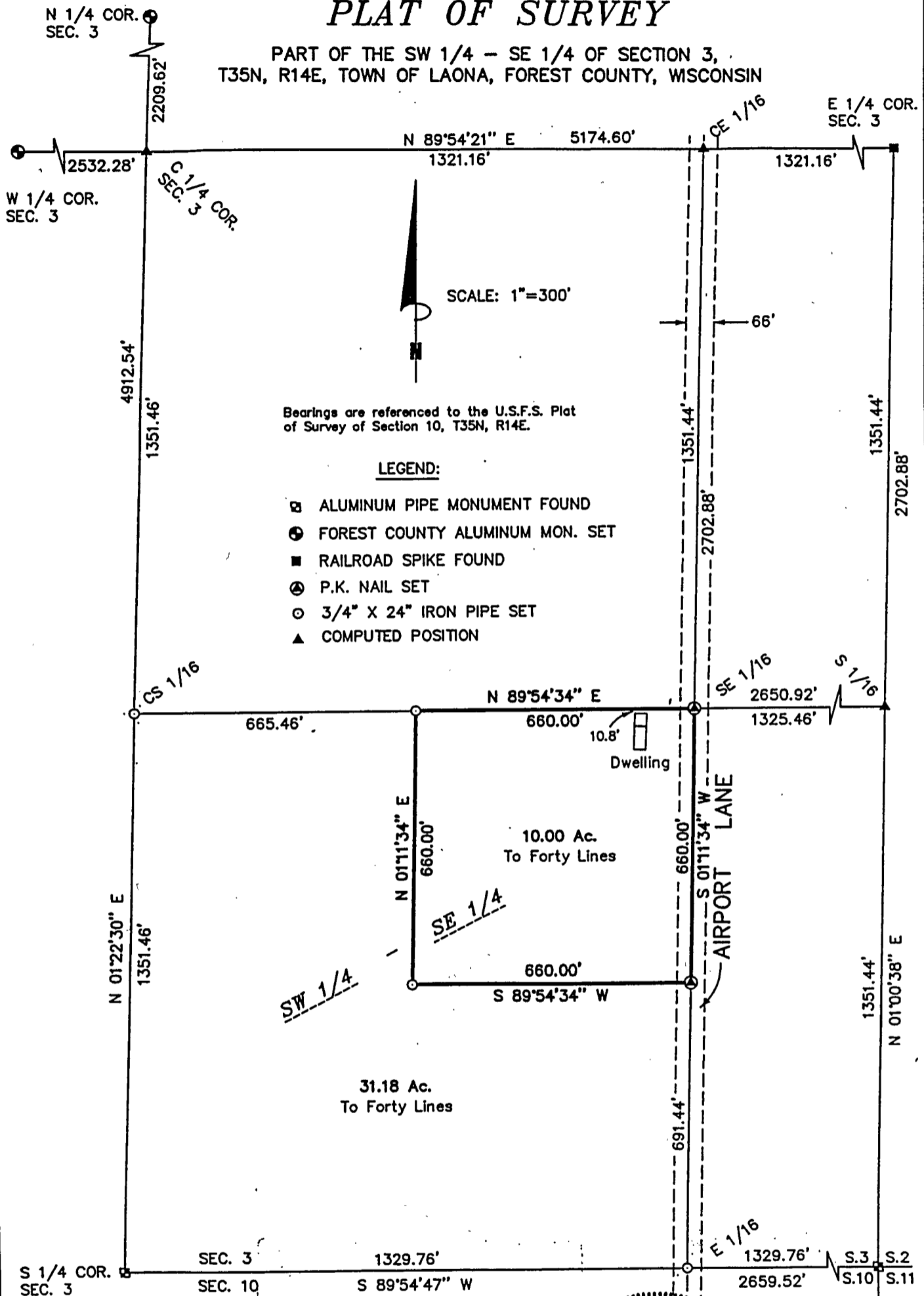

**LEGAL DESCRIPTION
(31.18 ACRE PARCEL)**

A PARCEL OF LAND LOCATED IN PART OF THE SOUTHWEST ONE-QUARTER (SW ¼) OF THE SOUTHEAST ONE-QUARTER (SE ¼) OF SECTION THREE (3), TOWNSHIP THIRTY-FIVE NORTH (T35N), RANGE FOURTEEN EAST (R14E), FOURTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, TOWN OF LAONA, FOREST COUNTY, WISCONSIN AND MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

COMMENCING AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SAID SW ¼ - SE ¼; THENCE S 01°11'34" W ALONG THE EAST LINE OF SAID FORTY A DISTANCE OF 660.00 FEET TO THE **POINT OF BEGINNING**; THENCE CONTINUING S 01°11'34" W ALONG THE EAST LINE OF SAID FORTY A DISTANCE OF 691.44 FEET TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SAID FORTY; THENCE S 89°54'47" W ALONG THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID FORTY A DISTANCE OF 1329.76 FEET TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SAID FORTY; THENCE N 01°22' 30" E ALONG THE WEST LINE OF SAID FORTY A DISTANCE OF 1351.46 FEET TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SAID FORTY; THENCE N 89°54'34" E ALONG THE NORTH LINE OF SAID FORTY A DISTANCE OF 665.46 FEET; THENCE S 01°11'34" W PARALLEL WITH THE EAST LINE OF SAID FORTY A DISTANCE OF 660.00 FEET; THENCE N 89°54'34" E PARALLEL WITH THE NORTH LINE OF SAID FORTY A DISTANCE OF 660.00 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.
