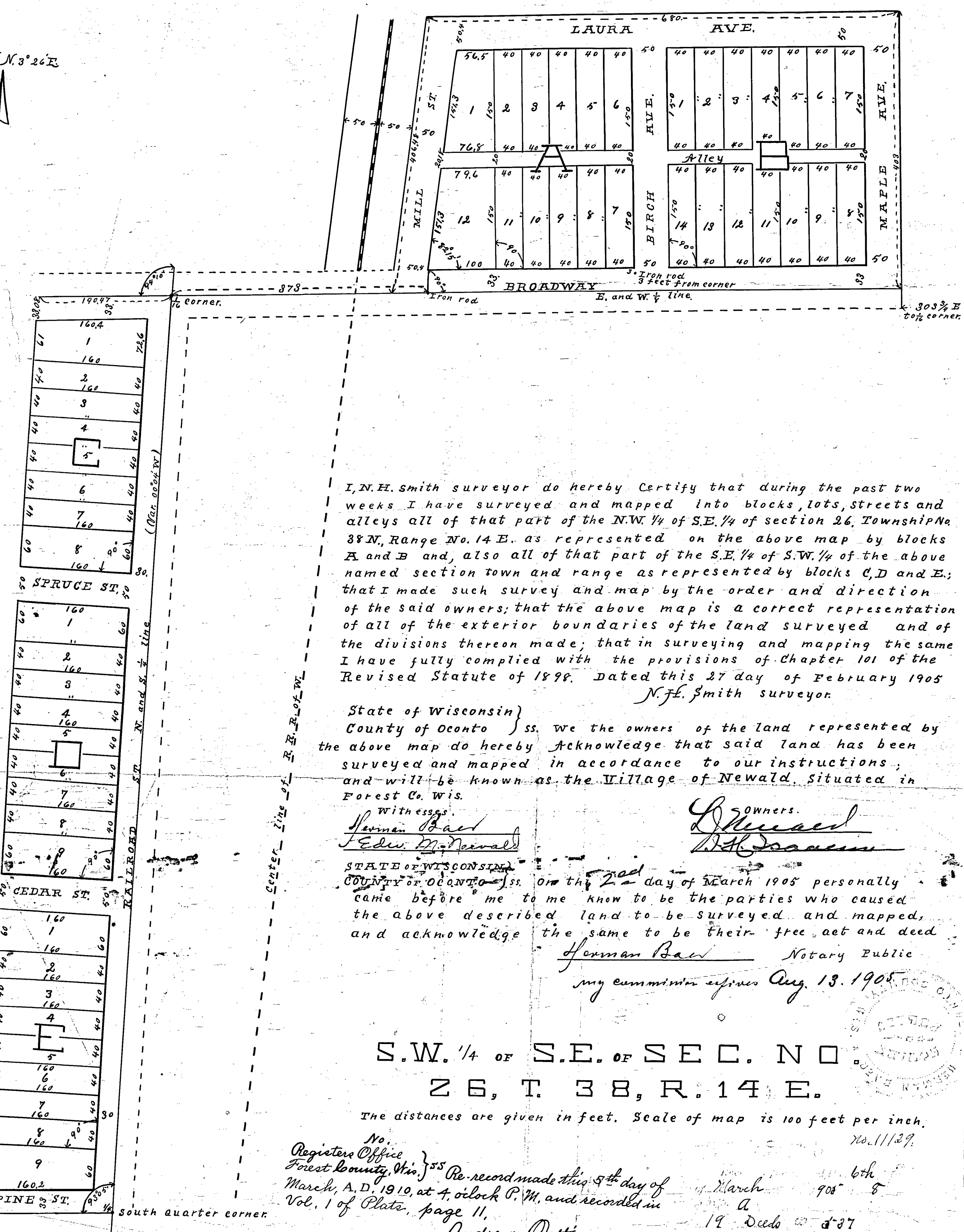
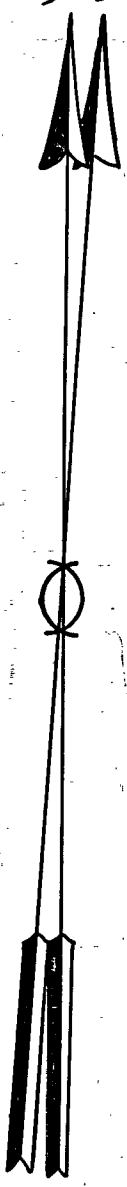


MAP OF NEWALD FOREST CO., WIS.
